RNRDGC Short Tee Ground Rule:

The river is Out of Bounds (OB). There are no other mandos, hazards or obs unless otherwise stated below.

Short Tee Layout (MA1 and FA1):

Hole 1: 253 ft Par 3 - No mando

Hole 2: 298 ft Par 3 – The river is OB

Hole 3: 269 ft Par 4 – No Mandos in play

Hole 4: 249 ft Par 3 – No Mandos in play

Hole 5: 308 ft Par 4 - The river is OB

Hole 6: 184 ft Par 3 - No Obs

Hole 7: 292 ft Par 4 - No Obs

Hole 8: 338 ft Par 4 – No Obs

Hole 9: 266 ft Par 4 – No Obs

(Repeat for 18 holes)

RNRDGC Long Tee Ground Rules:

- -All mandos, hazards and Obs are in play.
- -The river is OB. Take a one stroke penalty and play from where the disc last passed in bounds.
- -All missed double mandos receive a one stroke penalty. The drop zone is anywhere the between double mando unless otherwise stated below.
- -All missed single mandos receive a one stroke penalty. The drop zone is anywhere within 3 meters perpendicular to the missed mando on the inbounds side of play.
- -All island misses receive a one stroke penalty and proceed to designated drop zone.

Long Tee Layout (MPO)

Hole 1: 253 ft Par 3:

- a. There is a double mando in front of tee pad.
- b. The concrete path and beyond, located to the left of the fairway and behind the target, is OB.
- c. Beyond the back of the wooden posts on the right side of the fairway is OB.

Hole 2: 298 ft Par 3:

- a. The river is OB.
- b. The concrete path and beyond is OB.

Hole 3: 269 ft par 3:

- a. There is a double mando 10 meters in front of tee pad
- b. After passing the first double mando, the concrete path which lines the left side of the fairway, and beyond is ob.
- c. There is a second double mando in front of the basket. If you miss it then please proceed to the drop zone which is 10 meters in front of the double mando.

Hole 4: 249 ft Par 3:

a. The concrete path and beyond is OB.

Hole 5: 308 ft Par 4:

- a. The river is OB.
- b. The concrete path and beyond is ob.

Hole 6: 184 ft Par 3

Hole 7: 292 ft Par 3:

- a. The concrete path and beyond on the right-side plays as a hazard.
- b. The concrete path and beyond to the far left, and behind basket, is OB.

Hole 8: 338 ft Par 3:

a. All concrete path ways play as hazards.

Hole 9: 266 ft Par 4:

- a. All concrete path ways play as hazards.
- b. The back of the wooden posts and beyond to the far left are OB.

Hole 10: 439 ft Par 4:

- a. The water is OB. All shots in the water proceed to the drop zone which is directly across water between water and concrete pathway.
- b. There is a mando on the left side after the water which must be passed on the right.
- c. All concrete pathways play as hazards.

Hole 11: 565 ft Par 5:

- a. There is a mando on the left side which must be passed on the right.
- b. The concrete pathway on right plays as a hazard.
- c. The wire fence and beyond to the far right plays as OB.

Hole 12: 219 ft Par 3:

- The concrete pathway as well as the brick wall behind/below basket and beyond, plays as OB.
- b. Throws down the mountain receive one shot penalty and must re-tee. If there are any discrepancies then Danny will tell you if your shot is in or out.

Hole 13: 254 ft Par 3:

- a. All concrete pathways play as hazards.
- b. The water behind the target is OB. Play from where the disc last passed in bounds.

Hole 14: 395 ft Par 4:

a. The concrete pathway and beyond to the far left is OB.

Hole 15: 272 ft Par 3:

- a. There is a mando on the tree which must be passed to the right
- b. The target is on an island. All tee shots that do not come to rest on the island proceed to the drop zone which is at the beginning of island.
- c. All subsequent ob shots play normal ob rules.

Hole 16: 623 ft Par 4:

- a. The concrete pathway and beyond which surrounds the field is OB.
- b. The concrete pathway in front of stone henge plays as a hazard.
- c. Within the brick circle around big tree plays as a hazard.

Hole 17: 631 ft Par 4:

- a. The concrete pathway and beyond is OB unless you are on the island.
- b. The target is on an island. Missed island attempts receive a one stroke penalty and the player must rethrow from the same lie.

Hole 18: 392 ft Par 3:

- a. This as an island hole. The island is marked by the path concrete path and stone wall. The grass/dirt area, as well as the concrete gutter at the base of the mountain, are in bounds.
- b. Missed island shots receive one shot penalty and play from drop zone at the beginning corner of the island.
