





WARM UP

IMPORTANT INFO

Baskets for holes 18 and 8 are available for putting practice. There is a large grass area in front of HQ that is available for throwing practice - do not throw if members of the public are crossing the area.

CARTS

The course is suitable for carts.

SCORING

Access Code for PDGA scoring: wizdisc

It is highly recommended that **all** players on a card score on **pdga.com/score** or via the **PDGA Live** app. At least two players on each card must score. Bring a power bank if your phone will need to recharge before round 2. Please install the app before the event if you don't have it.

EMERGENCIES + WEATHER + DRAINS

A first aid kit will be stored near HQ, please call the TD, Andy in case of an emergency during the round.

We will be following ADG's Bad Weather Guidelines regarding weather.

There are some drains on the course - if your disc is not easily recoverable then ask the TD for help after the round. Play next shot from above disc as normal (no penalty).

CONTACTS

COURSE RULES

We are playing on a narrow public park surrounded by houses and crossed by several paths, there is a little more risk than normal of an accident. Do not throw if you may hit someone.

The mandos on the course are in place for safety reasons - either to protect the public and property or to protect players on other holes.

SECURITY

There will be nobody at HQ during the rounds so you will need to leave excess gear in your car. Please keep an eye on the course infrastructure to make sure that nobody wanders off with anything.

OUT-OF-BOUNDS

- Many concrete paths and beyond are OB as marked on the tee signs.
- All roads and beyond are OB
- All fences and beyond are OB. If your disc enters private property you must only attempt to retrieve it after the round with the consent of the property owner.
 There is a small stand-alone fence near hole 6 - this is not an OB boundary.

Only hole 13 has OB boundaries marked on the ground. These boundaries will be marked with string and flags - the line formed between two adjacent flags is the line you should use to judge in/out.

If in doubt take a photo, play a provisional let TD to check at the end of the round.

TIMING

Speed of play is important and will determine the timing of Round 2. Keep your card moving along to prevent any backlogs. The flow of the course and the lack of undergrowth should make for fast rounds.

TEE PADS

Tee pads are mainly dirt/grass/concrete and are marked with whiskers.

NEXT TEE

Please consult the Course Overview to navigate to the correct tee. Always check that you are at the correct tee before you tee off.

WATER/TOILETS

There is no toilet or water facility in this park. Please bring your own water.

There is a toilet at Saunders Park, about 150m from the the tee of hole 12. We are trying to arrange access to this facility during play and should be able to confirm during the players briefing.

There are also toilets at the nearby St Clair Shopping Centre and in Banks Drive Reserve.

We will have a limited supply of water to top up your water bottles at HQ during the event.

PLAY-OFFS

Play offs will be used to break a tie for 1st place only. Should a play-off be required then the play off holes to be played on rotation will be 1, 2, 7 and 8. As soon as a tie is broken any losing player stops playing and any remaining players continue to the next playoff hole.

CTP

Hole 1 will be the CTP hole for ALL divisions EXCEPT MPO, MP40 and MA1. Hole 8 will be the CTP hole for MPO, MP40 and MA1.

There will be a flag and clipboard at these holes and the winners will be determined over both rounds.

ACE POT

DISC RAFFLE











The road and beyond marked **OB** is Out of Bounds.


This hole is **CTP** for all divisions **EXCEPT** MPO, MP40 & MA1.









Road to the left and the concrete path beyond the basket marked **OB** are Out of Bounds.

Be aware of players on the tee and playing hole 5.










The concrete path is NOT **OB**.

Be aware of players playing hole 4.








All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the road, the concrete path and beyond.

On completion, proceed behind the tee of 3 to reach hole 7's tee.










All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the the concrete path on the left and beyond.


The concrete path the tee is on is **NOT OB**.







This hole is **CTP** for MPO, MP40 & MA1 **ONLY**.










All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the concrete path and beyond.

Beware of players on hole 14 nearby.








All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the concrete path on the left and beyond.


If you don't pass to the right of the Mando marked **M** then take a penalty shot and proceed to the dropzone marked **DZ**.








All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the concrete path on the left and beyond.

Beware of players on the tee of hole 13.








All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the areas outside the garden beds and beyond the bollards.

OB is marked by string and flags.









All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including all property and beyond.

Beware of players on hole 9 nearby.










All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including roads and property and beyond.

If you don't pass to the right of the Mando marked **M** then take a penalty stroke and proceed to the dropzone marked **DZ**.








All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including the road and beyond.








All areas marked **OB** are Out of Bounds including all roads and property and beyond.

Beware of players around hole 17's basket and people around the HQ and playground.
