

2025 Cowtown Christmas Classic supported by Innova Caddy Book and Notes

Welcome to the 2025 Cowtown Christmas Classic supported by Innova on December 20, 2025 at Prado Regional Park in Chino, Ca. This is a PDGA sanctioned pro-am C-tier and Southern California Disc Golf Club event. All PDGA rules are in effect. Make sure you are aware of any updated rules. If you have any questions, talk to the tournament director before the event starts.

Every player is required to keep score. PDGA live score will be the primary way to keep score for the event. Go to pdga.com/score to access the score card or download the PDGA Live app. Use access code **ccc25** to create your scorecard. This will be used for both rounds. If you are unable to do digital scoring, paper scorecards are available. See one of the tournament staff members to get a paper score card. Be sure to put your name, division, and which round the card is for on the card so we know that you submitted a scorecard for the round. The scorecard needs to be submitted to the staff at tournament central at the completion of each round.

All parking lots are OB. Paved roads and beyond are OB. The lake is OB. Players are allowed a 2-meter relief from the lake only for safety reasons. All areas past construction fences and park boundary fences are OB. Please keep searches for any lost disc to 3 minutes max. There will be time to look during lunch and after the event. There is no 2 meter rule.

If there are two players tied for first place only at the end of both rounds, the players will compete in an aggregate playoff using holes 1, 2, 19. If scores are still tied, sudden death playoff will be used on the same holes in the same order. The order of tee off will rotate each hole. A coin flip or another method will determine the starting order.

If there are any questions during play or after the round, come talk to Josh or Nate (TDs) for a resolution. If unsure how to play a hole, use the provisional rule.

Hole 1: 275 ft.

Hole 2: Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. 360 ft.

Hole 3: 375 ft.

Hole 4: 325 ft.

Hole 5: 270 feet

Hole 6: 210 ft.

Hole 7: Mandatory left of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. 195 feet

Hole 8: 310 ft.

Hole 9: Double mandatory between the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. 268 ft.

Hole 10: Double mandatory between the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. 280 ft.

Hole 11: 339 ft.

Hole 12: Double mandatory between the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. 305 ft.

Hole 13: Double mandatory between the marked tree and the marked pole. Drop zone if missed. 270 ft.

Hole 14: 300 ft

Hole 15: Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. If a disc is lost on the tee shot only, player may proceed to the drop zone or from where it was last in bounds.

235 ft

Hole 16: Mandatory left of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. 280 ft.

Hole 17: 260 ft.

Hole 18: 330 ft.

Hole 19: Double mandatory between the marked trees, Proceed to drop zone if missed. 285 ft.
