Sand Creek Disc Golf Ground Rules

1. Water plays as out of bounds (OB). Take a drop one meter in from the last point your disc crossed in bounds.
2. Ball golf greens play as OB. The fringe of the ball golf green plays as in bounds. The OB line is defined by the last continuous line of fringe. Take a drop one meter in from the last point your disc crossed in bounds.
3. The perimeter road and beyond plays as OB (except hole 17). Where there is a curb present on the inbounds side of the road, the curb plays as the OB line. In all other areas the OB line is defined by the last continuous grass line on the inbounds side of the road. Take a drop one meter in from the last point your disc crossed in bounds.
4. A missed **single mando** results in a drop within three meters inside and parallel to the mando which was missed.
5. A missed **double mando** results in a drop anywhere on the direct plane between the two mandos.
6. Sand bunkers play as hazards. Play your disc from where it lands. The hazard line is defined by the lip of the bunker. If there is no lip clearly present then the hazard line is defined by the last continuous line of grass.
7. All of the above results in a one stroke penalty.
8. Casual relief may be taken from non-permanent standing water as well as the drainage holes which are found near the perimeter of the course. No other casual relief exists on the course outside of normal PDGA rules.

Sand Creek Disc Golf: Short Tee Caddie Book

* If no special rule(s) applies to the hole then refer to the above ground rules. Special rules in the Caddy Book below supersede the ground rules.

*The Caddy Book below lists prominent features and OBs of each hole in order to assist the player, but does not list all features, OBs and hazards.

*All distances are approximate.

*Please do not walk on the ball golf greens.

*If you throw a disc into a water hazard and one of the groundskeepers goes into the water to retrieve it for you, please tip him\her 50 baht.

Hole 1 - Par 3 217ft\66m

- a. There is water to the right of the tee.
- b. There is a sand hazard in front of the target area.

Hole 2 - Par 3 158ft\48m

- a. There is a sand hazard to the left of the target area.

Hole 3 - Par 4 506ft\154m

- a. Off the tee, there is water to the left and to the right.
- b. There is water in front of and to the left of the target.

Hole 4 - Par 3 171ft\52m

- a. There is a sand hazard and ball golf green in front of the target.
- b. There is water to the left, right and behind the target.

Hole 5 - Par 4 399ft\122m

- a. There is water directly in front of the tee.
- b. As you approach the target area, please be aware of, and yield to, players teeing off on hole 6.

Hole 6 - Par 3 227ft\69m

- a. There is a mando to the left of the target area which players must pass on the right. There are two mando signs on this same tree. Only the mando facing the short tee box applies to short tee players. The other mando is for the long tees.
- b. There is a ball golf green and four sand hazards around target area.
- c. There is water behind the target area.

Hole 7 - Par 3 238ft\73m

- a. There is water directly in front of the tee as well as to the left of the fairway.
- b. There are two single mandos which players must pass on the left.
- c. Please be cautious of red ants around the target area.

Hole 8 - Par 4 436ft\133m

- a. Please be cautious of red ants around the tee area.
- b. Off the tee, there is water to the left and to the right of the fairway.
- c. There is a ball golf green and sand hazards on the far right of the target area.

Hole 9 - Par 3 167ft\51m

- a. There is water all around the target area.
- a. If a player's tee shot enters the water hazard, then they proceed to the drop zone to the left of the target area. For any subsequent shots that enter the water hazard normal ob rules apply.
- b. There are two sand hazards and a ball golf green in front of the target area.
- c. All land beyond the water on the right (near the hole 10 long tee) is OB. Players have the same OB options as listed above in 9b.

Hole 10 - Par 4 388ft\118m (as the crow flies)

- a. The ob perimeter road is on the left side for the entirety of the hole.
- b. There is a water hazard on the right side of the fairway which curves to the right towards the target area.
- c. All land beyond the water on the right side (near the hole 9 long tee and hole 8 target area) is OB.
- d. There is a sand hazard on the left side of the fairway.

Hole 11 - Par 3 206ft\63m

- a. The perimeter road is on the left side for the entirety of the hole.
- b. There is a ball golf green and sand hazard to the right of the target area.
- c. The perimeter road curves to the right, directly behind the target area.

Hole 12 - Par 3 174ft\53m

- a. There is water directly behind the target area.
- b. Please be aware of, and yield to, players teeing off on the hole 13 long tee.

Hole 13 - Par 5 543ft\166m

- a. There is a river on the left side of the fairway. All land beyond the river is also OB.
- b. There is a water hazard in front of the target area.
- c. There is a ball golf green to the right of the target area.

Hole 14 - Par 3 193ft\59m

- a. There is a "giant squid" sand hazard to the left of the target area.

Hole 15 - Par 3 231ft\70m

- a. There is a "giant squid" sand hazard and a ball golf green on the right side of the fairway.

Hole 16 - Par 4 329ft\101m

- a. The ob perimeter road is on the left side for the entirety of the hole.
- b. There is a mando near the tee area that players must pass to the left of.
- c. There is a water hazard directly in front of the target area. For the left portion of the water hazard, OB is marked by flags and/or a spray painted line. For the right portion of the water hazard, OB is marked by the waterline.
- d. On the target side of the water hazard there is a mando which players must pass on the left.

Hole 17 - Par 4 424ft\129m

- a. There is a mando off the tee which players must pass on the right.
- b. There is an additional mando further down the fairway which protects the hole 18 tee box. Players may pass this mando to the left or not pass it at all. If this mando is missed then there is drop zone marked directly next to it.
- c. The perimeter road and beyond is inbounds for the entire hole.
- d. There is a concrete wall behind the target area. Beyond the concrete wall is OB. The side of the concrete wall nearest the target area serves as the OB line.

Hole 18 - Par 3 206ft\63m

- a. The ob perimeter road is on the left side and curves left just before the target area.
- b. There are two sand hazards and a ball golf green to the right of the target area.
- c. There is a thin dike behind the target area. The dike and beyond are OB. The beginning of the dike, on the side nearest the target, marks the start of the OB area.
- d. The parking lot, and any concrete behind the target area, is OB.
