OUT OF BOUNDS & HAZARD

OB is defined by red stakes, where not present, by water, fencing net.

Footpath and Gutter are **NOT OB**.

Parking are **OB**

Hazard on hole 1, 2 (13p) & 3 (12p)

CTPs

CTP cash applies to Round 1/2 (26 holes) & round 3 on holes 1 & 2 (13p)

SERVICES

The nearest bathroom and bar services are at the Club House near the castle

SCORING

At least three player per group must enter scores on PDGA. Online scoring at pdga.com/score
Assess code: **BNT2**

Hole 1 : Hazard. Junior's Tee

Hole 2 : Mando – DZ

Hole 3 :

- Two Mando right (2 tennis lamp) and Two left (2 trees) – If you missed the 2 first mando's (left or right) go to DZ1,
- Between the mando's 1 & 2 you'll play classic OB if you don't cross the line wich define the mando's. OB line on left side is defined by the tennis fence, on the right by red flags.
- If you missed the 2 second mando's (left or right define by the line) go to DZ 2.

Hole 4 : Two Mando's – DZ, the DZ is also the junior's Tee

Hole 5 : OB line on the right side

Hole 6 : Parking OB, footpath IN

Hole 7 : OB line on the left side

Hole 8 : Mando – DZ between trees

Hole 9 : /

Hole 10 : OB line on the left side, parking OB, footpath IN

Hole 11 : OB line on right side

Hole 12 : Hazard, crossing hole => **priority group playing on 13**

Hole 13 : Hazard, **priority hole over hole 12**
