

The 2026 Challenge at Reidy Creek - Virtual Player Meeting!

Welcome, players, to The 2026 Challenge at Reidy Creek, presented by Innova Disc Golf and Dog Haus Disc Shop! We're excited to have you here in Escondido and look forward to some great disc golf this weekend.

Important Rules Information:

- The Challenge is a PDGA-sanctioned A-Tier tournament, and we are following the Player conduct rules outlined in Section 4.04 of the PDGA Competition Manual: no smoking or vaping during play, upper and lower body garments – no tank tops for men.
- Most of our tees use the golf cart paths. Black and yellow dots indicate the tee location – **the front of the tee is the pavement joint nearest the dot.**
- No 2-meter rule.
- All hole rules, tee designations and distances are listed in the PDGA Digital Scorecard. The Digital Scorecard is the official rules source for the tournament. There are links to the hole rules and the caddie book on the Disc Golf Scene “About” section.
- Please check in at the pro shop at least 15 minutes before your tee time. Tee times are published on PDGA.com (<https://www.pdga.com/tour/event/97579>)
- Check in at the first tee at least 5 minutes before your tee time. **Failure to be at the tee 5 minutes before earns a 2-throw penalty.**
- All OB lines are marked with white paint and/or white flags. All golf greens are OB. The OB line on golf greens is where the mow height changes. For a disc to be OB on a green you must be able to see “green” grass between the disc and “fairway” grass.
- All sand bunkers are Hazard, additional Hazard lines are marked with yellow paint and/or flags. We will be adding more paint lines to bunkers that have stray grass in them. General rule: Hazard begins where the sand and/or vertical face of the bunker begins.

Parking will be tight all weekend. If the golf course parking lot is full, there is space across the street in the city park.

Am player packs will be distributed after Round 1. Awards and payout will be distributed on Sunday after each division completes play.

Each Amateur card will compete for a CTP on Saturday and Sunday. All Amateur ladies will be competing for a Byrdey Cage practice basket – whoever scores better against their PDGA rating wins!

Please do not pull or push carts on the golf greens!

After your round, pull up a stool and watch the fun on Hole 18! Ties for first place (or for USDGC & Throw Pink invitations will be played on Hole 18 on a loop (if needed).

Central Coast Disc Golf will be filming the MPO feature/lead card and Disconnected will be filming FPO. Feel free to spectate after you play and invite your friends to join the galleries.
