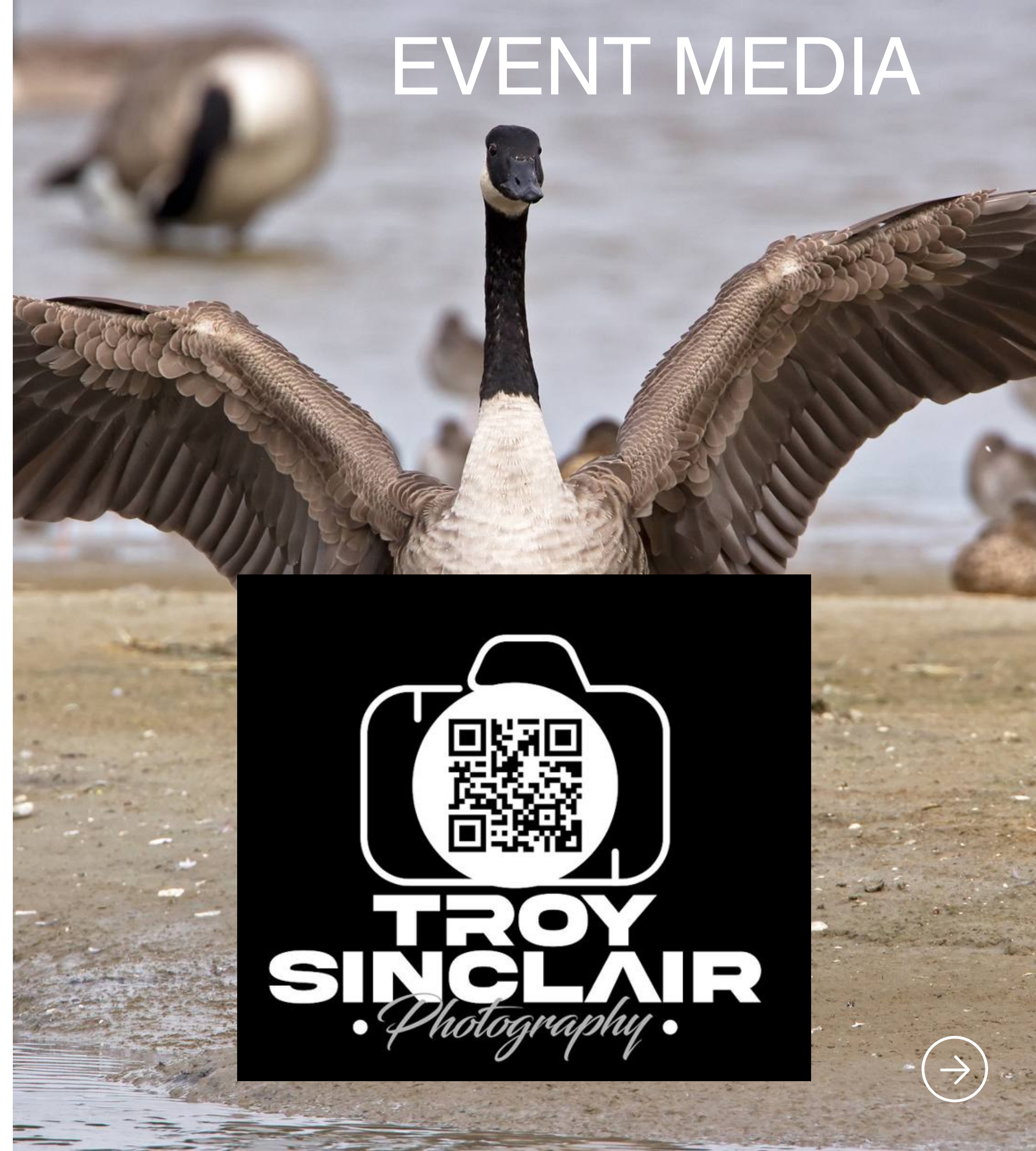

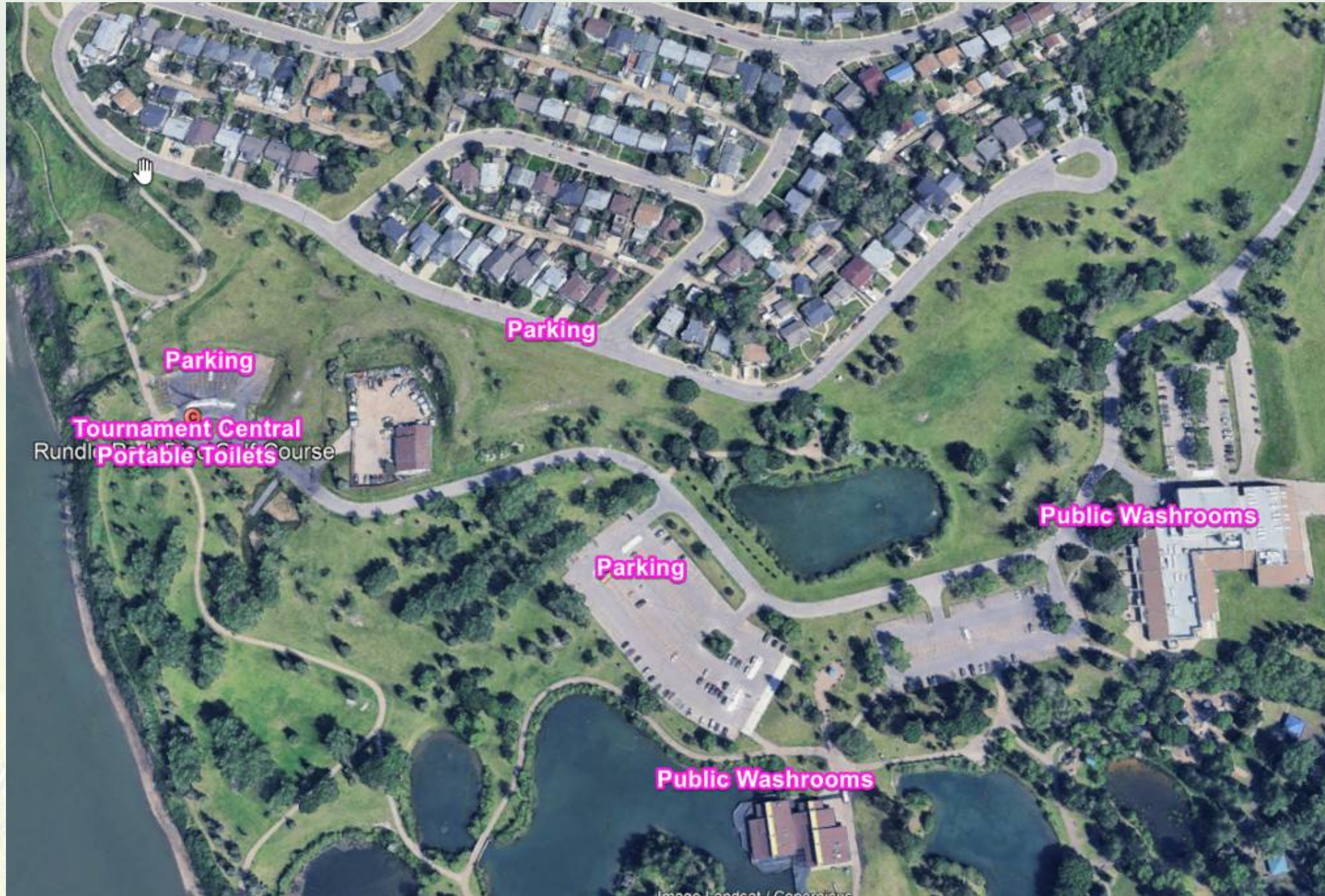

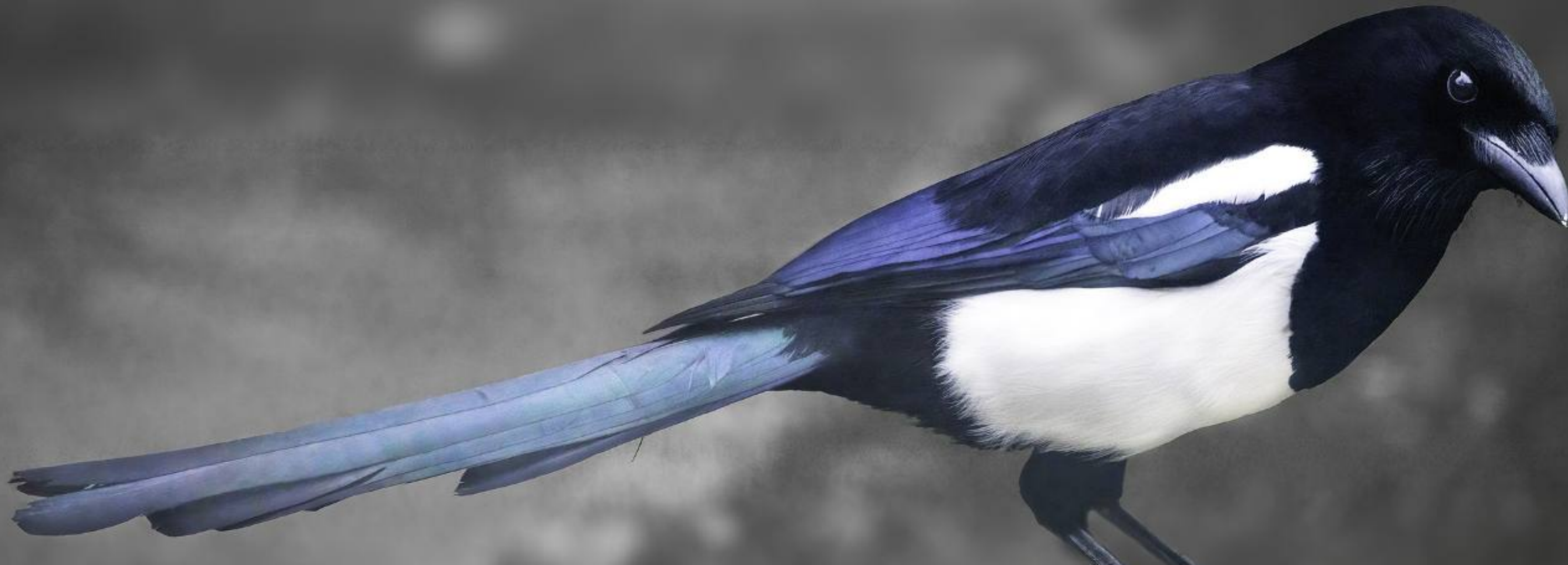

SCORING & RULES

The live scoring code is [29RCC](#)

All players are required to keep score electronically or using a paper scorecard

If there are scoring disputes, please speak to a Tournament director before submitting your scores for the round.

Playoffs will be sudden death, playing holes 1, 17, 18 (Rundle) or 1 & 18 (Hermitage) on repeat until there is a winner.

We are playing with full PDGA rules with no two metre rule. Drinking, smoking, and vaping during play is not permitted. Dress code will not be strictly enforced.



- All distances are approximate.
- Some hole layouts may be subject to change depending on weather conditions.
- Unless otherwise specified on a hole description, discs fully surrounded by concrete or gravel are considered out of bounds.
- If there is standing water on the course outside of the normal bodies of water on the course, you may take casual relief by marking along the line of play a new lie which is farther from the target and no farther than the nearest lie where the marker disc and lie are outside the casual area.
- OB may be marked with white stakes, flags, or paint to indicate the OB area.
- Mandos will have a line painted to indicate the restricted space.



COURSE MAPS & OUT OF BOUNDS



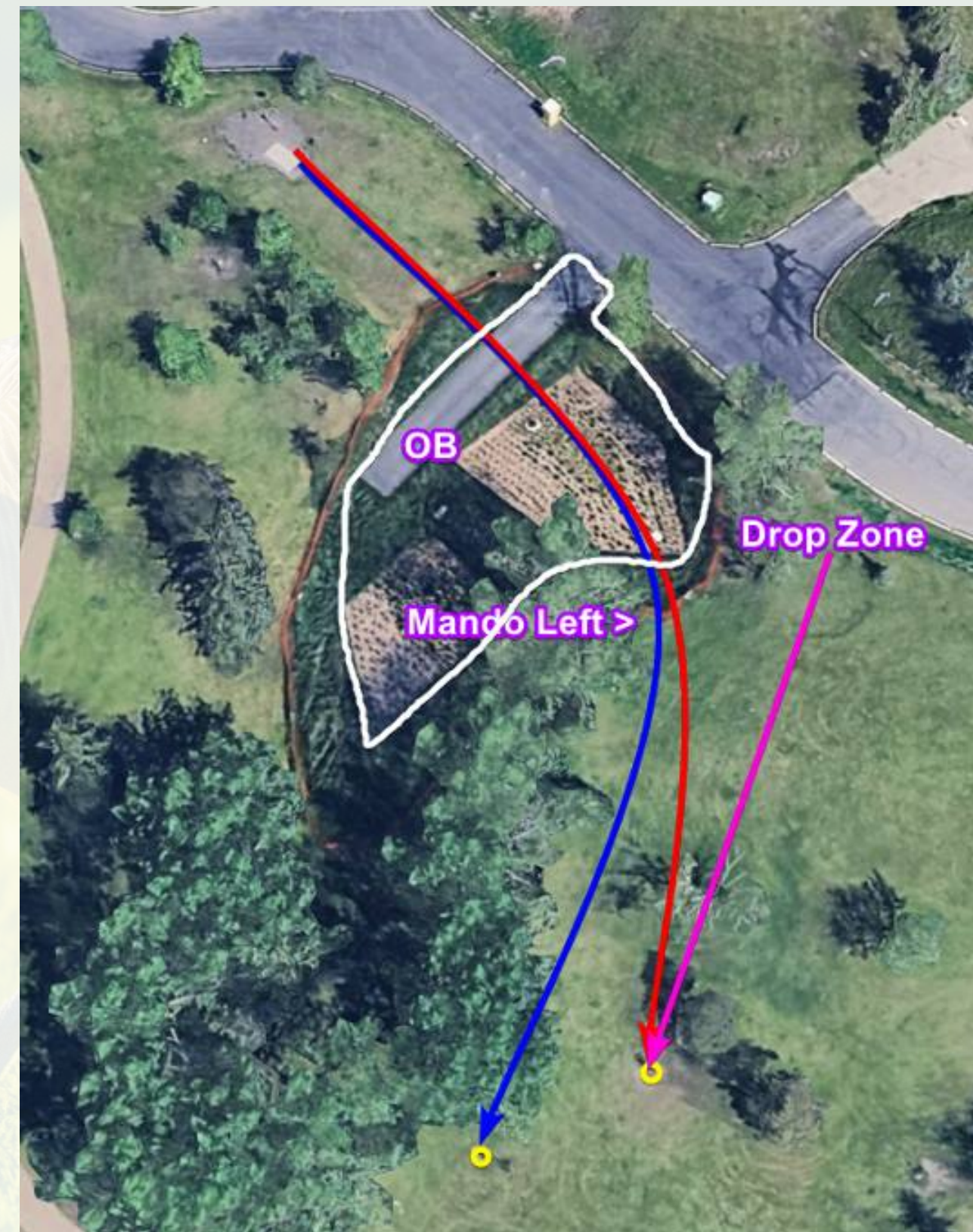
Rundle Hole 1

Par 3 - 142/288/318 ft

Gulley and concrete path in front of tee pad is OB. Road, walking path, and beyond are OB.

OB before crossing the mando proceeds to drop zone. OB after is played as point of entry.

Mando left of marked tree. If missed mando, proceed to drop zone/short tee near the road past the marked tree.

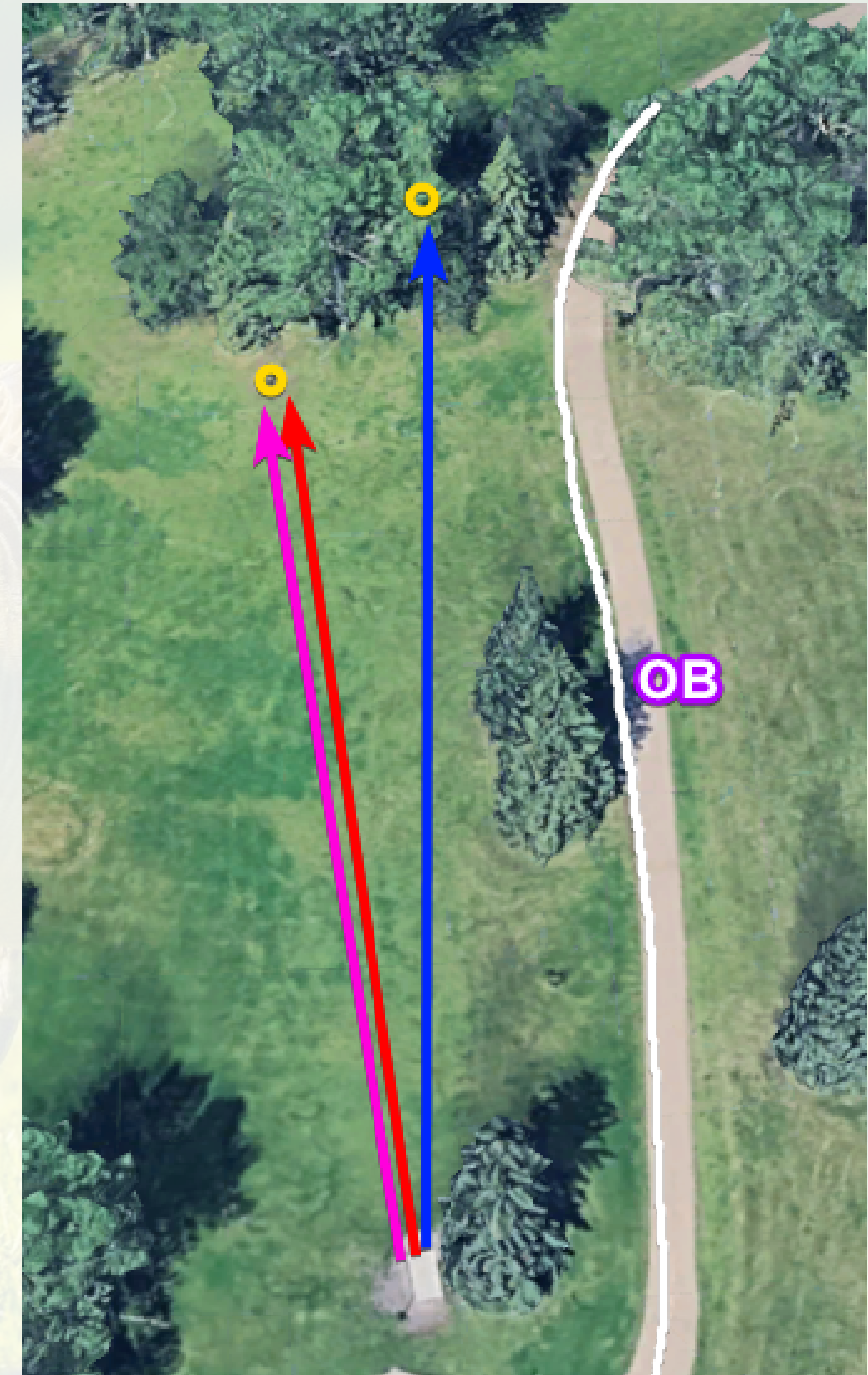


Rundle Hole 2

Par 3 - 210/210/282 ft

Walking path and beyond is OB.

OB is played as point of entry.

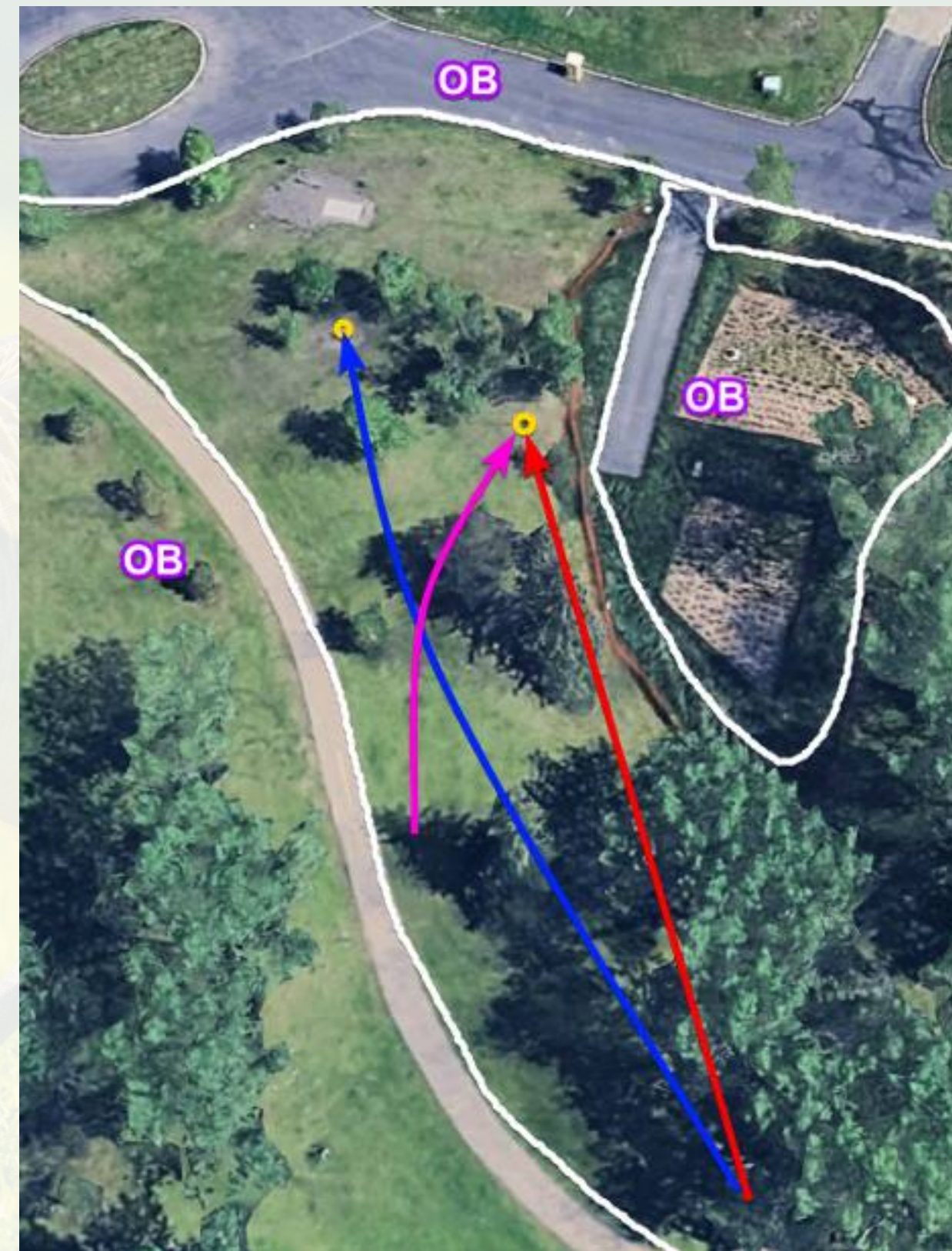


Rundle Hole 3

Par 3 - 106/192/240 ft

Gulley and concrete path in front of Hole 1 tee pad is OB. Road, walking path and beyond are OB.

OB is played as point of entry.



Rundle Hole 4

Par 3 – 130/231/220

Road and beyond are OB.

Maintenance yard is OB. Do not attempt to enter the yard to retrieve lost discs.

OB is played as point of entry.

Par 3 – 147/147/147ft

Road and beyond is OB.

Maintenance yard is OB.

Marked bush is OB.

OB is played as point of entry.



Rundle Hole 6

Par 3 – 165/264/372 ft

Road, Walking path and beyond are OB. OB is played as point of entry.

Mando right of marked tree, proceed to drop zone.

Drop zone is beside mando tree



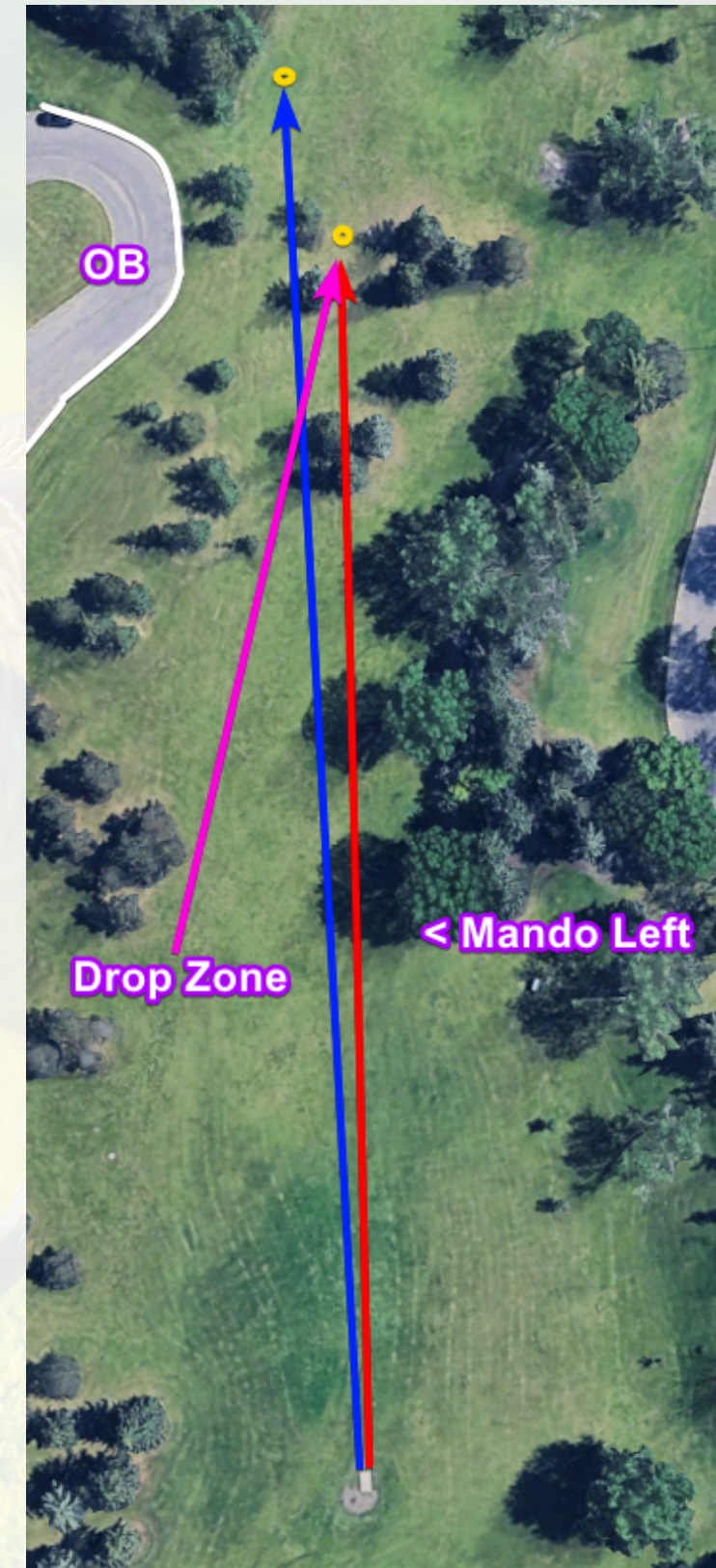
Rundle Hole 7

Mando left of marked tree.

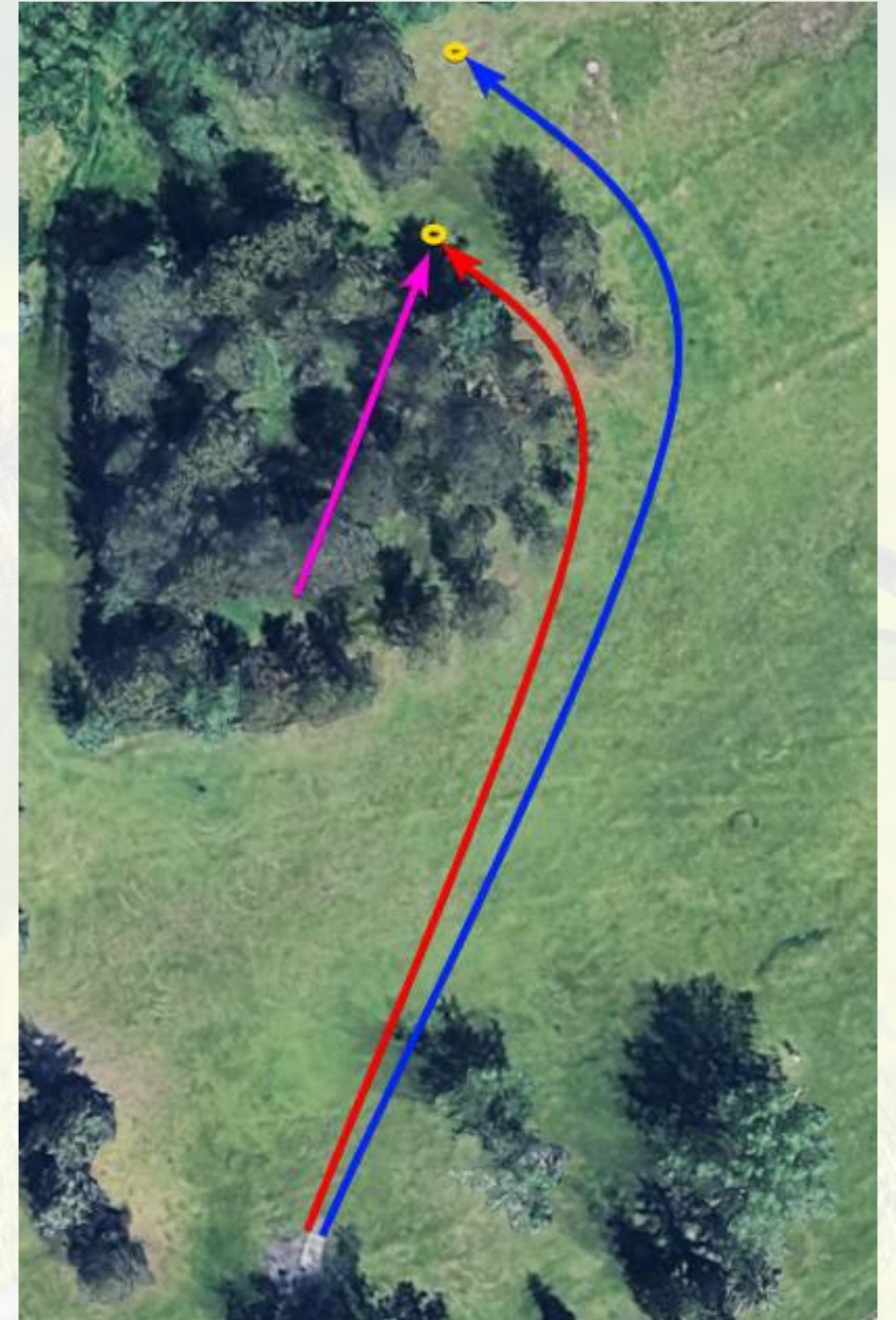
Dropzone is beside the mando tree.

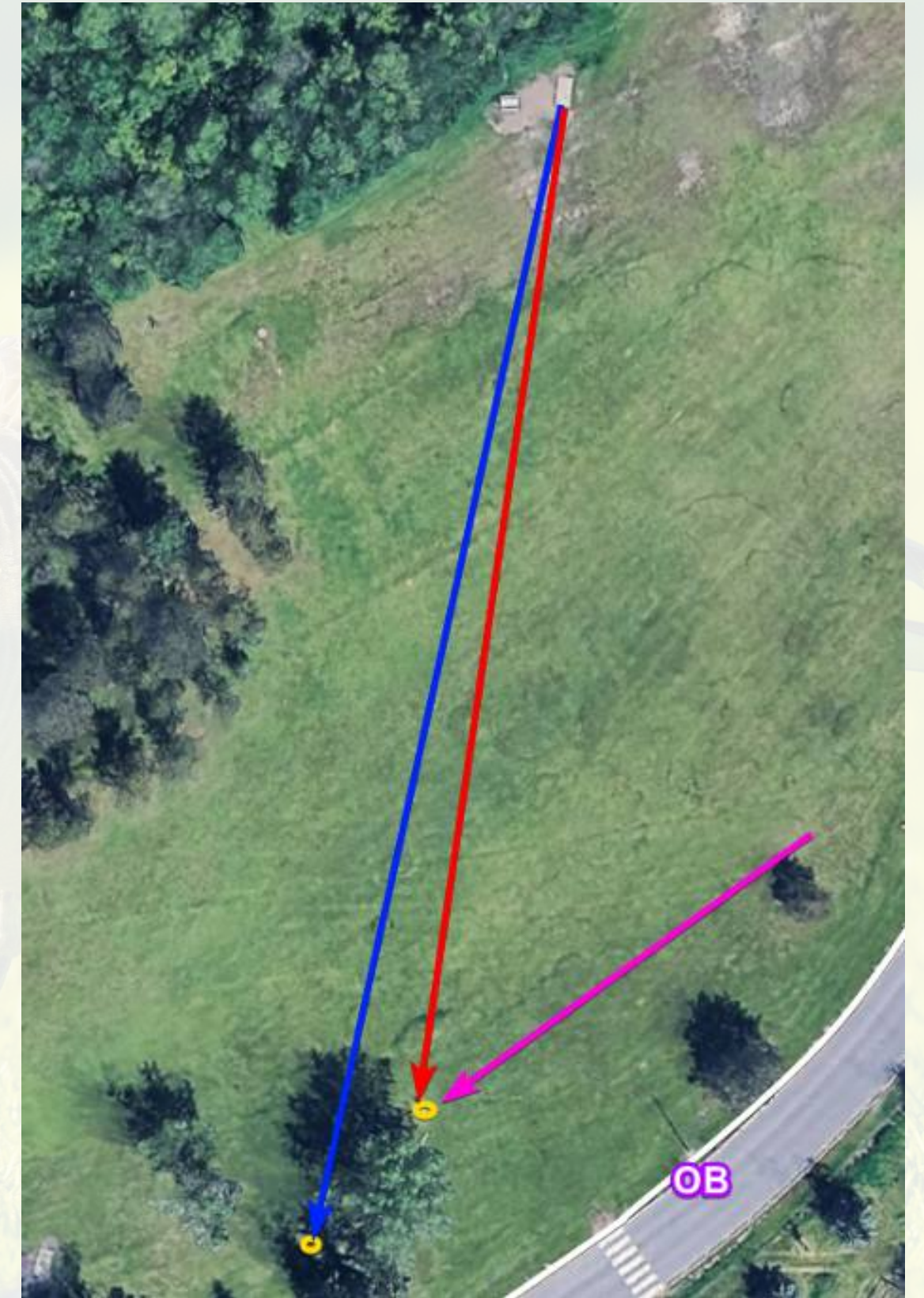
Road and beyond are OB.

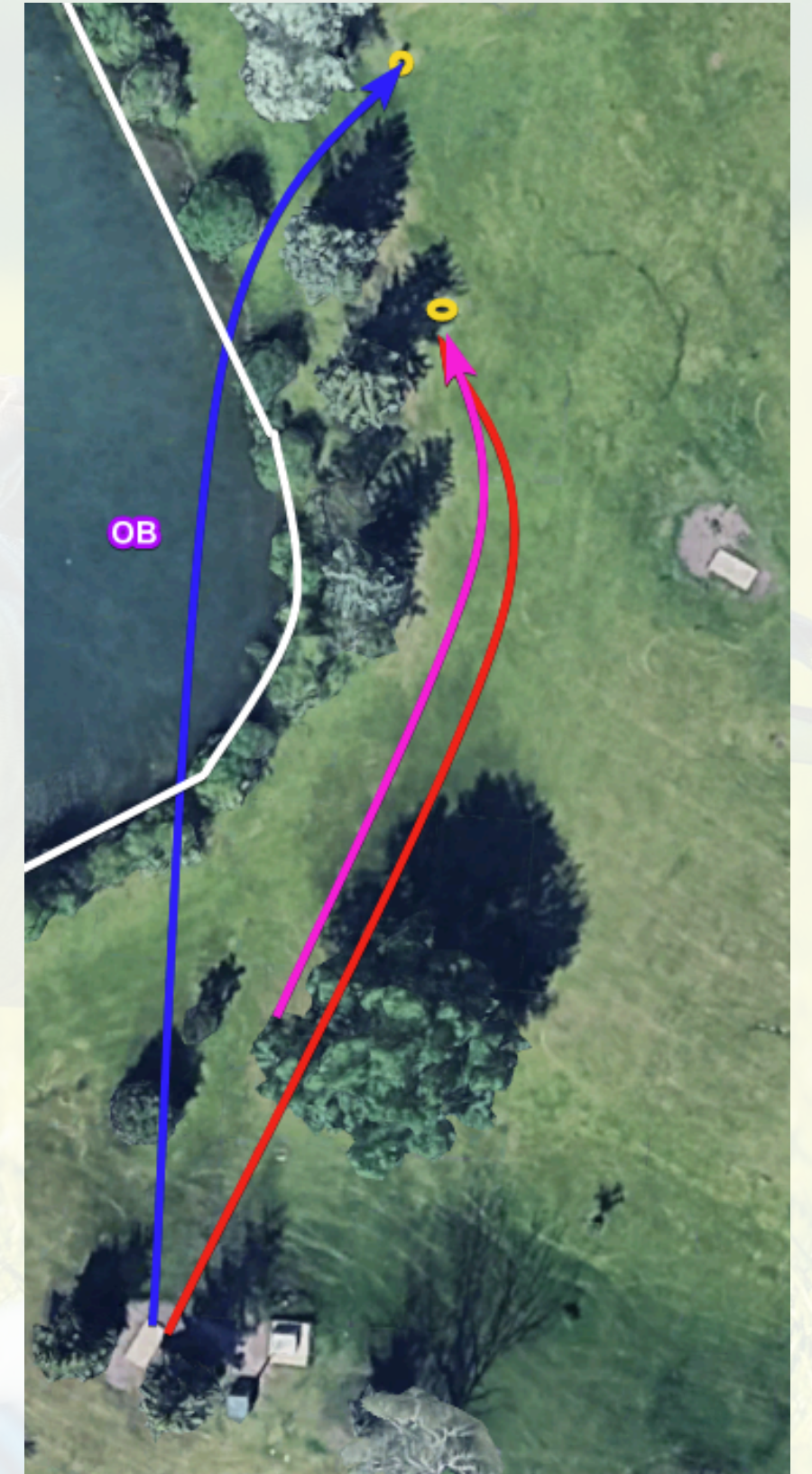

OB is played as point of entry.

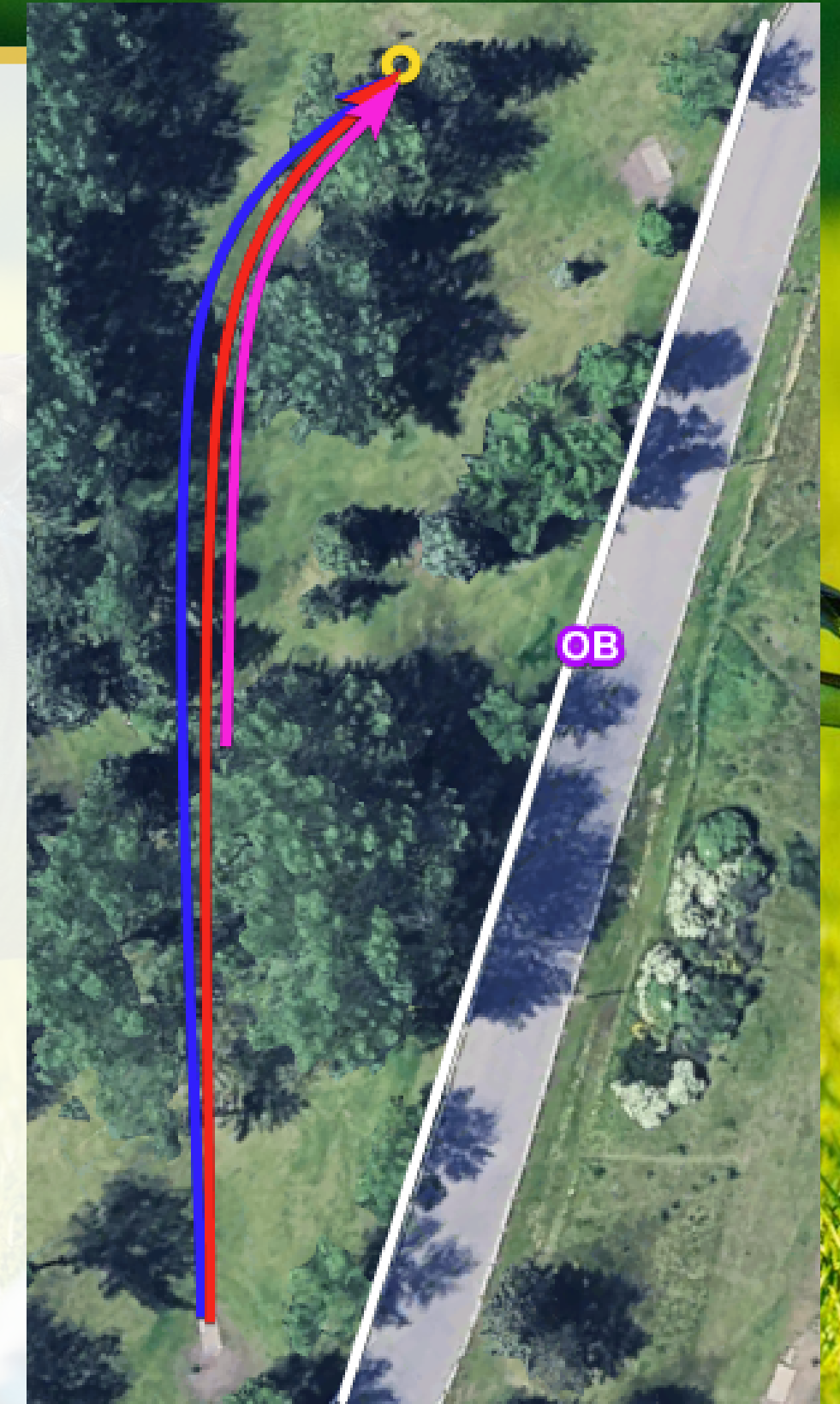

OB is played as point of entry.



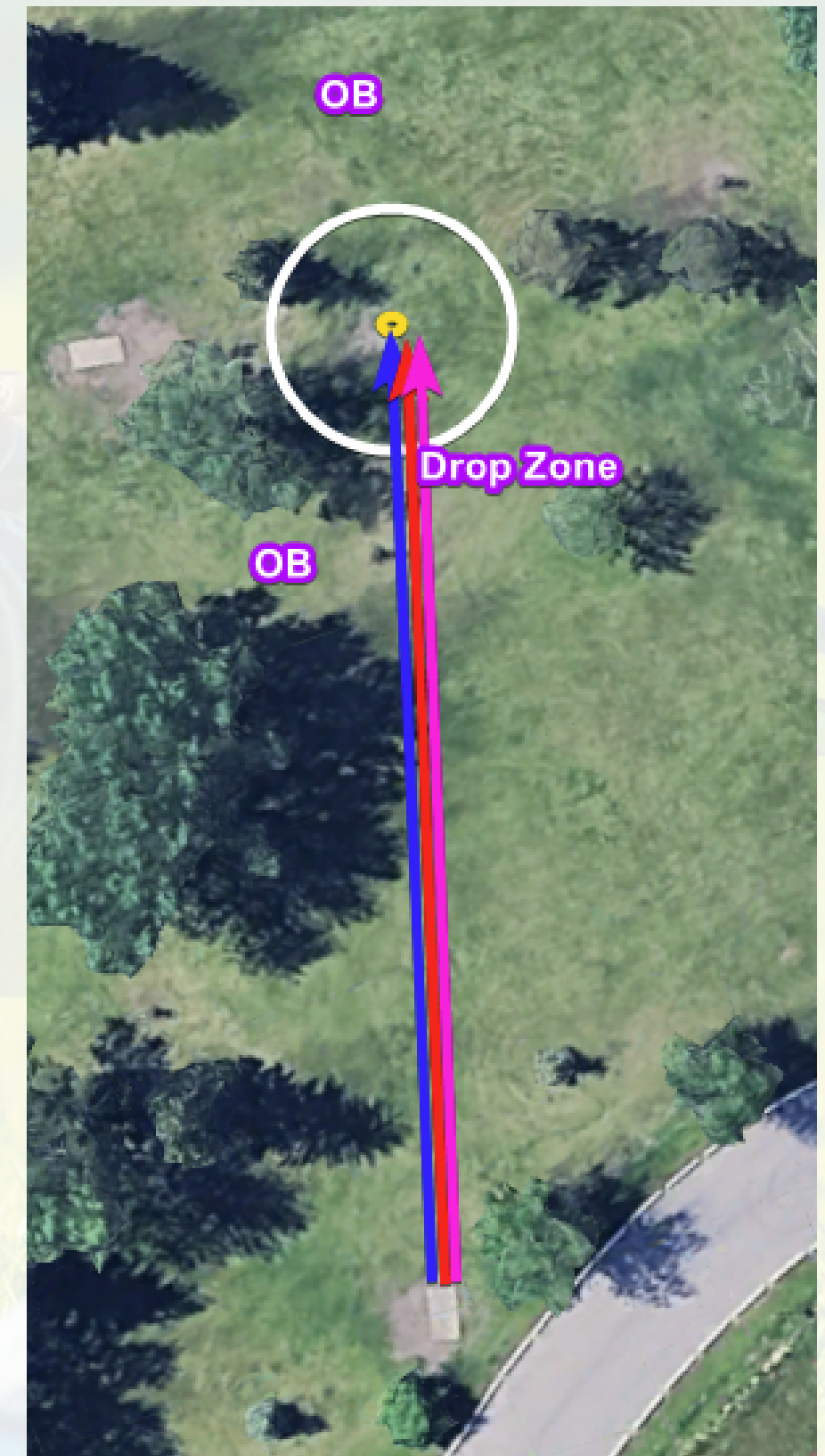
Rundle Hole 14

and beyond are OB.

OB is played as point of entry.

Mando is not in effect.

OB is played as point of entry.



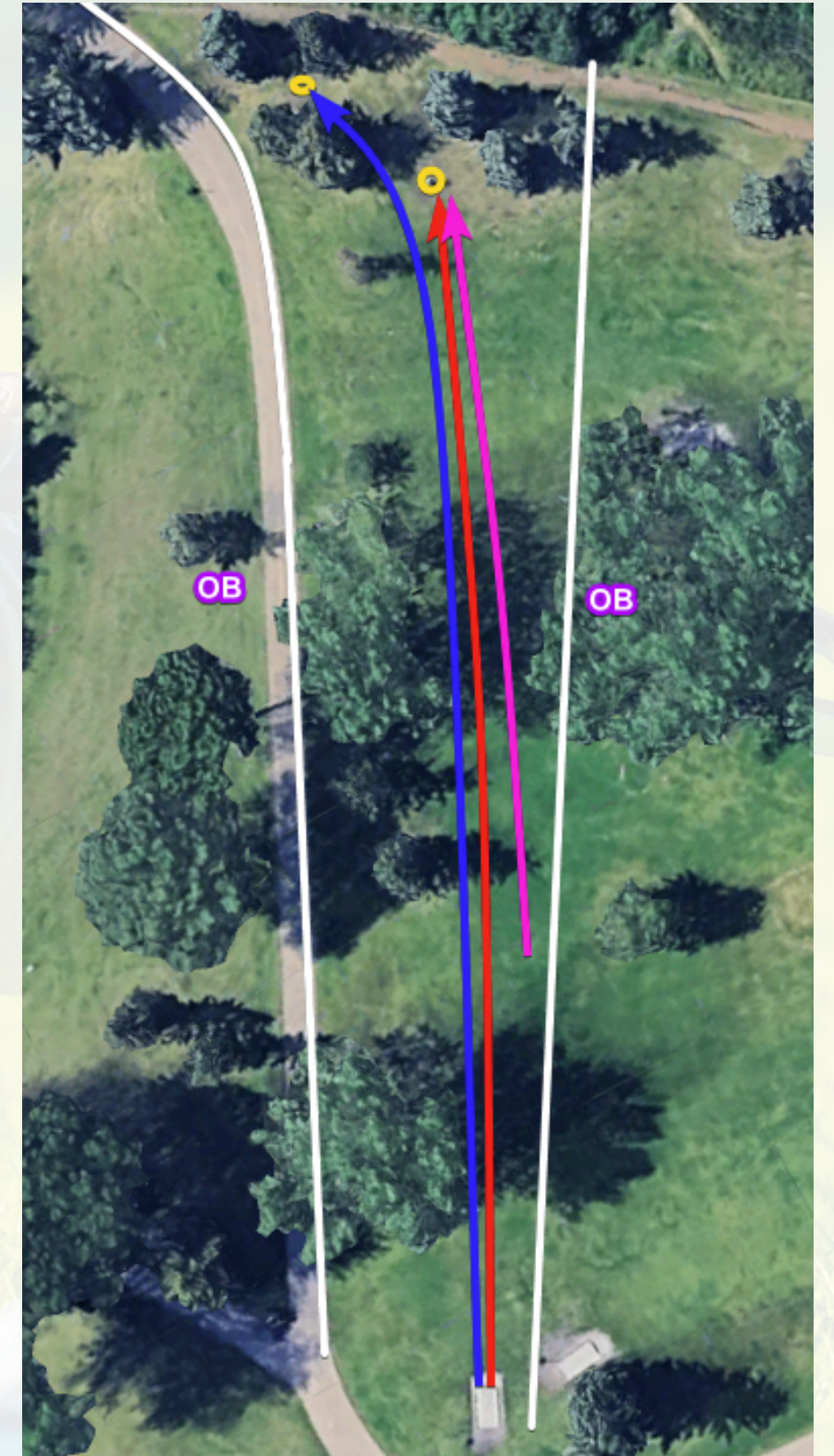
Rundle Hole 17

Par 3 - 161/282/309 ft

Walking path and beyond are OB.

Marked area on the right (towards hole 18 tee pad) is OB.

OB is played as point of entry.

Par 4 - 325/574/620ft

Water, walking path and beyond are
OB.

OB is played as point of entry.

Mando left of marked tree. Dropzone
is the short tee in the fairway left of
the marked tree.



Rundle Ghost Hole

POOL B ONLY

After completing hole 18, start a 7 minute timer.

During this time feel free to visit the trail house, use the washrooms, etc. Practicing during this time is prohibited.

Proceed to hole 1 once the timer expires.

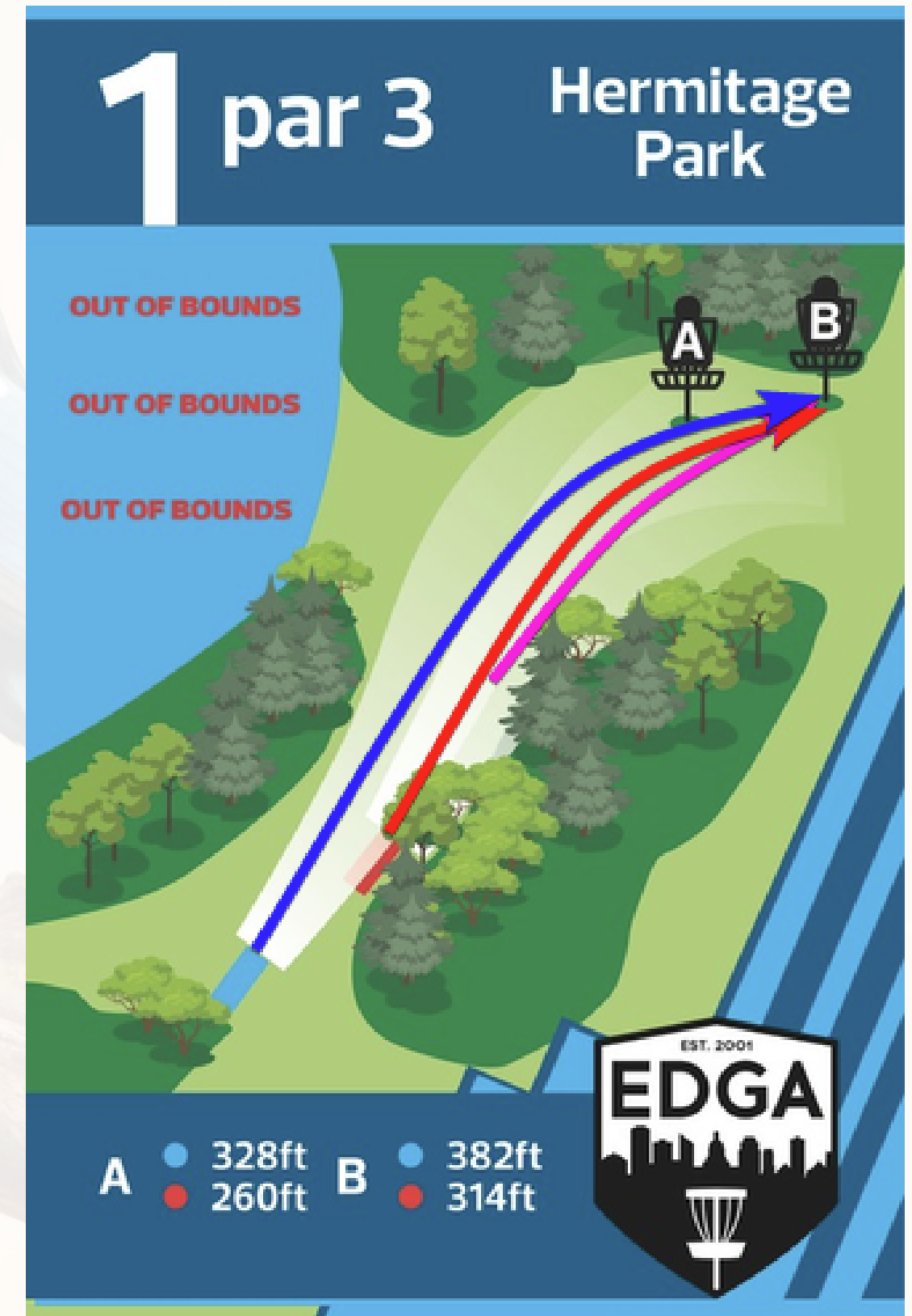


Hermitage Hole 1

OB is played as point of entry



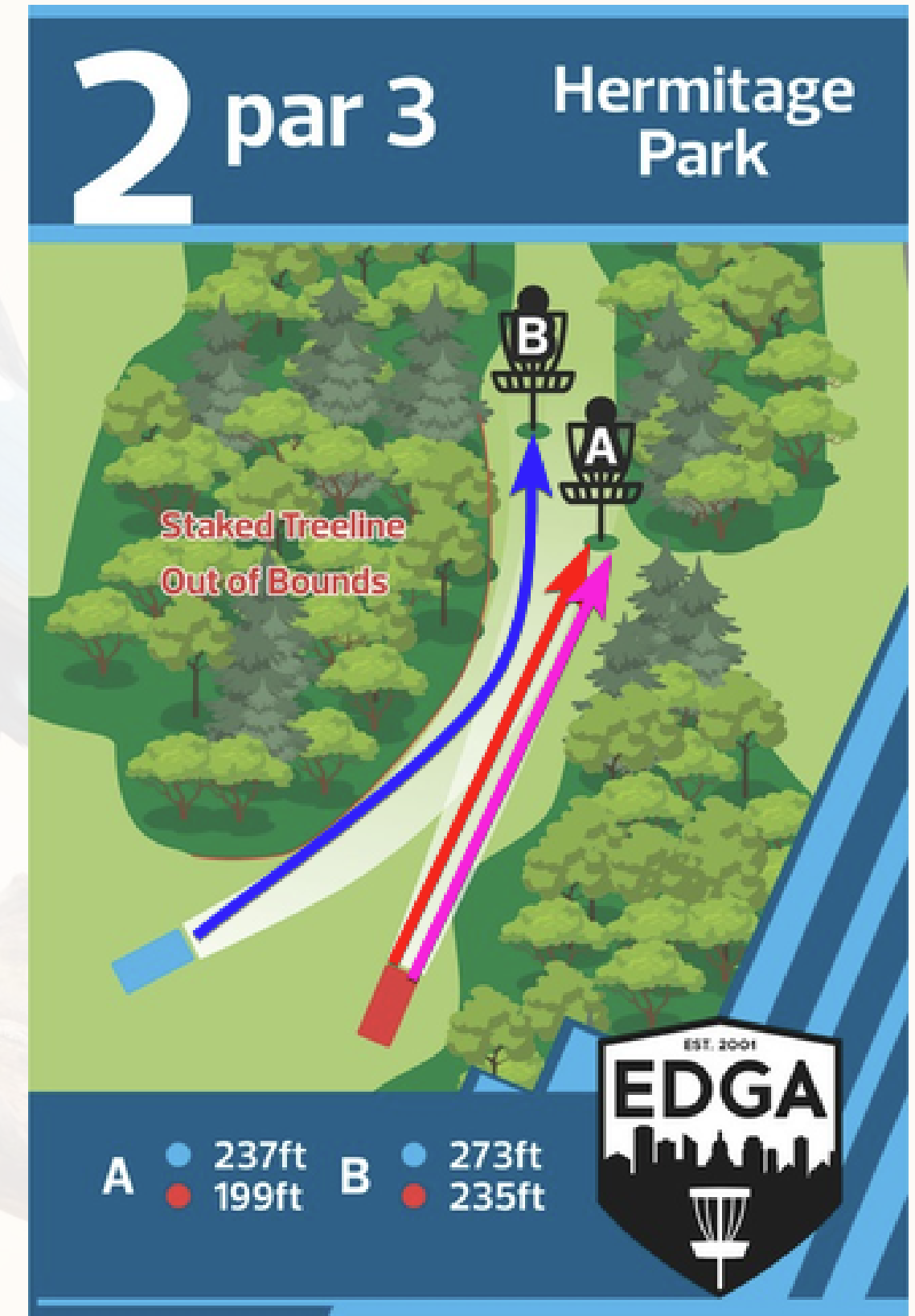
Hermitage Hole 2

OB is played as point of entry



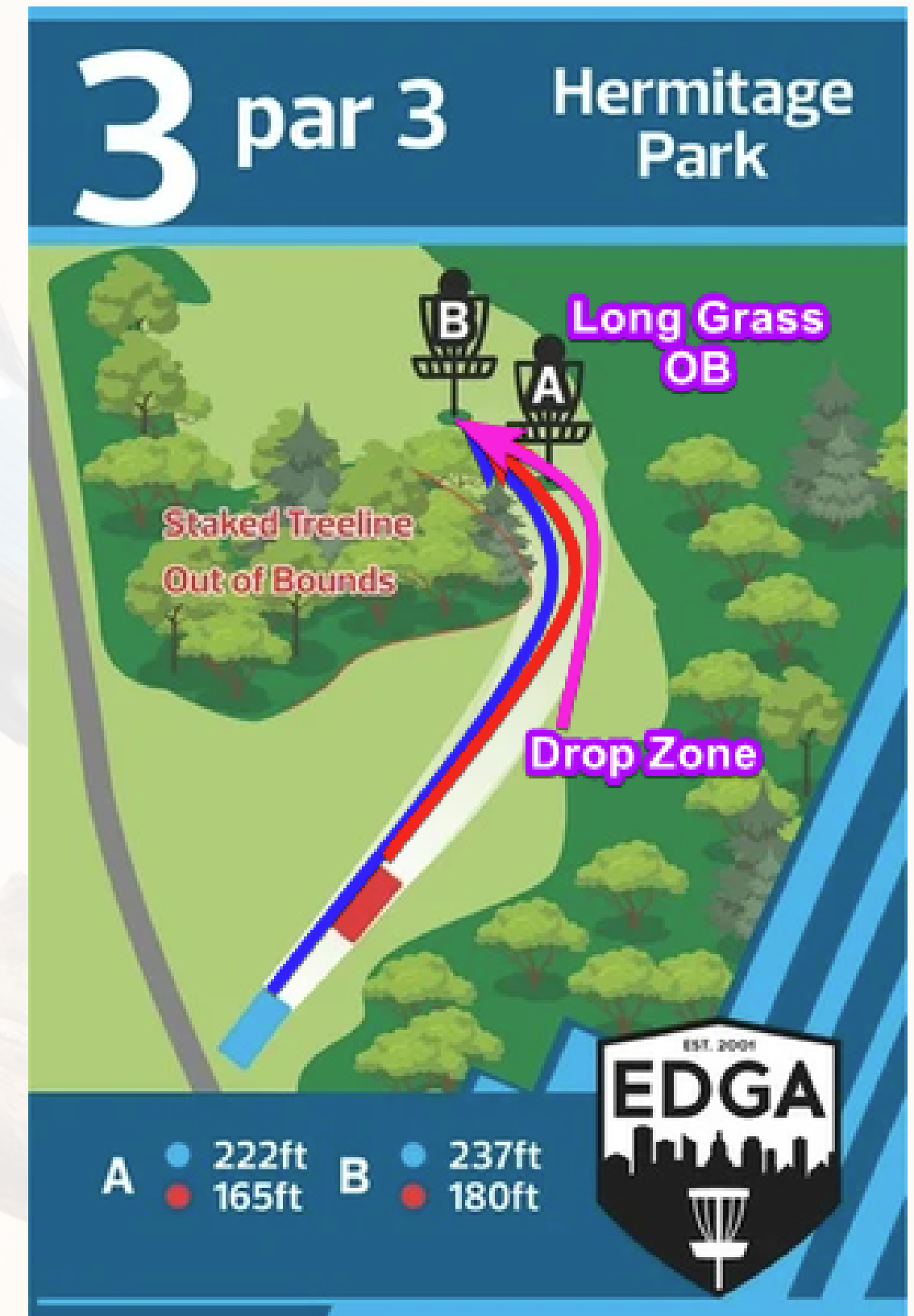
Hermitage Hole 3

Played as point of entry



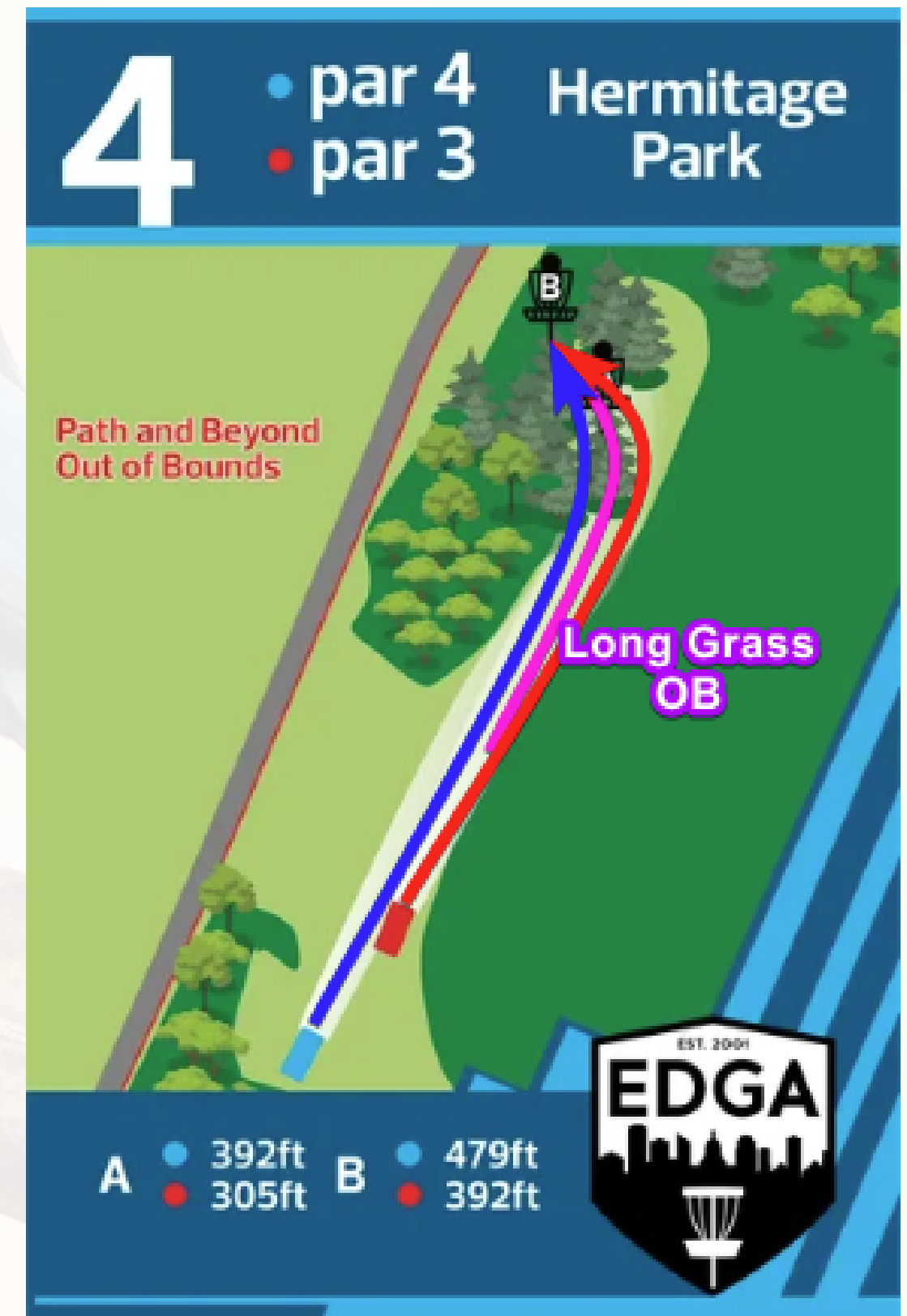
Hermitage Hole 4

OB is played as point of entry.

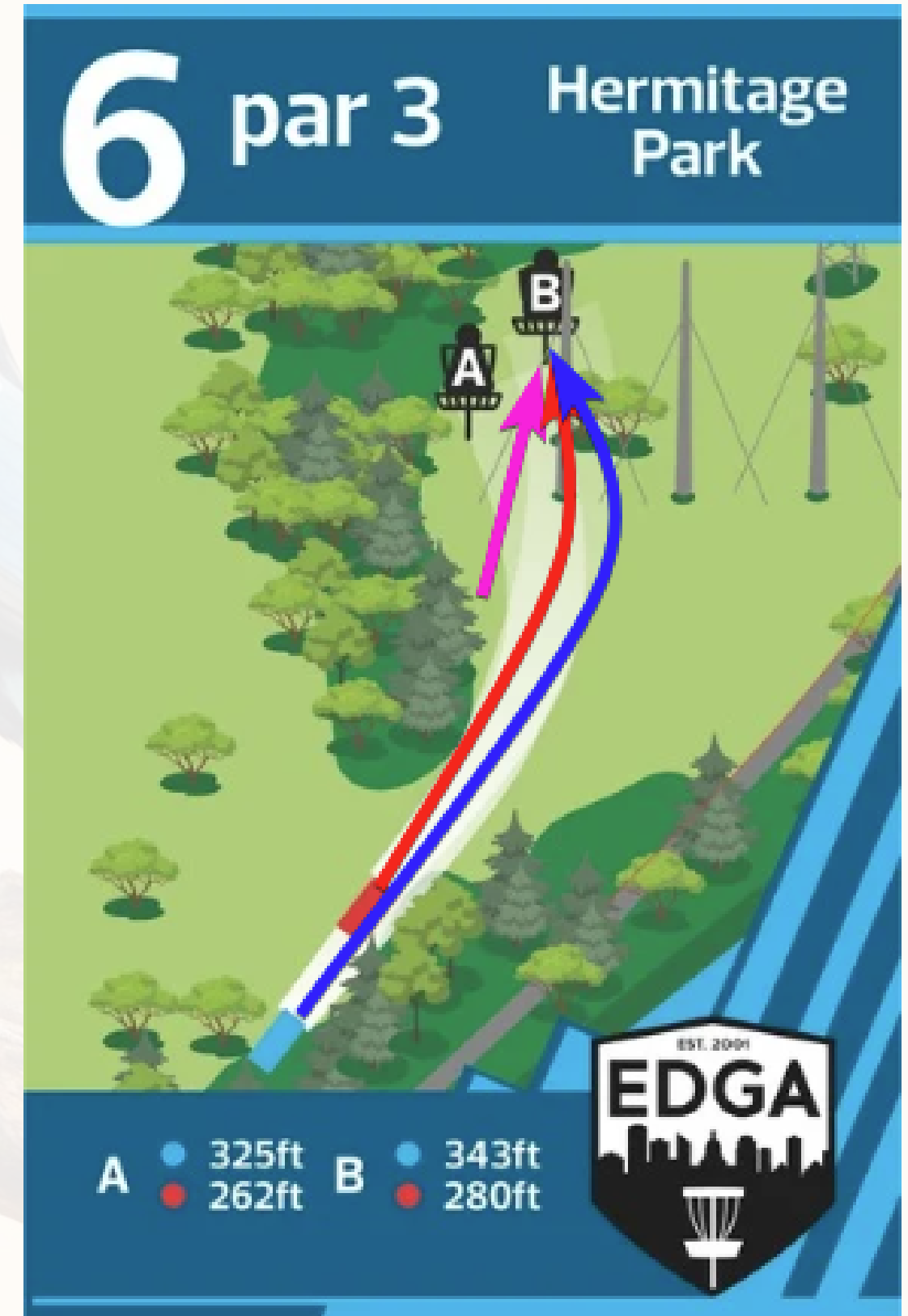


Hermitage Hole 6

Hazard is not in play for short layout players.

White flagged OB behind the basket is played as point of entry.



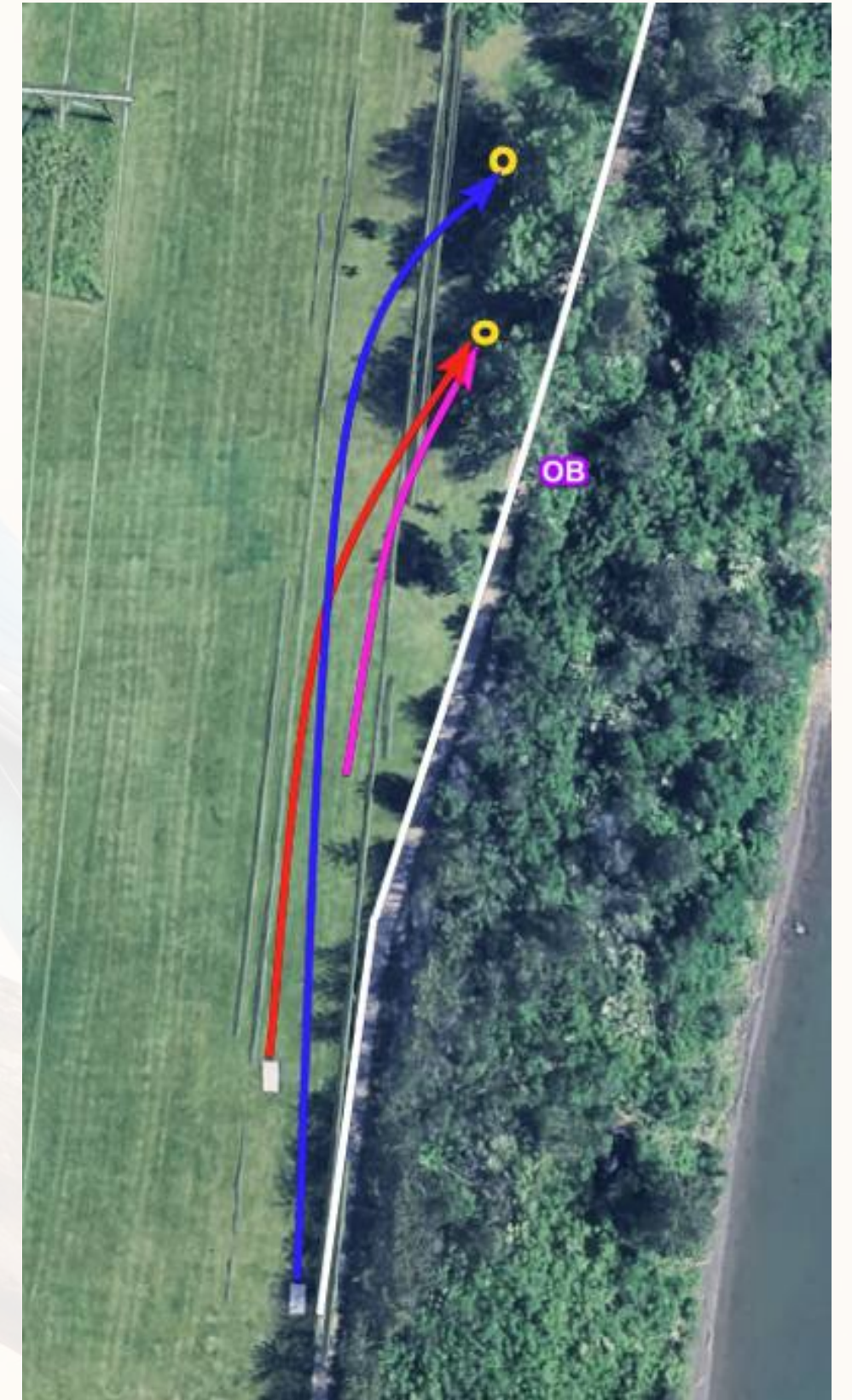
Hermitage Hole 9

Par 3 141/191/191 ft

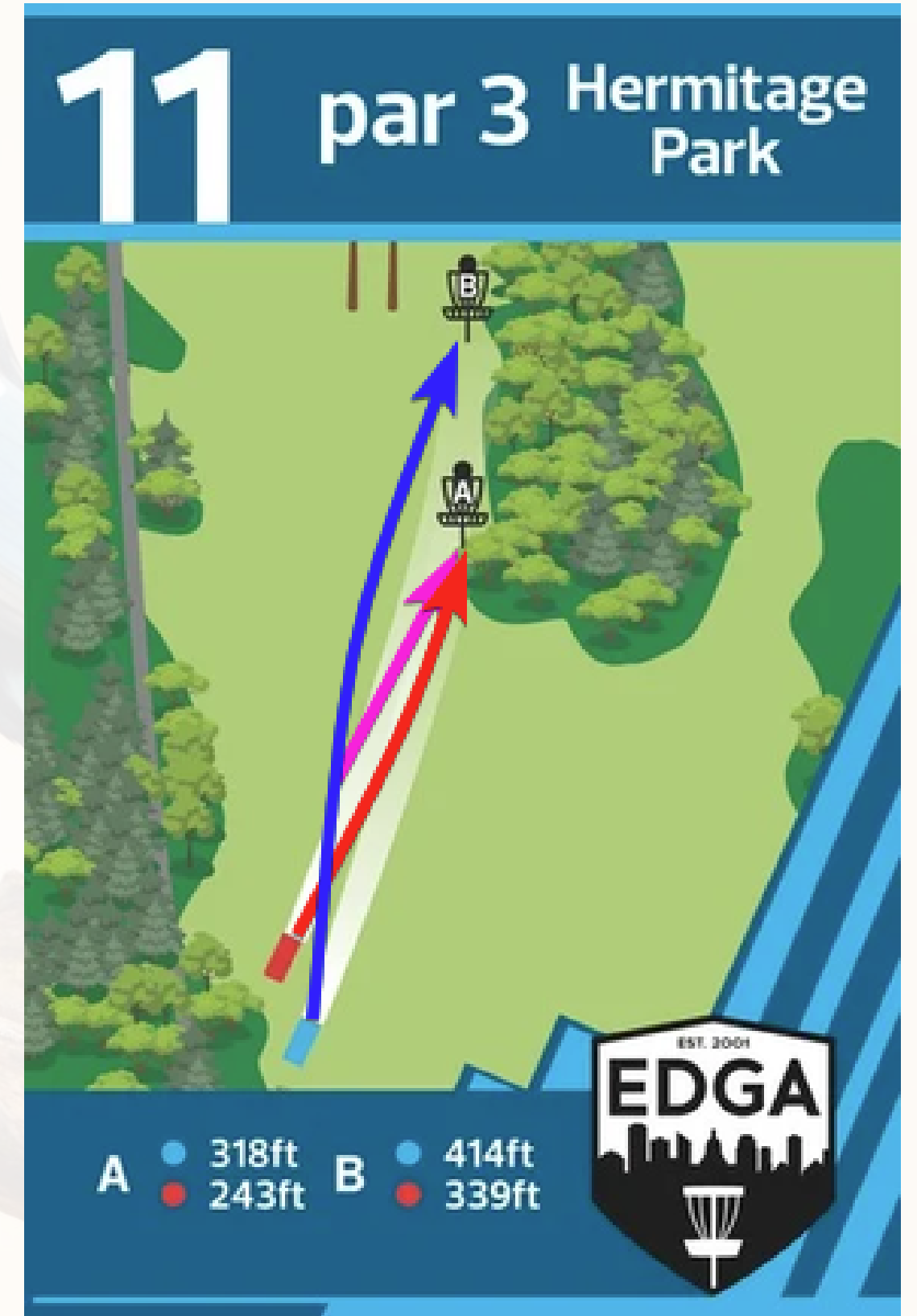
Three, double mandos between marked trees. Painted drop zone between each set of mandos.

Gravel path and beyond is OB and played as point of entry.

OB is played as point of entry.

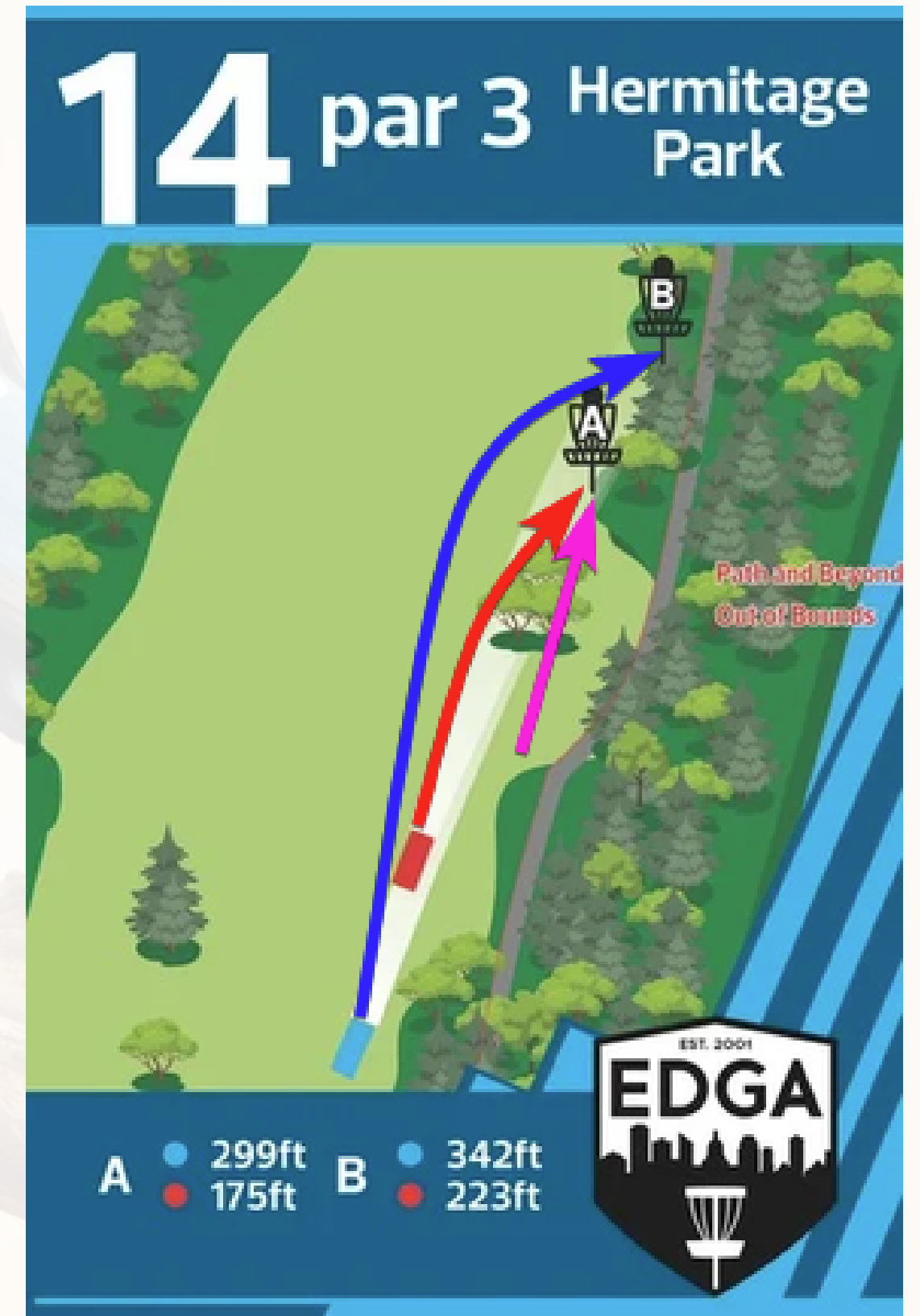

OB is played as point of entry.



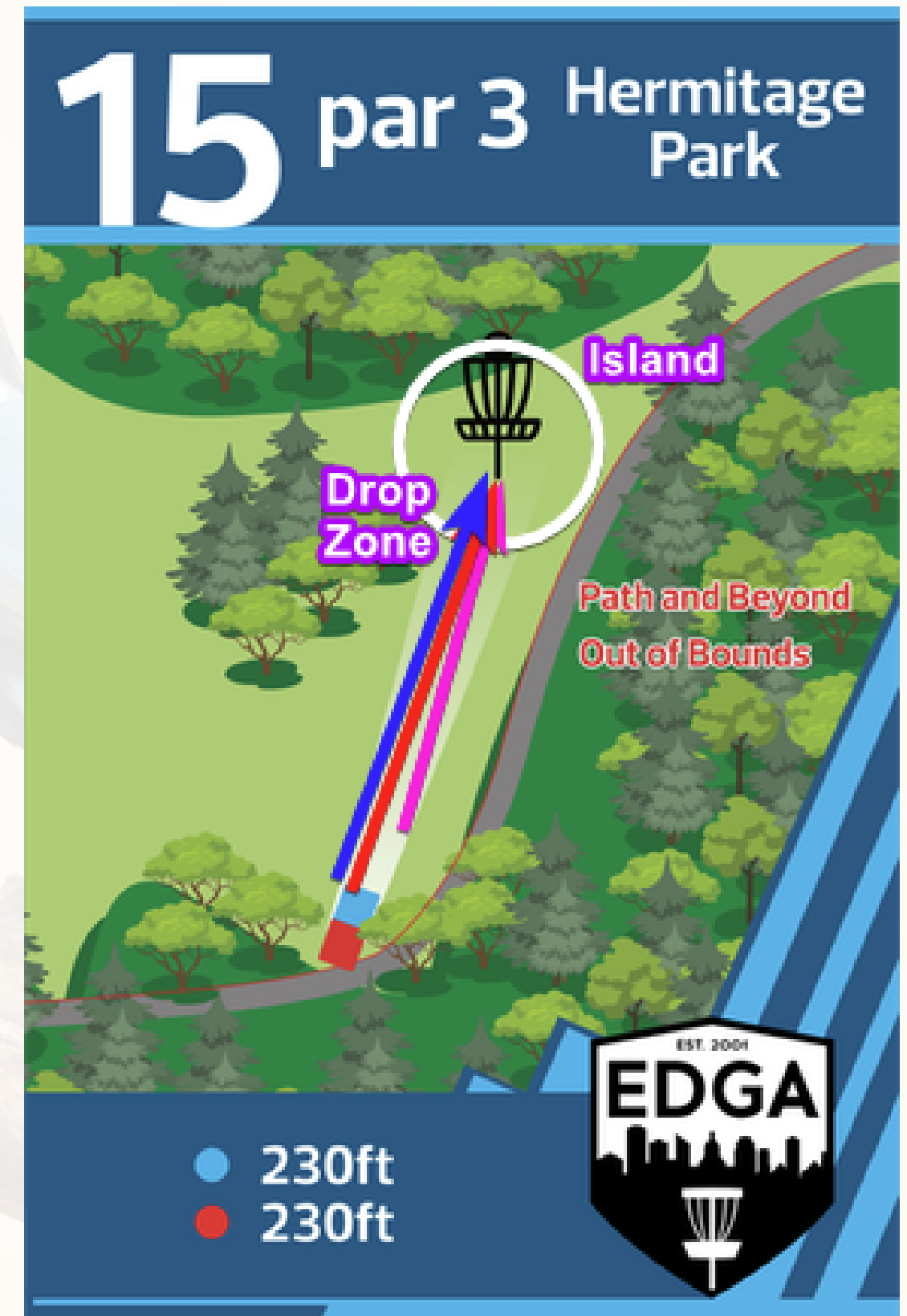

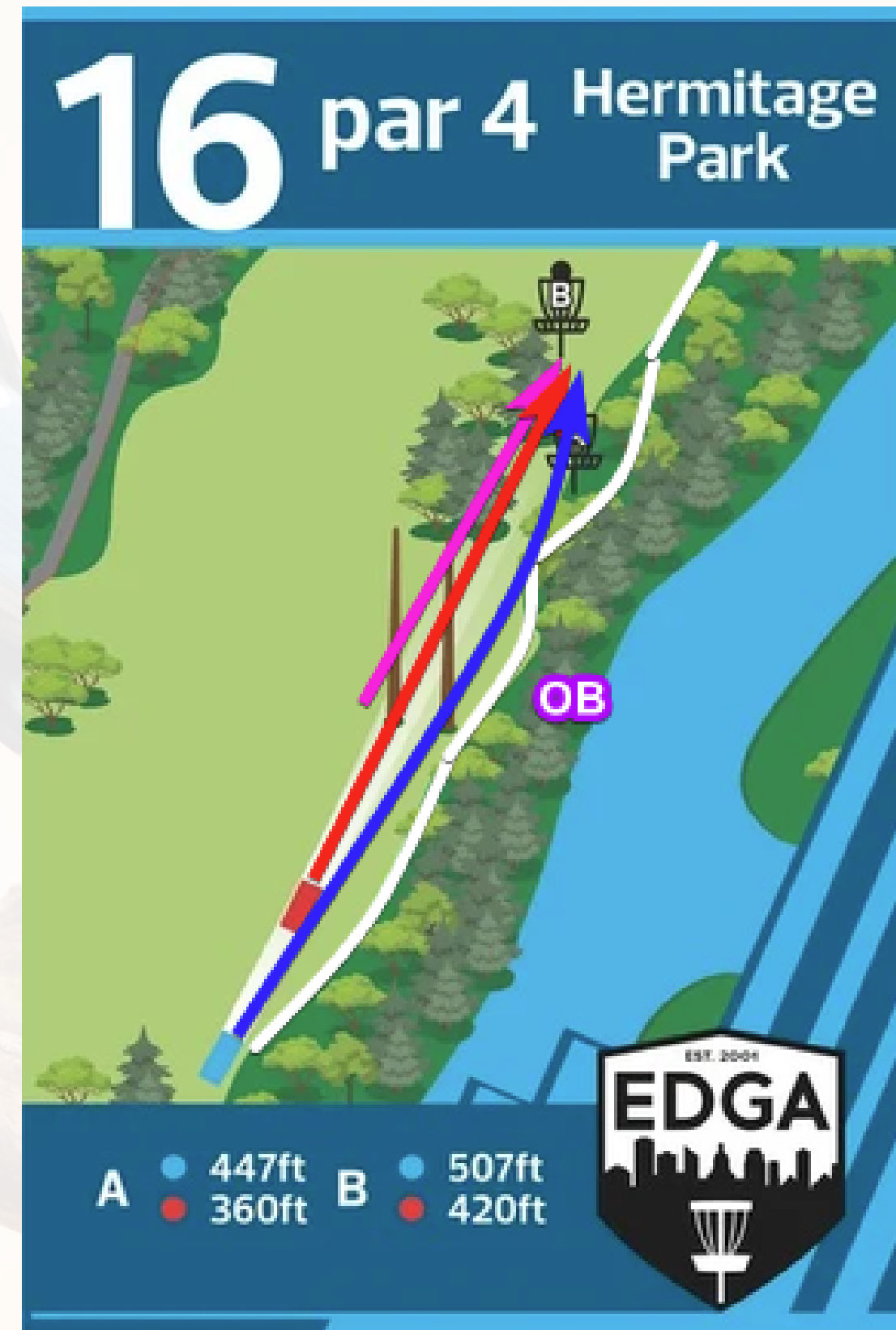
Par 4 - 225/420/507 ft

OB is played as point of entry.

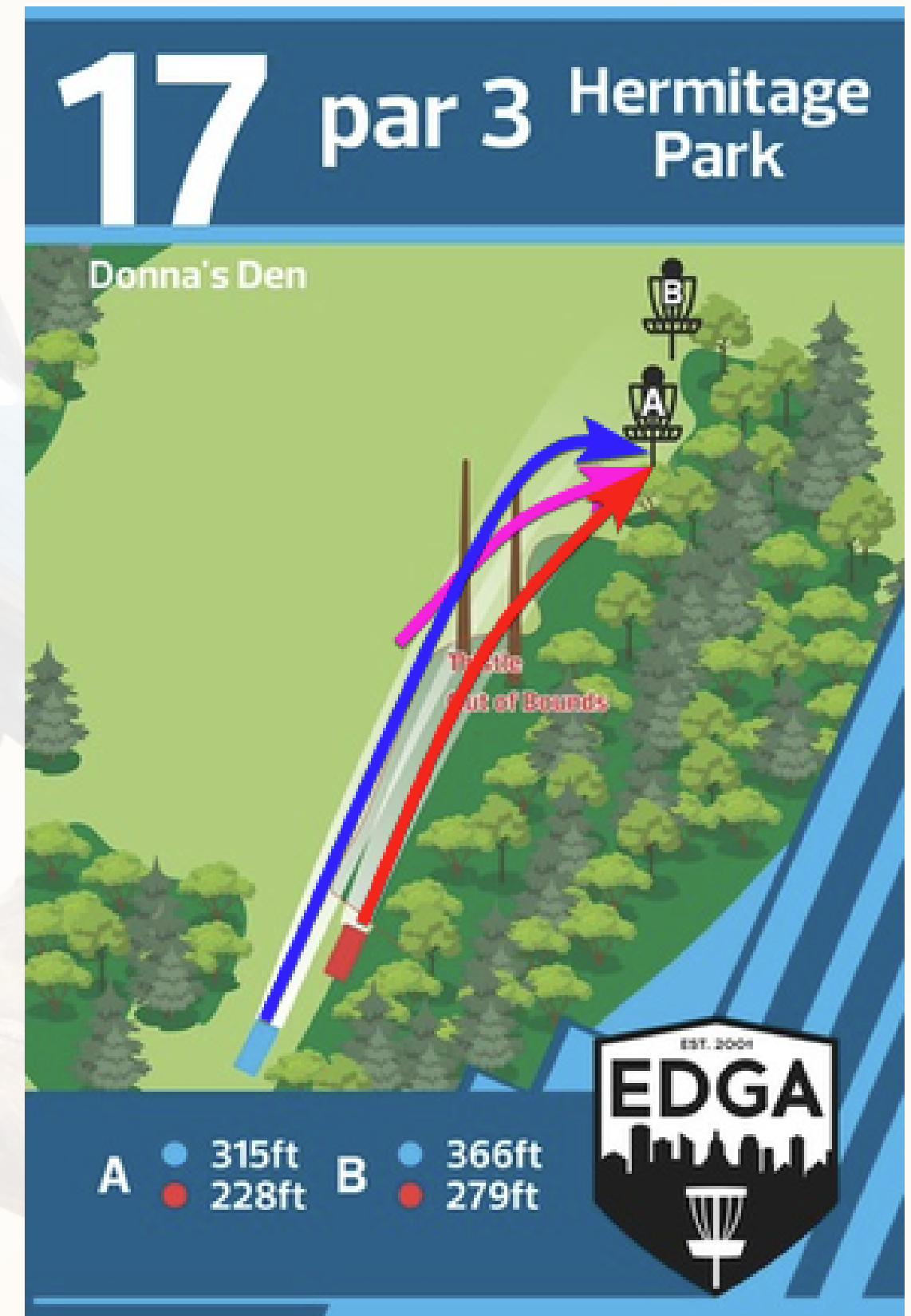
