## The Story of Crickle Creek Disc Golf Course

In early November of 2023, Jon Storey from Escape Sports cold-called Dave at Crickle Creek about potentially installing a disc golf course on the property.



Dave was very receptive as the 18 hole par 3 golf course he designed and installed himself in 2005 had seen little use for a long time. Due to this, he was only maintaining the front 9 (DG holes 6-14) for the past few years.

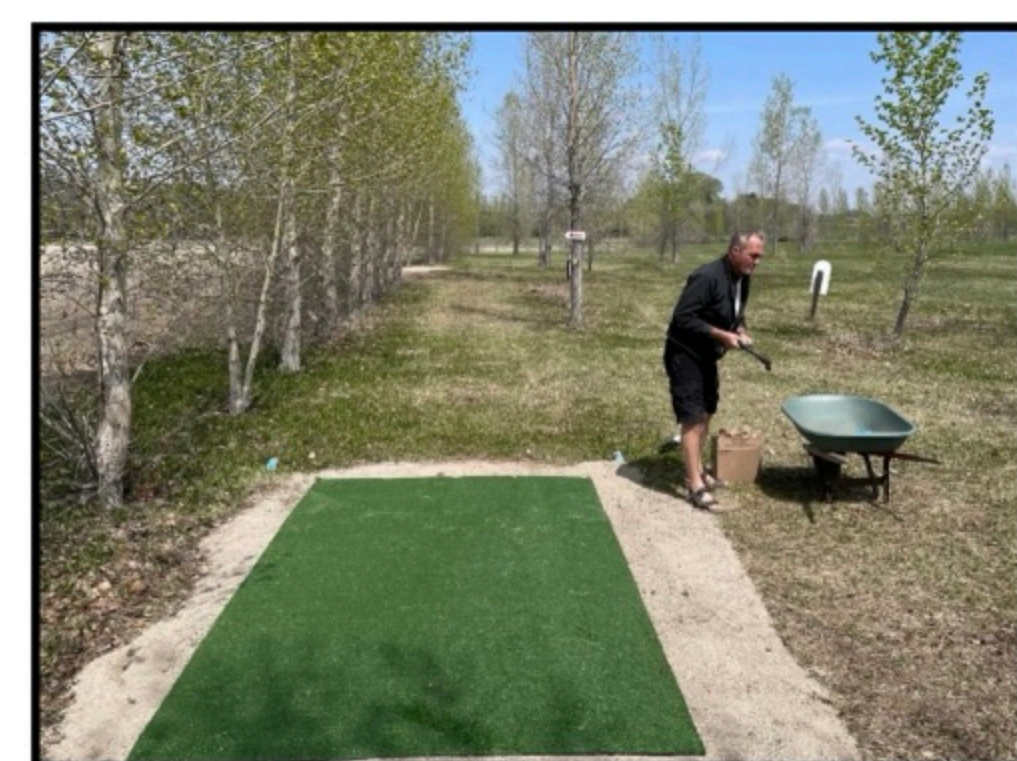


On Nov 21st, Jon invited Brandon Redekop to join him in the design process. After a week of scouting and a full walk through on Nov 27th by Dave, Jon, Brandon and Scott Chapman (visionary of the hole 3 tunnel tee shot and craftsman of basket 18) the course layout was essentially complete.



The big day: April 27th, 2024. A fantastic crew of SDG and Asshats DG members made quick work of basket installation and played the first official rounds.

May 4th was the SDG membership drive at Crickle Creek, over 160 rounds were recorded that day!



May 28th, tee pad installation was completed by Dave and Brandon with the help of Greg Hesterman and Don McManus.

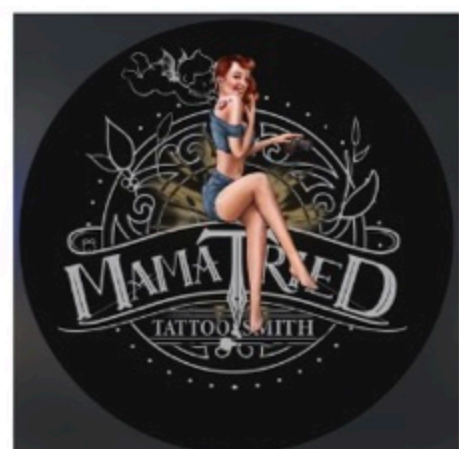
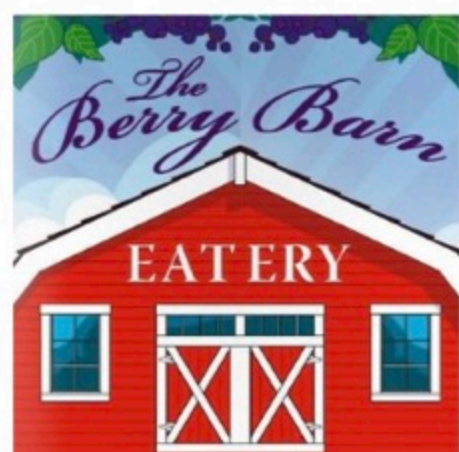

## Player Information

Practice rounds on **Friday June 5th** are free for tournament players.  
Casual doubles Friday at **7:00pm** meet at hole 1.

Feel free to hang out around tournament central and watch hole 1 & 18 during the weekend - please bring a camping chair as seating won't be provided.

**DBL mando now installed on 10.** The tournament layout will be very similar to standard play, Tournament Changes are: **hazard islands on 4 & 15** from the **whites & blues** and **OB long on 18.**

There will be a throwing net and practice basket available at Crickle.  
**No on-course practice while official play is underway.**  
Consider warming up at Diefenbaker Park (12 minute drive) or William A. Reid (8 minute drive).

Please **carpool** if possible, if the weather is nice the parking lot will be quite full including other Crickle Creek user groups.

**Escape Sports, Bridge City Discs** and **Little Potato Disc Designs** will be on site. There is a snack shack on site open 11-8 with burgers, a fantastic selection of ice cream etc. **(cash/debit only)**

**Bathrooms** are located near the middle of the parking area.

**Top 3 in each division** will be presented with **medals** from North Star Trophies at the conclusion of the tournament. **There will also be draws during the medal ceremony, you must be present to win.**  
If you need to leave early you may pickup your medal from tournament central.

**All players must keep a scorecard every round.**

## Rules

**Tournament Director: Brandon Redekop**  
**Assistant TD: Erik Trenouth**

PDGA rules will be followed. No drugs or alcohol permitted on the course.

There will be **no formal players meeting**. **All players** check-in on Saturday **before round one** to receive your **players pack**. Thank you to M2S Graphics and Debi from Crickle Creek for their contributions!

Players are expected to know their exact tee time as per the **'PDGA live'** app. If you are not present at hole one at your tee time you score par +4 for each missed hole.

**Hole notes in the PDGA live app will be observed for hole specific rules, along with the general course rules below:**

Beyond the tree line & fences that denote the Crickle Creek property line are OB, the inside edge of the tree trunks and of the fence posts denote the OB line if it is not specifically marked. One meter relief from OB lines, two meters relief from OB barbed wire fence.

**Active** traditional golf greens are OB, the OB line is the shortest grass cut line if it is not specifically marked. Golf flags are part of the course and should remain upright **except** on disc golf holes 7 and 8 where they are removed. Traditional golf bunkers are **casual** - no penalty, play as it lies.

There will be hip waders available to retrieve wet discs after the round, entering the water without them is not recommended.

If there are two groups in the same sightline/playing area, the group on the higher hole number has the right of way.

If you are unsure of a rule or situation, **declare** that you are playing a provisional to your card and play it out both ways, consult a TD after your round **before** submitting any scorecards.

In the event of a tie, playoffs will be conducted on holes 1 then 18 on repeat. **Report to a TD prior** to starting a playoff.
