## SCORING

PDGA Live will be our digital scorecard.

The code will be announced at the Players Meeting.

All players are obliged to score.

Please make sure that you have the App and your phone charged.

If you do not want to score via phone, you have the possibility to score with a paper scorecard.

One person in each flight should score on paper.

In the forest there are sometimes connection problems and consequently a time-delayed result transmission.

It is therefore reassuring to be able to fall back on analogue results.

## FLIGHTS

The flights for the first two rounds remain the same.

Rounds 1 and 2 are played directly after each other.

The flights for the first round are put together randomly.

The flights for the third round are determined based on score and division.

## SIDE EVENTS

Ace Run (2€) - The Ace Pot is currently filled with €64.

If there are multiple aces, the pot will be split.

CTP (2€) - 1 premium Disc to win for each round.

Ring of Fire (free) – Gosse has once more 3 discs to give away in a joyful game at the end of the tournament.

## TOILETS

We have a toilet available in the Haus des Waldes.

A Dixie toilet is between holes 11 and 12.

Both have to be used mixed.

## PLAY-OFF

If there is a tie for first place, there will be a Shoot-Out to determine the winner.

Holes 1, 2, 3, 4, and 13 will be played in a loop.

Ties for the other podium places will be decided by a Shoot-Out on holes 1 and 2.

If no decision has been made after two holes, it will be decided by CTP.

## TRAINING & DOUBLES

The course will be available for free training by friday morning.

There will be another fun doubles tournament on Friday.

The doubles round(s) can be played flexibly throughout the day.

# BASIC RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

- Everyone is responsible for his or her own throw. Please do not throw if this could cause danger to people or animals.
- All participants should be familiar with the rules, especially the OB rules.
- Some roads that are designated as OB areas are not specially marked with flags. The following applies here: if the disc is completely on the asphalt, it is OB. If it is still in contact with grass/woodland, then it is safe.
- Friendly interaction with other forest users is expected.
- Smoking during play is not allowed. Use the breaks for that and take care of your stumps and wildfire.
- Playing quickly is a prerequisite for keeping to the schedule. If a disc is lost, the flight is obliged to search together for three minutes. If the disc remains lost, the game continues from the old position with a penalty throw.
- Please spot independently at dangerous spots.



# THE COURSE

We play on a mobile course in the Trier Weißhauswald. So please bear in mind that there will be no professional tee pads.

However, you will find good tee-off areas on forest paths or grass.

The tees will be marked by two white flags and a white line.

The back end of the tees will not be marked, but according to PDGA rule will always extend backwards for 3 metres.

White flags are used on the course for tee, drop zone

and mando markers. Red flags mark the respective OB

areas. Orange flags come to use if there will be Relief Areas.

We will mainly play on Discmania and Dynamic Disc baskets.

There will be 3-4 Eurodiscs baskets with a slightly shallower basket depth.

A big Shout-Out for Disc Golf Luxembourg for helping us out!

The course is around 2.5 kilometres long and, with the exception of hole 5, has no significant ascents.

.

The forest is also a favourite place for other people.

We have designed the course to minimise waiting times. However, if you need to pause for a moment, take a look around and enjoy the place where you are!





The Mando Tree after about 50m has to be passed on the right side. If the Mando is missed, continue at the Drop Zone with a penalty stroke.







## BASIC RULES 4 NC

---

- One tournament in each country per season.
- The 4NC can be embedded in an existing tournament.
- Minimum 16 spots reserved for 4NC players.
- All players can play, that are somehow related to a participating club.
- A player must have played at least two rounds to gain points for the team.

## POINT SYSTEM 4 NC

---

- The four best scores per team are summed up. The best team score will get 100/75/50/25 points.
- Podium places in each offered division will be awarded with 30/20/10 points to the teams.
- Solo Competition: There will be an overall ranking for all offered divisions.
- For each event the seven best 4NC players will be awarded with 10/7/5/4/3/2/1 points.

- Create a spectacular and international Disc Golf event in our home town.
- Get new people to play and love our sport.
- Attract more women and kids for our sport.
- Get more publicity and PR in our regions.
- Building up Disc Golf networks across borders.
