Professional Net Entry Fee Breakdown

Professional Payout (\$45)

\$45 per player will be allocated to Professional Payout distributed via PayPal within 48 hours of the end of the event to the PayPal email provided during registration.

Amateur Net Entry Fee Breakdown

Amateur Player Pack (\$30)

\$30 per player is allocated to player packs. Each player will receive either:

- 1-year Power Disc Golf Academy Membership or 1-year membership extension (first 2026 2-round Power DGA Series event you compete in)

OR

- \$30 credit to the Power DGA Player Pack Store (every other 2026 Power DGA Series 2-round event you compete in)

Amateur Payout (\$15)

\$15 per player is allocated to Amateur Payout in the form of credit to the DGPT Pro Shop (in person or online). Payout vouchers will be distributed by DGPT via email after the event is complete. Payouts will remain valid until 12/31/2026.

Trophies for every 2-round event are provided by LZR Prints! Stick around after the event for the award ceremony.

Series Ace Pool

Each player has the option to enter the Series Ace Pool for \$3/player. The ace pool will include entries from every Qualifying Event around the country. If no ace is hit, the ace pool will roll over to the next weekend. The hole must be >150 feet in distance to qualify for the Series Ace Pool.

2026 Points Series - Presented by Disc Golf Threads

Players will earn points for every Power DGA Championship Series Event you compete in, and bonus prizes will be awarded based on the number of points they earn throughout the Series! Players will receive the following points for each event they compete in:

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: There are an odd number of players in my division. How will the top 50% invitations be awarded?

A: If there are an odd number of players, we will invite the larger 50% - top 2 of 3, 4 of 7, etc.

Q: There is only one person in my division, will I still receive an invitation?

A: Yes, if there is only one player in your division, you will receive an invitation to the Finale and the bonus points for winning the division.

Q: Is there a minimum number of players needed for the event?

A: We generally need at least 4 players to form a full card. If the event has fewer than 4 players, it may be canceled or postponed at the TD's discretion. If the event is canceled, registered players will receive a full refund.

- 8:30am - 9:00am- Check-in with the TD at Event HQ.
- 9:00am - 9:15am- Player meeting at HQ.
- 9:30am - 12:30pm- Round 1
- 12:30pm - 1:30pm- Lunch Break (approximate) - will begin when the last card submits their scorecard and will last for at least 1 hour and 15 minutes. Round 2 tee times will be posted to the PDGA Event Page and players will be notified via email. Players must be on their starting hole for Round 2 at least 10 minutes before Round 2 starts.

- Hole 1- 340ft- Par 3- OB on or over road on the right side.
- Hole 2- 228ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 3- 342ft- Par 3- OB on or over road on the right side.
- Hole 4- 137ft- Par 3- OB on or over road on the right side
- Hole 5- 215ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 6- 282ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 7- 449ft- Par 4- OB on or over gravel parking lot or surrounded by water on the left side.
- Hole 8- 315ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 9- 198ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 10- 285ft- Par 3- OB is over the rope on the left side. (Left side of the post line)
- Hole 11- 343ft- Par 4- Mando left of the tree. (Drop zone left of tree) OB on the right side over the rope line- (outside of post line)
- Hole 12- 213ft- Par 3- Mando right of tree, No OB
- Hole 13- 507ft- Par 5- Mando left of tree. (Drop zone on tee pad next to the mando.) Ob on the right side of the fairway over roped line. There is a secondary Mando tree on the approach shot. Missed mando drops to the left of that tree.
- Hole 14- 543ft- Par 4- OB over line on the right side of fairway. (Same OB rope as the previous hole.)
- Hole 15- 227ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 16- 351ft- Par 4- OB on the right side over rope line
- Hole 17- 248ft- Par 3- No OB
- Hole 18- 321ft- Par 4- OB is on/over gravel
