

Spoon Creek Disc Golf Course - Round 2, Skip Hole 1

General Notes

'Surrounded by water' means if there is water between your disc and land the disc is surrounded. So, if a disc is laying on a rock, and that rock is surrounded by water, you are still OB. If the disc is touching water, but is also touching land that is connected to fairway, you are safe.
