

2026 Cowtown Throwdown supported by Innova Caddy Book and Notes

Welcome to the 2026 Cowtown Throwdown supported by Innova on March 7, 2026 at Prado Regional Park in Chino, Ca. This is a PDGA sanctioned pro-am C-tier and Southern California Disc Golf Club event. All PDGA rules are in effect. Make sure you are aware of any updated rules. If you have any questions, talk to the tournament director before the event starts.

Every player is required to keep score. PDGA live score will be the primary way to keep score for the event. Go to pdga.com/score to access the score card or download the PDGA Live app.. Use access code **cow26** to create your scorecard. This will be used for both rounds. If you are unable to do digital scoring, paper scorecards are available. See one of the tournament staff members to get a paper score card. Be sure to put your name, division, and which round the card is for on the card so we know that you submitted a scorecard for the round. The scorecard needs to be submitted to the staff at tournament central at the completion of each round.

All parking lots are out of bounds (OB). Paved roads and beyond are OB. The lake is OB. Players are allowed a 2-meter relief from the lake only for safety reasons. All areas past construction fences and park boundary fences are OB. Read the rules on each hole for directions on play if your disc comes to rest in the water. Please keep searches for any lost disc to 3 minutes max. There will be time to look during lunch and after the event. There is no 2 meter rule.

To clarify the lake and how to determine OB, the bank/grass/dirt is inbounds. The vegetation growing out of the lake is not. If you disc lands on aquatic vegetation that is in the lake and surrounded by water, it is OB. If there is dry land underneath your disc when it comes to rest, then it is safe.

If there are two players tied for first place only at the end of both rounds, the players will compete in an aggregate playoff using holes 1, 2, 18. If scores are still tied, sudden death playoff will be used on the same holes in the same order. The order of tee off will rotate each hole. A coin flip or another method will determine the starting order.

If there are any questions during play or after the round, come talk to Josh or Nate (TDs) for a resolution. If unsure how to play a hole, use the provisional rule.

Hole 1: 317 feet. Road and beyond in OB.

Hole 2: 254 feet. Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed.

Hole 3: 325 feet.

Hole 4: 310 feet.

Hole 5: 250 feet. Island hole. If a disc does not come to rest on the island, play where it lies with a 1-throw penalty (Hazard rule).

Hole 6: 348 feet. Par 4. Mandatory right of the marked pole (at the corner of the grass and pavement). Proceed to drop zone if missed. Parking lot and road are OB.

Hole 7: 300 feet.

Hole 8: 278 feet. Double mandatory between the two marked trees. Proceed to drop zone if either mandatory is missed.

Hole 9: 262 feet: . Double mandatory between the two marked trees. Proceed to drop zone if either mandatory is missed.

Hole 10: 345 feet.

Hole 11: 346 feet.. Double mandatory between the two marked trees. Proceed to drop zone if either mandatory is missed.

Hole 12: 292 feet. Double mandatory between the marked tree and the free standing pole. Proceed to drop zone if either mandatory is missed.

Hole 13: 318 feet. Basket is near the water. If a player's tee shot comes to rest in the lake, the player can either take their lie from where the disc was last in bounds or can proceed to the optional drop zone with a 1-stroke penalty. If any throw besides the tee shot comes to rest in the

lake, the player takes their lie from where the disc was last in bounds with a 1-stroke penalty.

Drop zone is about 105 feet from the basket.

Hole 14: 241 feet. Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. It is a good idea to have someone keep an eye of tee shots as discs can roll down to the water and into the lake without being seen. If a disc is rolling, do not stop it or prevent it from entering the lake as this is a rules violation. You must allow the disc to come to rest on its own.

Hole 15: 282 feet. Mandatory left of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed. Road and beyond are OB.

Hole 16: 294 feet. Road and beyond are OB.

Hole 17: 356 feet: Mandatory left of the marked tree. Proceed to drop zone if missed.

Hole 18: 328 feet.
