All PDGA rules shall be in effect unless otherwise noted.

THE TWO-METER RULE IS NOT IN EFFECT.

All roads and parking lots (defined by edge of asphalt/concrete) and beyond are out of bounds (806.02) for all holes, unless otherwise noted for a specific hole rule.

On top of all buildings and inside of all fenced-in areas is out of bounds (806.02) for all holes, unless otherwise noted for a specific hole rule.

All perimeter fences (defined by rear edge of white vinyl posts or chain link) and beyond are Out of Bounds (806.02) for all holes, unless otherwise noted for a specific hole rule.

All sidewalks and walking paths are Out of Bounds (806.02) for all holes, unless otherwise noted for a specific hole rule.

When it is unclear, or there is a disagreement about how to properly proceed under the rules, please take advantage of the Provisional Throw Rule (809.02).

**Please note that in the event of a tie for first place only, an aggregate playoff, taking place on Holes 1-3, shall determine the winner (1.09).

In the event of a tie for second or third place, only when a trophy is being awarded, the winner shall be determined by a CTP contest.

Hole 1: 270 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory left of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 2: 245 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory left of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 3: 310 feet. Par 3.

PLEASE TAKE CAUTION CROSSING THE ROAD

Hole 4: 540 feet. Par 4.

Mandatory right of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Please note that the dirt area between the fairway and the road is a parking lot defined by the edge of the concrete, and therefore out of bounds. (806.02)

Hole 5: 480 feet. Par 4.

Please take caution when throwing into the fairway of Hole 7.

Hole 6: 230 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory right of the marked pole (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 7: 220 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory left of the marked pole (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 8: 290 feet. Par 3.

Hole 9: 340 feet. Par 3.

PLEASE TAKE CAUTION CROSSING THE ROAD

Hole 10: 730 feet. Par 5.

Mandatory left of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 11: 360 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory right of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 12: 320 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory right of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Hole 13: 315 feet. Par 3.

Hole 14: 250 feet. Par 3.

Hole 15: 270 feet. Par 3.

PLEASE TAKE CAUTION CROSSING THE PARKING LOT

Hole 16: 300 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory left of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.

Sidewalk (defined by edge of concrete) and beyond is out of bounds (806.02).

Hole 17: 220 feet. Par 3.

Island Green: All throws must come to rest on the Island Green. The Island Green is defined by rope/string and marked with flags. All throws that don't come to rest on the Island Green are considered to be in a Hazard Area (806.05).

PLEASE TAKE CAUTION CROSSING THE ROAD

Hole 18: 345 feet. Par 3.

Mandatory right of the marked tree (804.01). The restricted plane is defined by paint. The drop zone is marked with flags.
