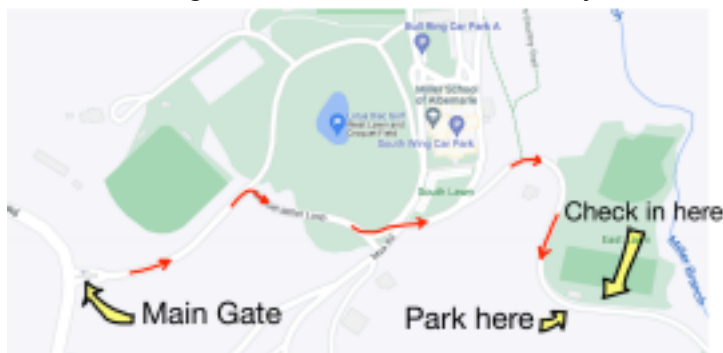


Caddy Book: Battle in the Blue Ridge 2026



Welcome to the Battle in the Blue Ridge. Here is the caddy book for the Creekside course at the Miller School. Your course director is Devin Crosby. We cannot begin to express our thanks to Devin, John Macdonald, and Tommy Landseadel for letting us use this course, but also for maintaining such a beautiful piece of land!

Parking for this event will be down by the lower athletic field.



The abbreviation "OB" is used to represent the out-of-bounds rules. There are instances of OB that apply consistently around the course:

A. OB Gravel – There is a gravel road that runs on several holes on the course. If you are surrounded by gravel or across, your disc is out of bounds. Mark your lie up to a meter in-bounds off the OB line or play again from your original line. Proceed with a one stroke penalty.

B. OB Stakes - White stakes mark OB for hole 14. You may play normal OB rules taking a meter in from the OB.

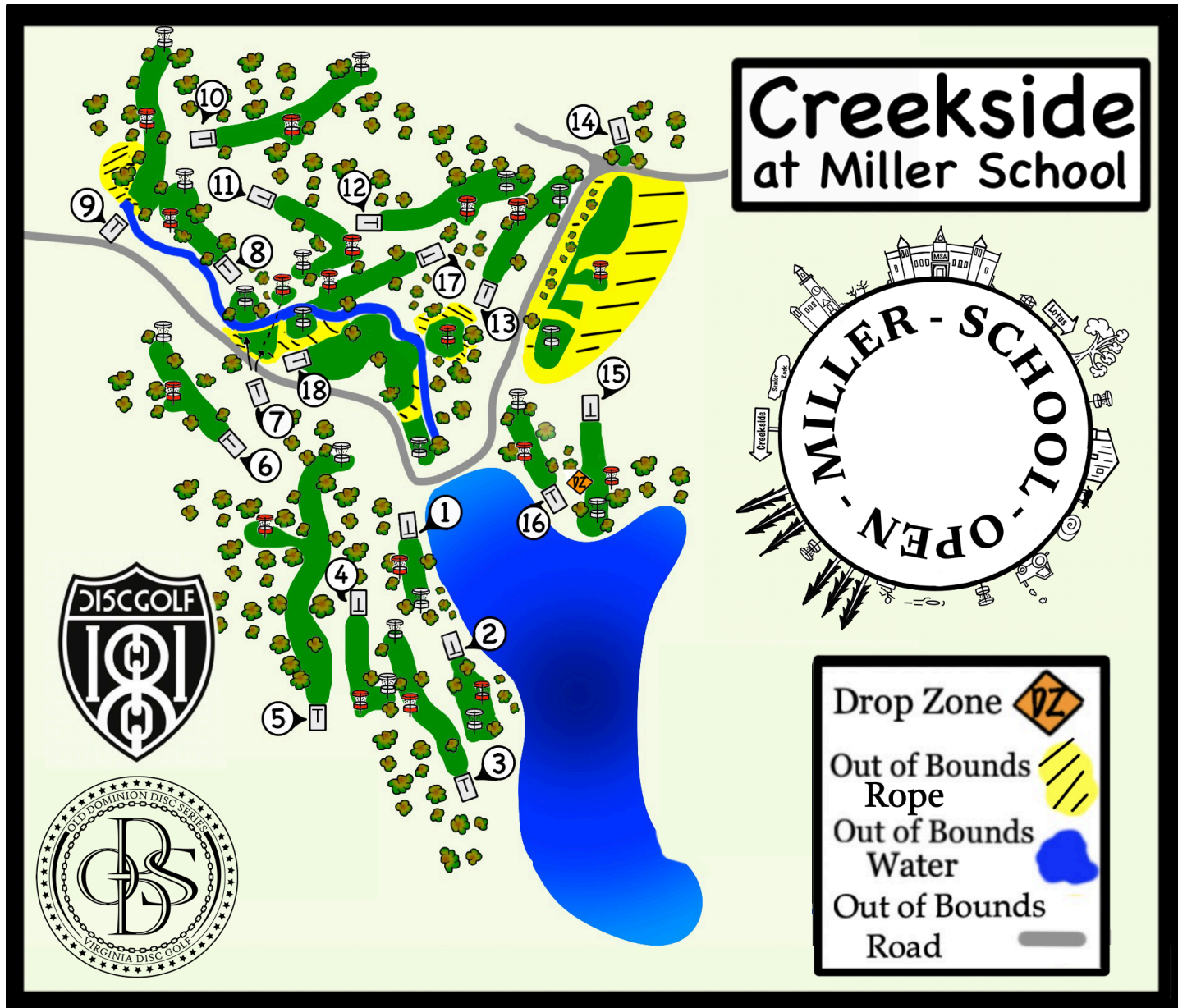
C. OB Creek/Lake – there is a lake and a creek running through the course that comes into play on several holes. For both the creek and the lake the disc must be completely surrounded by water. Proceed to the Drop Zone for indicated holes. On all others, mark your lie up to a meter in-bounds off of OB or play again from your original lie. Proceed with a one stroke penalty.

D. OB Yellow Rope - There is yellow rope marking OB on some holes near the creek or slopes to better define the out of bounds and to provide a safer lie. Holes 7, 8, 9, 17 and 18 have yellow rope. Normal OB rules apply if beyond the yellow rope. Yellow flags may be used to indicate where the rope is on some holes but the rope defines the OB.



E. Yellow Jackets and Wasps - If applicable look out for orange flags that mark known nests. Players can mark a new lie on the line of play, farther from the target, and at the nearest point that provides relief.



F. Barbed-Wire - Players may take 2 meter relief no closer to the hole from barbed wire fencing found anywhere on the course.



G. Teepads - Players must throw from the turf. The wooden areas surrounding the turf is structural and provide space for follow throughs. Players may not throw from off the turf.

-  Maverick- Main Tee to Long Pin (Silver)



- Hole 1-
-  Maverick: Par 3 (215 feet)
 -  Red Devil: Par 3 (170 feet)
- Notes: OB Lake. Teepad is located above the beach.



Hole 2-  Maverick: Par 3 (270 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (195 feet)
Notes: OB Lake.



Hole 3-  Maverick: Par 4 (463 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 4 (359 feet)



Hole 4-  Maverick: Par 3 (248 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (205 feet)

Hole 5-  Maverick: Par 5 (697 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 5 (565 feet)



Hole 6-  Maverick: Par 3 (208 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (166 feet)
Notes: OB gravel road. Small creek is casual. Players may take optional relief behind the casual creek in line with the basket at the closest available point with safe footing.


Hole 7-  Maverick: Par 3 (201 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (187 feet)
Notes: Teeing from OB. Short of the creek OB is defined by yellow rope. On the green side, the disc is OB if surrounded by water. If OB play from last in bounds or re-throw with a penalty. Must re-tee if the disc fails to cross in bounds.



Hole 8-  Maverick: Par 3 (280 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (203 feet)
Notes: OB Creek defined as surrounded by water. OB across yellow rope behind the basket.

Hole 9-  Maverick: Par 4 (409 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 4 (310 feet)
Notes: Teeing from OB. OB marked by a yellow rope line. If the disc fails to cross in bounds on the tee shot, the player must re-tee.

Hole 10-  Maverick: Par 3 (321 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (223 feet)

Hole 11-  Maverick: Par 3 (219 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (175 feet)
Notes: OB Creek


Hole 12-  Maverick: Par 4 (444 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 4 (393 feet)
Notes: If no volunteer spotter please provide a spotter on the card to stand up the fairway.


Hole 13-  Maverick: Par 3 (287 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 3 (242 feet)
Notes: OB Road

Hole 14-  Maverick: Par 4 (579 feet)
 Red Devil: Par 4 (380 feet)

Notes: If no volunteer spotter please provide a spotter on the card to stand up the fairway. Teeing from OB. Re-tee if drive fails to cross in bounds. Stakes mark the OB along the entire boundary of the fairways and greens. Maverick basket is on an island green. Normal OB rules for all shots on this hole.


Hole 15-


 Maverick: Par 3 (361 feet)

 Red Devil: Par 3 (290 feet)

Notes: OB Lake. DZ is optional for OB tee shots where the group can determine the point at which the disc went OB. Use DZ for all lost discs.


Hole 16-


 Maverick: Par 3 (244 feet)

 Red Devil: Par 3 (194 feet)

Notes: OB Lake, OB Road

Hole 17-

 Maverick: Par 4 (411 feet)


 Red Devil: Par 4 (366 feet)

Notes: Yellow rope defines OB left side of the fairway. Maverick green plays like an island. Yellow rope marks the far side of the island boundary. The short side of the island is the creek. For the short section, the disc is OB if surrounded by water. OB, play from where the disc was last in bounds. Across the yellow rope onto Hole 18 Red Devil green is OB.

Players may take casual relief from the ditch/ravine in the fairway. *If casual relief from ditch places you OB, you may take relief towards the basket the first available safe footing.

Hole 18-

 Maverick: Par 4 (468 feet)

 Red Devil: Par 4 (317 feet)

Notes: OB road, OB creek defined by yellow rope down the left side of the fairway. OB spillway with a forced carry to get to the Maverick basket. OB play where last in bounds, or rethrow from previous lie with penalty. Red Devil- Green plays as an island. Normal OB rules apply.

Playoffs for 1st place for Pool B will be from Holes 18, 17, 7 on the layouts the division played on loop.
