

**Welcome to the 2026 Georgia State Championships powered by Prodigy Disc!**



### **Georgia Super Series Event #1**

We are excited about your participation in this tournament! This event will be at Boundary Waters Park at 5000 hwy 92, Douglasville, GA 30135. In this caddie book you will find course layouts, out-of-bounds for each course, vital tournament information, and a list of sponsors that have made this all possible!

## Layouts

**Pool A: MPO, FPO, MP40, FP40, MP50, FP50, MA1. Playing from pads marked with orange flags. Playing course 1 day one and course 2 day two.**

**MA40 - Playing from pads marked with pink flags. Playing course 1 day one and course 2 day two. You will be the only division in Pool B to play with Pool A at the same time.**

**Pool B: FA1, FA40, MA50, FA50, MA55, FA55, MA60, FA60, MA70, FA70, MA2, FA2, MA3, FA3, MA4, FA4. Playing from pads marked with pink flags. Playing course 2 day one and course 1 day two.**

**Course 1** - You will start on Bw3/Hawk hole 1. Continue through Bw3/Hawk and once you finish hole 18 you will immediately turn right and continue on a new trail between Bw2/Falcon holes 1 and 2 to get to the walking path to get back to the tournament central area. This will eliminate any cross traffic down the fairways on the starting holes. You will continue your round on hole 1 Bw1/Buzzard which will be hole 19. You will play until you reach the alternate hole 9A on Bw1/Buzzard which will be hole 27 and the completion of course 1. Again, every tee sign will be modified to let you know what hole you are on.

**Course 2** – You will start on Bw2/Falcon hole 1. Continue through Bw2/Falcon and once you finish hole 18 you will walk across the parking lot, past the playground, towards the aquatic center building. You will continue your round on hole 10 Bw1/Buzzard which will be hole 19 of course 2. You will play until you reach hole 18 on Bw1/Buzzard and this will be hole 27 and the completion of course 2.

PDGA Live Scoring will be utilized (every player from each card will have to keep everyone's score for that round). Paper cards will be available in addition to PDGA live scoring and Udisc for added integrity if needed.

Bring Extra Singles \$1. We will be raffling off Discs, Bags, Entry for next year for \$1 per ticket.

Cash CTPs will be available for purchase at tournament central day of event! There will be 8 - \$2 CTPs for a total of \$16. CTPs will be for SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

Ace Pot is \$4 per person and will be for BOTH DAYS. Ace pot will be chopped if multiple aces are hit.

\$20 ALL IN for side action! CTP's/Ace Pot will be collected DAY OF WITH CASH ONLY at check in.

We will have multiple free CTPs from our sponsors and they are for everyone. Free CTPs will be marked with BLUE Flags; CASH CTPs will be marked with green flags. If you do not pay for cash CTPs, please do not mark the GREEN flags. It will be checked to verify that you paid in. Please make sure that if you do mark a ctp, write your full name and phone number on the card to make sure everyone gets paid.

All open payouts will be sent via PayPal within 24 hours of the tournament completion. Please make sure your PayPal address is correct!

Water will be available every 9 holes or so. So if you wait, make sure to HYDRATE!

# **Important Tournament Information**

All OB's will be painted with white marking paint, and most will have white flags on the lines. Just remember that the flags will be for visual references only. The painted line will be the actual line and that line will also be out of bounds, meaning that if your disc is only touching paint, from the out of bounds side on the line, then you are OB. **Take 1 meter relief to ensure that you are not throwing from out of bounds.**

## **2026 rule change**

If you are unsure about your ruling or lie, make a group decision from your card. Most cards will be four packs. Just remember that you will not have a vote in the first round of voting. Everyone must vote. You would receive a vote only if there was a tie. If you are in a 3 pack, this can happen. You may also play a provisional shot then bring this to your TD at the end of the round. Do not finalize your card until the issue is resolved.

## **No 2-meter rule**

### **All drop zones will be marked with yellow paint and yellow flags.**

Course 1 - Hole 19 (Pool A Only)

Course 2 - Hole 8

**Please know what pool you are in. Look for the color of the flag in your pool to find your tee pad. There are multiple tee pads on some holes. Play from your color flag. All Temp pads will be painted Pink or Orange and will have flags on them.**

### **There will be a handful of holes with two baskets.**

Make sure you are throwing to the correct basket.

### **Pool A will play long basket positions**

Course 1 – Hole 6 Blue Basket

Course 1 – Hole 20 Green Basket

Course 2 – Hole 14 Green Basket

Course 2 – Hole 27 Green Basket

### **Pool B will play short position baskets.**

Course 1 – Hole 6 Orange Basket

Course 1 – Hole 20 Yellow Basket

Course 2 – Hole 14 Orange Basket

Course 2 – Hole 27 Yellow Basket

## **Course 1 – BW3/Hawk full layout and front 9 of BW1/buzzard**

Hole 1 – Par 4. 725 feet. OB fairway lines. OB lake

Hole 2 – Par 3. 295 feet. OB full right side of fairway, lake will not be in play

Hole 3 – Par 5. 1000 feet. OB Walking path and beyond, OB full left side of fairway.

Hole 4 – Par 3. 410 feet. OB line straight long and continuing to left side of basket.

Hole 5 – Par 3. 245 feet. NO OB

Hole 6 – Short Orange Basket for pool B with no OB par 3. 300 feet.

Long Blue Basket for pool A par 4. 500 feet OB Creek line and beyond past long basket.

Hole 7 – Par 3. 295 feet. OB Creek, painted lines on both sides of creek and OB line long of basket

Hole 8 – Par 3. 275 feet. OB line at River

Hole 9 – Par 3. 285 feet. OB line long of basket

Hole 10 – Par 4. 740 feet. OB line full right side of fairway circled to rear of basket. Long creek will not be in play

Hole 11 – Par 4. 570 feet. OB line full right side of fairway that continues to hole 12's tee pad.

Hole 12 – Par 3. 270 feet. OB line right side of fairway

Hole 13 – Par 3. 250 feet. OB line long of basket at creek. Creek will not be in play

Hole 14 – Par 3. 270 feet. OB line full left side of fairway. Creek will not be in play

Hole 15 – Par 3. 200 feet. OB line full right side of fairway circled to rear of basket

Hole 16 – Par 3. 220 feet. NO OB

Hole 17 – Par 3. 315 feet. OB line full right side of fairway to walking path. OB walking path and beyond

Hole 18 – Par 4. 570 feet. OB line right side of fairway. OB lake

Hole 19 – Par 3. 415 feet. OB fairway lines. OB lake

Hole 20 – There will be two baskets on this hole. Pool A will play across the lake to the green basket, Par 5. 660 feet with one drop zone. There will be a painted line to define the lake at some points. The drop zone will be on the other side of the lake. When you attempt to cross the lake and do not cross inbounds (OB line on top of bank), then move your lie to where you last crossed inbounds with a 1 stroke penalty. If you cross the lake, cross inbounds and roll back into the out of bounds or go deep (on or past the walking trail) then proceed to the drop zone on the other side of lake with a 1 stroke penalty. Pool B will play Par 4 to short yellow basket par 4, 410 feet with OB lake only. Pool B will not use a drop zone.

Hole 21 – Par 4. 570 feet. OB full left side to circles edge down to lower fairway on hole 22

Hole 22 – Pool A long pad Par 4, 429 feet. 325 Island Hazard in play. If you land in the hazard, continue playing at your disc with a 1 stroke penalty.

Pool B short pad. Par 4, 325 feet. Island Hazard in play. If you land in the hazard, continue playing at your disc with a 1 stroke penalty.

Hole 23 – Par 3. 251 feet. OB line long of basket

Hole 24 – Pool A long pad Par 4, 598 feet. OB line left side of second fairway to walking path. OB walking path and beyond.

Pool B short pad Par 4, 475 feet. OB line left side of fairway to walking path. OB walking path and beyond.

Hole 25 – Par 3. 250 feet. OB walking path and beyond

Hole 26 – Par 3. 233 feet. Island in play with hazard. If you land outside of the painted circle continue playing at your disc with 1 stroke penalty.

Hole 27 – Par 3. 400 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond. New basket location

## **Course 2 – BW2/Falcon full layout and Back 9 of BW1/buzzard**

Hole 1 – Par 3. 360 feet. OB fairway lines

Hole 2 – Par 3. 200 feet. OB inside of pump station fence

Hole 3 – Par 3. 270 feet. OB line right side, splitting fairways

Hole 4 – Pool A long pad Par 4. 500 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek. OB walking path and beyond. Pool B Par 4. 400 feet. OB walking path and beyond.

Hole 5 – Par 3. 226 feet. NO OB

Hole 6 – Pool A long pad Par 3, 350 feet. OB painted line around lake. OB line long on hillside  
Pool B short pad Par 3, 250 feet. OB painted line around lake. OB line long on hillside

Hole 7 – Par 3. 270 feet. OB Lake

Hole 8 – Par 3. 200 feet. OB Lake with drop zone. There will be a painted line to define the lake at some points. When you cross the lake and do not cross inbounds on the other side, then you will proceed to drop zone 1 with a 1 stroke penalty. If you cross inbounds on the other side but manage to still go OB, then play your lie where you last cross inbounds with a 1 stroke penalty.

Hole 9 – Par 3. 451 feet. OB line left side of wood line to circle one

Hole 10 – Par 3. 375 feet. OB line full left side of fairway towards basket

Hole 11 – Par 3. 260 feet. OB lines left and right side of fairway circling back of basket

Hole 12 – Par 3. 255 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek.

Hole 13 – Pool A long pad Par 4. 520 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond. Pool B short pad Par 4. 420 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond.

Hole 14 – There will be two baskets on this hole. Pool A will play long green basket Par 3, 360 feet with OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek. Pool B will play short orange basket. Par 3, 235 feet. with NO OB.

Hole 15 – Pool A long pad Par 3, 500 feet. NO OB. Pool B short pad Par 3, 375 feet. NO OB

Hole 16 – Par 3. 255 feet. NO OB

Hole 17- Par 3. 321 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek.

Hole 18 – Pool A long pad Par 4, 570 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek.

Pool B short pad Par 4, 465 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek.

Hole 19 – Pool A long pad Par 4, 700 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond.

Pool B short pad Par 4, 500 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond.

Hole 20 - Par 4. 485 feet. NO OB

Hole 21 - Par 3. 303 feet. OB Paved surfaces and beyond

Hole 22 - Par 3. 337 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek. OB paved surfaces and beyond. OB painted fairway line on left side

Hole 23 – Par 3. 360 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek. OB paved surfaces and beyond. OB painted fairway line of left side

Hole 24 – Par 3. 315 feet. OB creek, painted lines on both sides of creek. OB paved surfaces and beyond

Hole 25 – Par 3. 360 feet. OB Paved surfaces and beyond

Hole 26 – Pool A Par 3, 552 feet. Pool B Par 4, 552 feet. OB Paved surfaces and beyond. Long basket position both pools.

Hole 27 -There will be two baskets on this hole. Pool A play long green basket Par 3, 425 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond.

Pool B will play short yellow basket Par 3, 357 feet. OB paved surfaces and beyond.
