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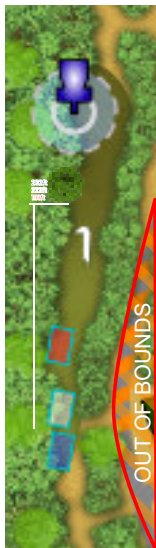
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TOP GUN COURSE CADDY BOOK



Hole 1: Flex line with the gap tightening closer to the basket. Safe play is to throw to the wide area prior to the tight gap. Anything on or over the road is out of bounds.

PAR 3 BLUE: 360 FT
WHITE: 321 FT
RED: 290 FT



Hole 2: Sharp left turn then straight long to the basket. Safe play just get around the corner.

PAR 3 BLUE: 316 FT
WHITE: 305 FT
RED: 275 FT



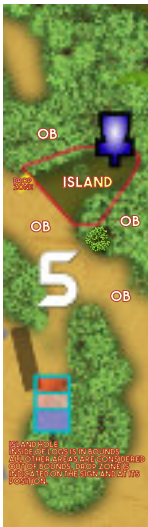
Hole 3: Open field with a teepee. First shot should be on left hand side to open up the shot to the green guarded by large poplar trees.

PAR 4 BLUE: 520 FT
WHITE: 505 FT
RED: 428 FT



Hole 4: Tunnel shot that you want to finish left so you can open up your shot into the green.

PAR 4 BLUE: 530 FT
WHITE: 485 FT
RED: 352 FT



Hole 5: Awkward right hand short shot into an Island surrounded by logs and out of bounds. Island gets tight around the basket. Inside of logs is the OB line. Anything in out of bounds proceed to the drop zone. If your putt from the drop zone or in bounds goes out of bounds play from where the shot went out of bounds.

PAR 3 BLUE: 190 FT
WHITE: 190 FT
RED: 190 FT



Hole 6: Tightly wooded with a left and a right gap.

PAR 3 BLUE: 198 FT
WHITE: 198 FT
RED: 190 FT



Hole 7: Downhill straight to left finish. Safe play is to play to the right side to leave yourself a shot to the green.

WHITE: 350 FT
RED: 258 FT



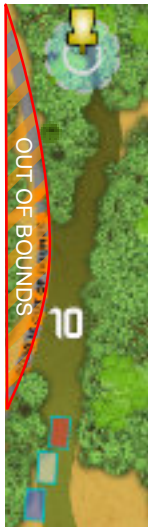
Hole 8: Hard right shot that is protected by a large spruce tree on the left of the basket. Safe play is to get around the corner without trying to push for the basket.

RED: 236 FT



Hole 9: Long gradual right bend with the basket in the trees on the right at the end. Safe play is to play for the middle of the fairway.

PAR 3 BLUE: 308 FT
WHITE: 302 FT
RED: 240 FT



Hole 10: Straight first shot. Try to keep to the right to allow yourself access to the green. Second shot is left turning through a gap with a hill in front to force distance control. Anything on or over the road is out of bounds.

PAR 4 BLUE: 500 FT
WHITE: 475 FT
RED: 427 FT



Hole 11: Gradual right turn first shot. Try to keep left to allow a shot to the green. Don't overthrow the landing zone. Second shot is a hard right to a protected basket.

RED: 435 FT



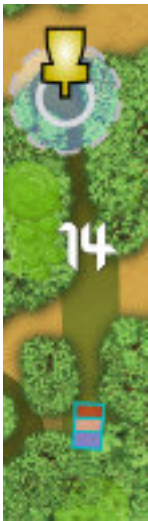
Hole 12: Straight with a left finish. A low shot finishing left will leave you with an unobstructed 25ft uphill putt. A high hyzer shot will give you a chance at a birdie, but will chance getting blocked by trees.

RED: 240 FT



Hole 13: Very large downhill shot straight. Low ceiling under spruce tree. Difficult to get the angle correct.

WHITE: 301 FT
RED: 279 FT



Hole 14: Tunnel shot down hill that is protected by a large spruce on the left. Getting your shot to the ground is a must.

Hole 15: A tight tunnel shot over a gully. Slightly downhill overall.

PAR 3 BLUE: 344 FT
WHITE: 344 FT
RED: 192 FT



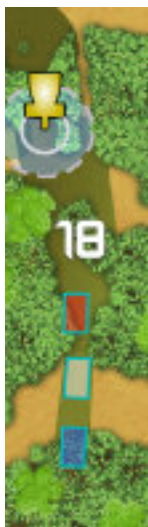
Hole 16: Uphill shot with a risky right hand side to tempt players to going for the basket. Safe play is the wide gap on the left.

WHITE: 221 FT
RED: 204 FT



Hole 17: A two shot placement hole that snakes down the fairway to a basket perched on a log just before a steep valley. Distance control is a must.

PAR 4 BLUE: 426 FT
WHITE: 383 FT
RED: 311 FT



Hole 18: A tight gap off of the tee. A safe straight shot will yield a par. A left finishing shot will give you a chance at birdie while bringing some tighter gaps further down the fairway into play.

WHITE: 269 FT
RED: 226 FT

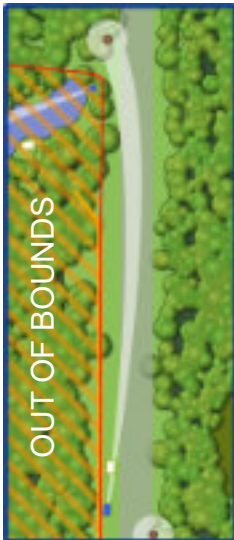


Hole 1: Basic Left to Right Hole.

Stay away from the guardian trees by the basket for an open putt. Out of bounds on the left past the fence on the left. OB line is on the inside of the fence.

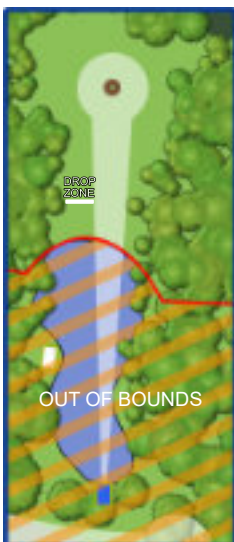
Benefit of the doubt given to the player.

**PAR 3 BLUE: 373 FT
WHITE: 373 FT**



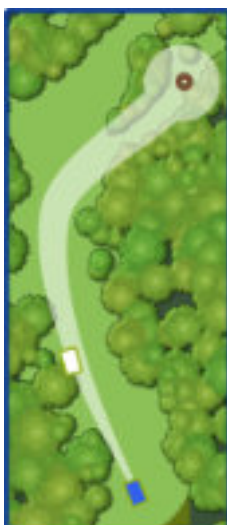
Hole 2: Long Downhill Par 4. Get as far as you can while keeping the drive to the middle or right of the road for an open second shot. Out of bounds on the left past the fence on the left. OB line is on the inside of the fence. Benefit of the doubt given to the player. The OB extends straight from the fence line towards the basket.

WHITE: 640 FT**



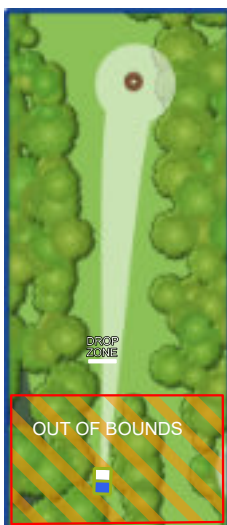
Hole 3: Water carry 240ft from the Blue tees. 165ft from the White tees. Try and hit the gap. You are throwing from out of bounds and can proceed to the drop zone if you do not make it past.

**PAR 3 BLUE: 368 FT
WHITE: 236 FT**



Hole 4: Two shot par 4. Try to play your first shot to the top of the hill. The right side is thick bushes. Avoid if possible. Second shot is a tight gap to a guarded basket.

WHITE: 331 FT



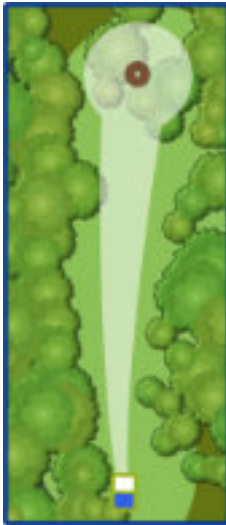
Hole 5: This is a gap hit off the tee. The shot needs to be straight to get to the basket. You are throwing from out of bounds and can proceed to the drop zone if you do not make it past.

PAR 3 BLUE: 290 FT
WHITE: 290 FT



Hole 6: Tight wooded hole with two main gaps. Rough bush protects against short shots. A drop off behind the basket protects against long shots.

PAR 3 BLUE: 248 FT
WHITE: 248 FT



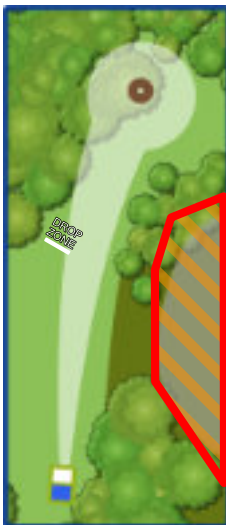
Hole 7: Slight left to right turn with a tightly guarded basket. Getting near the treeline will yield a putt.

PAR 3 BLUE: 259 FT
WHITE: 259 FT



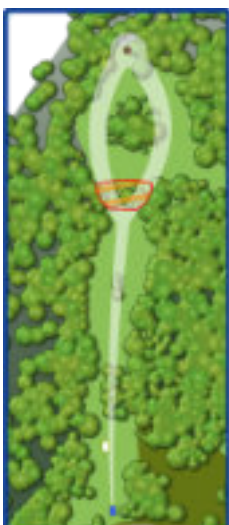
Hole 8: First shot has a slight left bend. Common mistake is to have the disc fade too much. Try to stay in the middle to give yourself a downhill shot to a green protected by some guardian trees.

PAR 4 BLUE: 483 FT
WHITE: 436 FT



Hole 9: Slight right bending shot with an elevated basket. Keep shot on the fairway. Left and right bushes are punishing. OB in right bushes right of the steel fence. Proceed to dropzone if deemed OB.

PAR 3 BLUE: 273 FT
WHITE: 273 FT



Hole 10: This hole has two landing zones before the blind shot to the basket. The first shot needs to get past the spruce trees to give yourself an open second shot to the landing area in front of the OB Bunker. The third shot is a choice of left or right to a guarded green.

PAR 5 BLUE: 857 FT
WHITE: 755 FT



Hole 11: First Shot is a slight right but priority should be given to keeping the disc in the middle of the fairway. The second shot is to a basket on the left that is protected by guardian trees.

PAR 4 BLUE: 525 FT
WHITE: 525 FT



Hole 12: Short right turning hole to a protected basket. Tee shot is pinched on the right.

PAR 3 BLUE: 225 FT
WHITE: 225 FT



Hole 13: Longer basic left turning hole. Try and miss the guardian trees on the left and right side of the fairway.

PAR 3 BLUE: 327 FT
WHITE: 327 FT



Hole 14: Right turning hole with an awkward set of gaps that makes you have to decide what to do to try and reach the basket.

PAR 3 BLUE: 300 FT
WHITE: 300 FT



Hole 15: First shot is a long left turning shot followed by a long right turning shot. Playing a straight shot first will keep disc on the fairway to help set up the second shot.

PAR 4 BLUE: 642 FT
WHITE: 600 FT



Hole 16: Uphill shot to an basket perched on a small hill.

PAR 3 BLUE: 253 FT
WHITE: 253 FT



Hole 17: Very sharp corner to an long uphill shot. First shot needs to get past the trees on the left without going too far. Second shot is farther than you think.

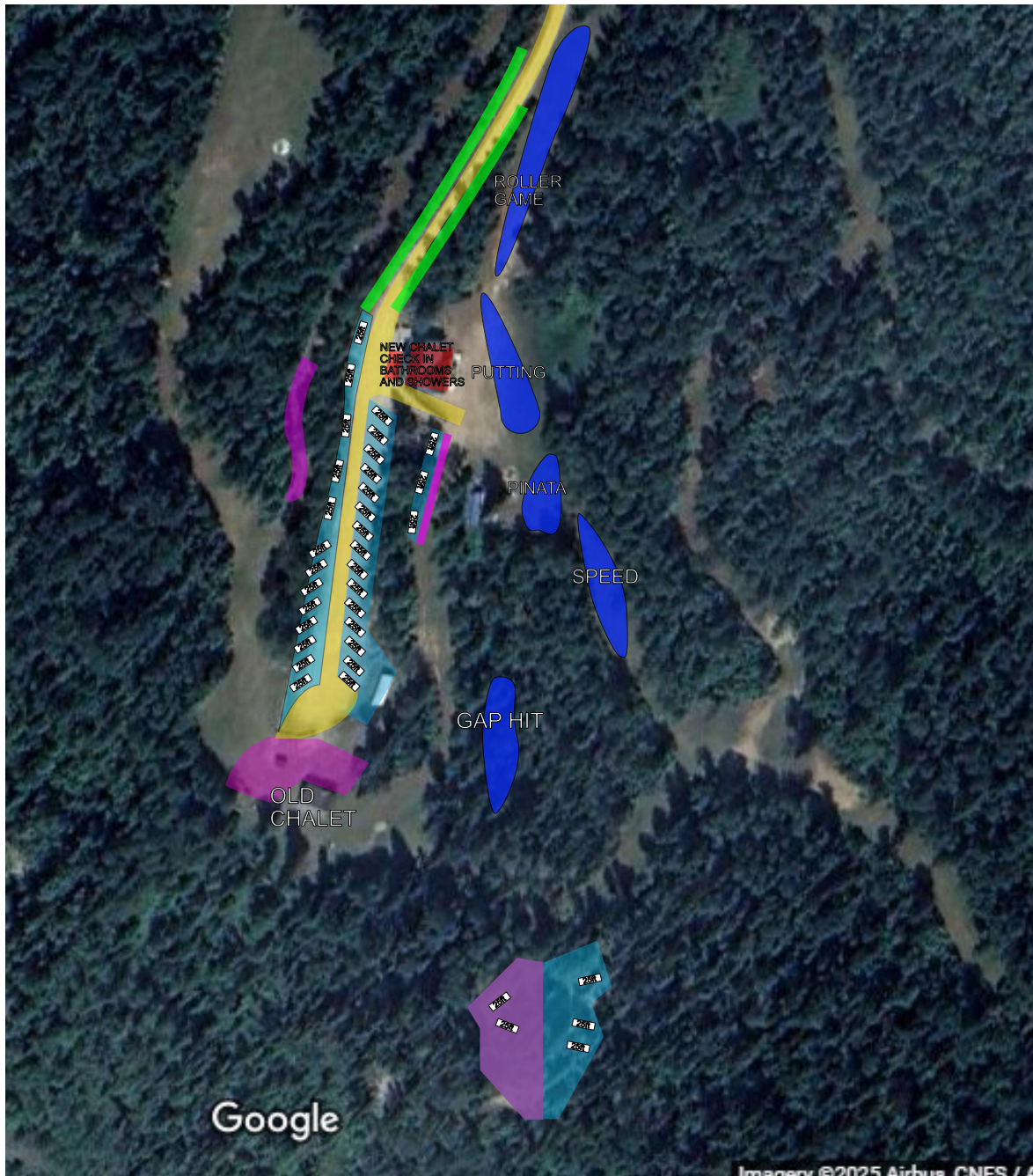
PAR 4 BLUE: 553 FT
WHITE: 443 FT









Hole 18: First shot is to the opening of the first gap. Set yourself up for a second shot to push for distance through the gap to get close to the second gap in front of the basket.
