

## **The Don Shannon Disc Golf Course at Dundee Lake - DUNDEES 22 Hole Layout SHORTS w/island**

### **Hole Notes**

1. Water Right is OB, culvert is OB (white line marks OB). Water will available on hole 1.
2. If 100% surrounded by water it is OB. DO NOT WALK WHERE IT IS WET, it is very slippery.
3. Lake is OB, PLEASE BE CAREFUL OF PLAYERS FINISHING HOLE 3 walking to hole 4 tee pad.
4. If disc is 100% covered by water it is OB, lake is OB.
- 2A. White OB line with Flags on entire backside of this hole. If disc is 100% surrounded by water it is OB. Please be careful of the players on the next tee pad.
- 3A. If disc is 100% surrounded by water it is OB. BE VERY CAREFUL ON THE SMALL GULLEYS AROUND THE BASKET, it's VERY SLIPPERY, go up and down on an angle and try holding on to something if possible.
- 4A. Cliff/river on FAR right is OB. It is clearly marked by white line and flags. If you go into the deep creek, mark where it went OB and then come back and get your disc in between rounds, it's way to dangerous and time consuming to get it during the tournament.
- 5A. SHORT LAYOUT PLAYS RED BASKET.
6. RIGHT SHORT TEE PAD, it's a good idea to have spotter stand wide right by the other short tee pad to watch the flight.
7. No OB, beware of going far wide right .... It's a big drop off down into a swampy wooded area. All water in swamp is Casual relief as far behind it as you deem necessary to make a shot.
8. Road long is OB, if disc comes to rest 100% on road then it is OB, mark where it went out and take 3 feet relief. Fence Long is OB. Kudzu on right side is VERY NASTY, please be careful.
9. Road on left side and parking lot is OB, if disc comes to lay 100% on concrete it is OB, if you flew over road and never even touched the road, mark it where it crossed the road and take 3 feet from road with added penalty stroke. If you go inside of Bathrooms, that is OB.
10. Water bottle refill station. NO OB.
11. No OB, just be careful of very thick wooded area all right side.
12. Be very careful of players finishing Hole 11, it's very hard to see them from the long tee pad.
13. No OB, beware of very thick woods short left and short right side.
14. No OB or Mando, beware of THICK woods on whole right side and left side.

15. Water is OB and it's left, right, and long so be careful.
16. 100% surrounded by water is OB, there is also an added physical OB line marked with Flags. If you throw and never re-establish in bounds on the other side by hitting land or a tree over land, then Drop Zone is Short Tee. And if you end up short in the very thick mud and your not surrounded by water but it's still too muddy to get to, then go back and get it in between rounds or when you're done.
17. Lake is OB.
18. Lake is OB, if disc comes to rest 100% on concrete at pavilion, it is OB. Pavilion roof is OB.
19. This is an Island Hole, if you don't land in the clearly marked island landing zone, then you have landed in the hazard zone. It is then a Hazard stroke and you simply play from your lie with an added penalty stroke.
