There may be spectators at this event, so please ensure their safety and ask them to move to a safe spot if they are in an area where they could be injured by your throw. Please also be aware that there may be a group of photographers taking pictures of this event. Keep an eye out for them as well and keep them safe.

Course Rules:

All roads are played as out of bounds. The bullards marking the roads are the boundaries and they are in bounds.

The parking lot is played as out of bounds. The concrete curb surrounding it is the boundary and it is in bounds...so your disc is in bounds if it is touching the concrete curb.

There are a number of mandos on the course which are described in the hole description in this book and on the PDGA scorecard. Drop zones are marked next to the mandos...each mando has its own drop zone.

There is one OB line separating hole 3 and hole 4 fairways. The line is OB for both holes and the line itself is OB. There is also an OB line for hole 18 long and right of basket.

Tie breaking for division winners only will be on a four-hole loop of #8, #9, #10, #18. The tie break may require a shotgun start depending on how many divisions require a tie break. The TD will decide which hole each tie breaking group will start on.

The course will be officially open for practice in the tournament layout Friday morning from 10:00 am to 9:30 pm when the temporary basket for hole #18 will be stored for the night. The course will be switched over into tournament layout Thursday afternoon.

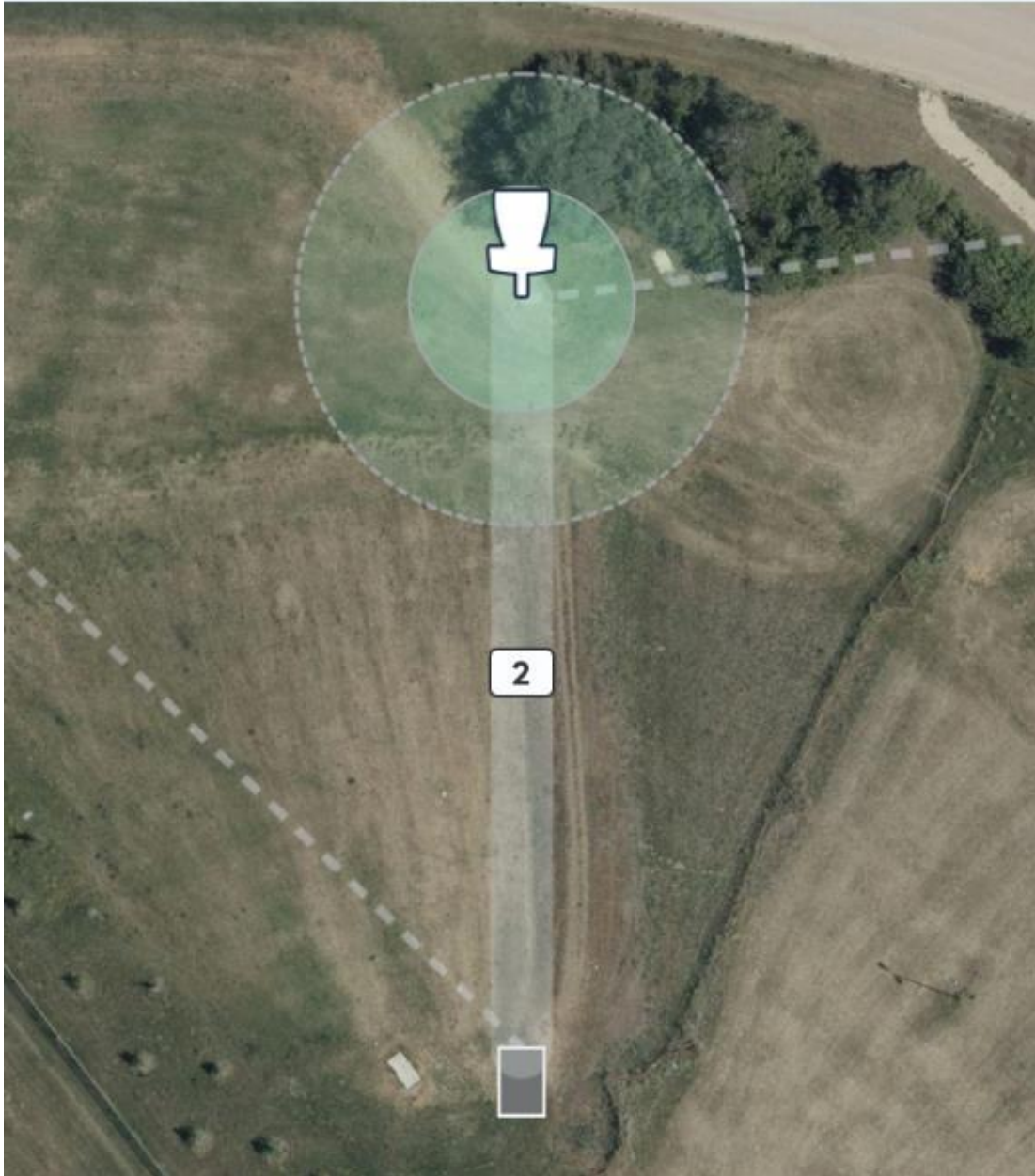


Hole 1 • Par 3 • 299 ft

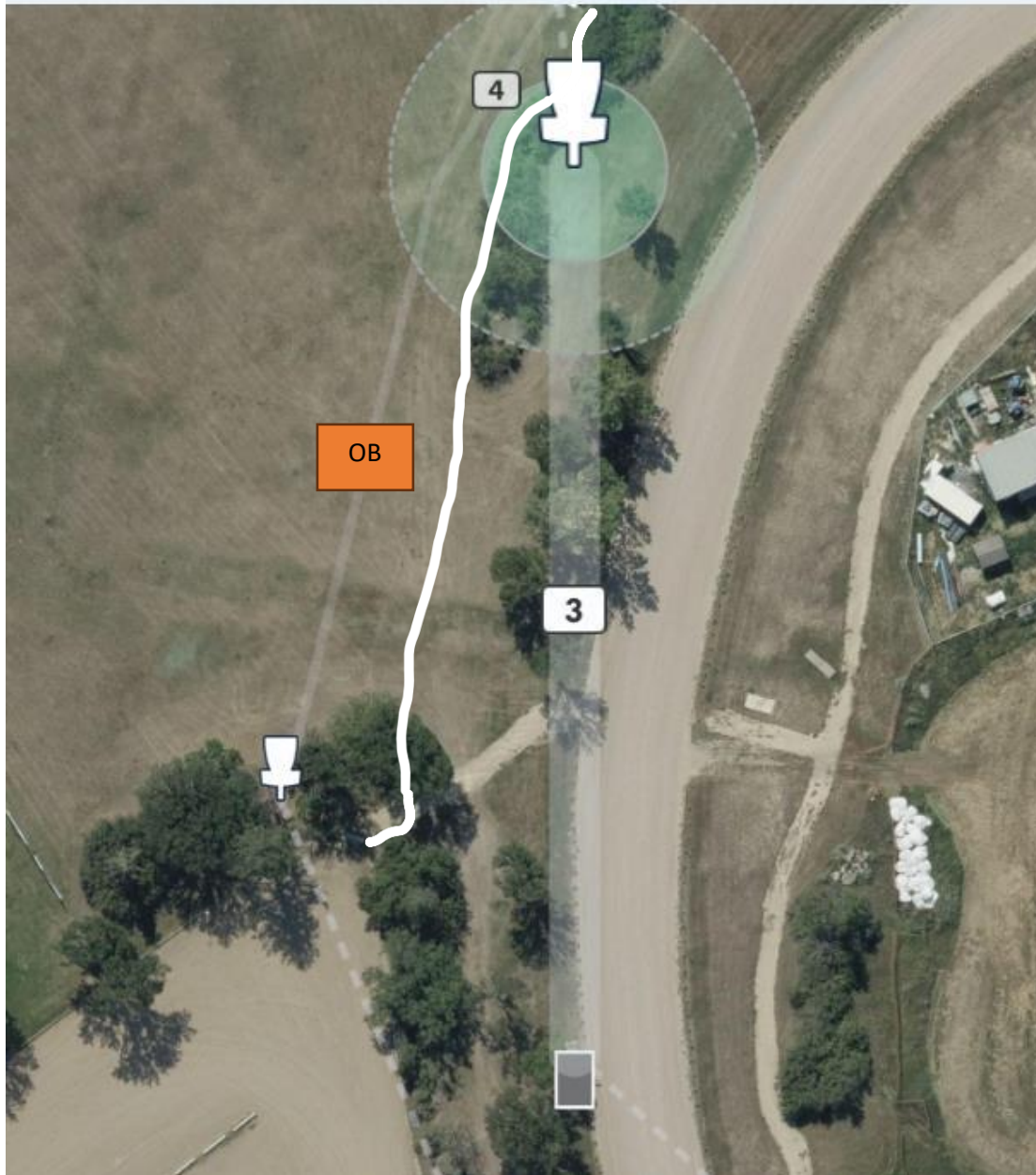

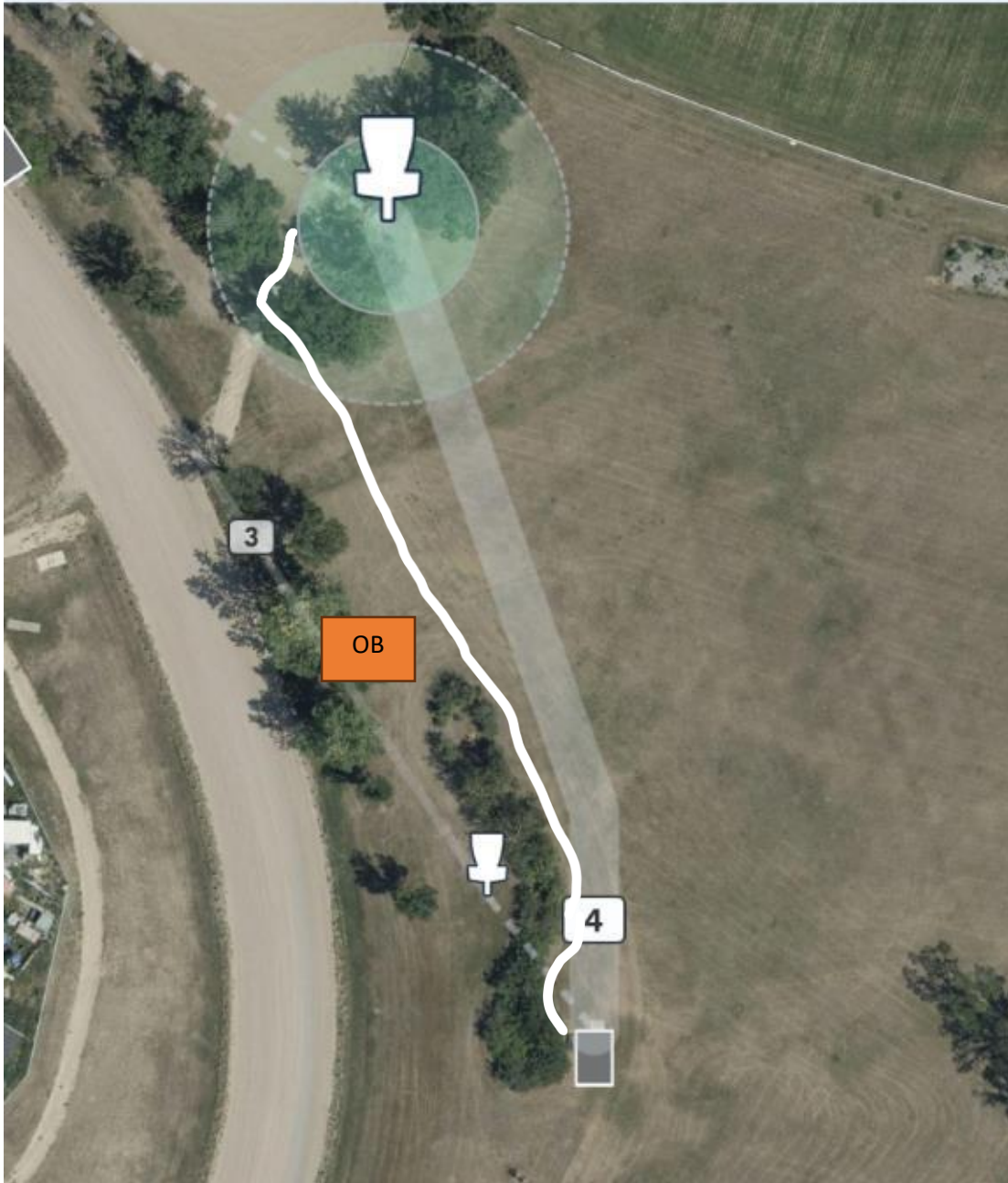

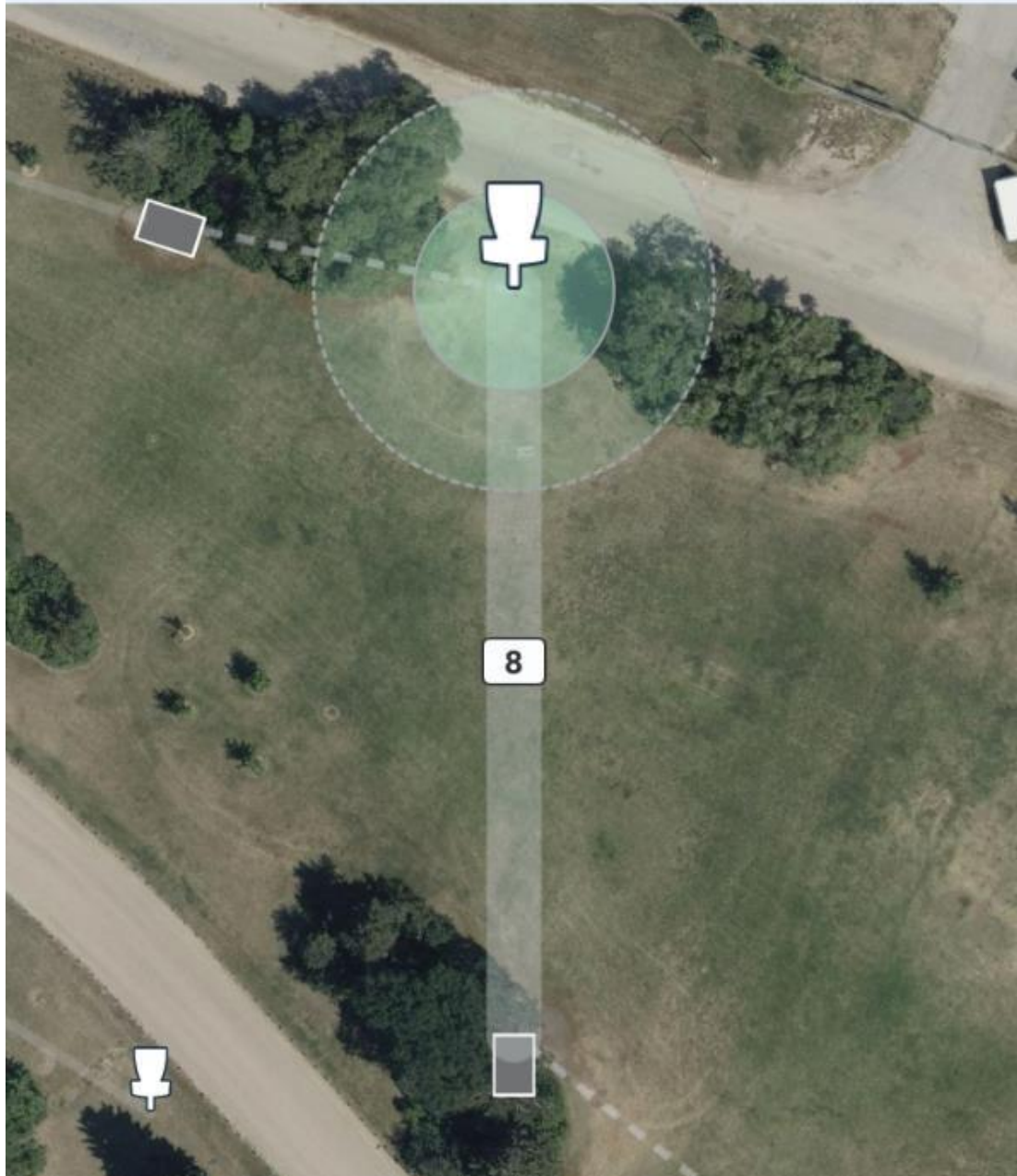

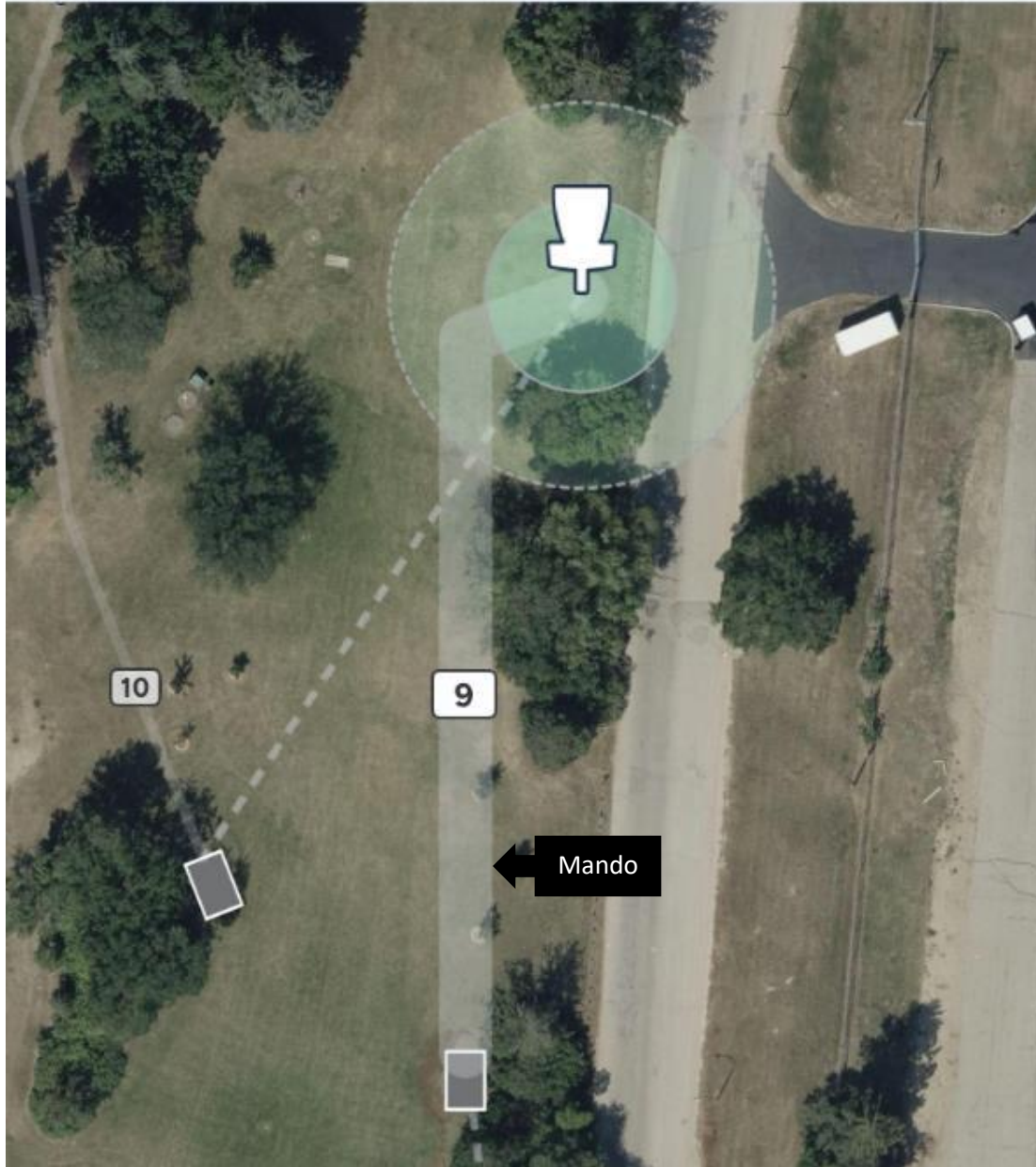

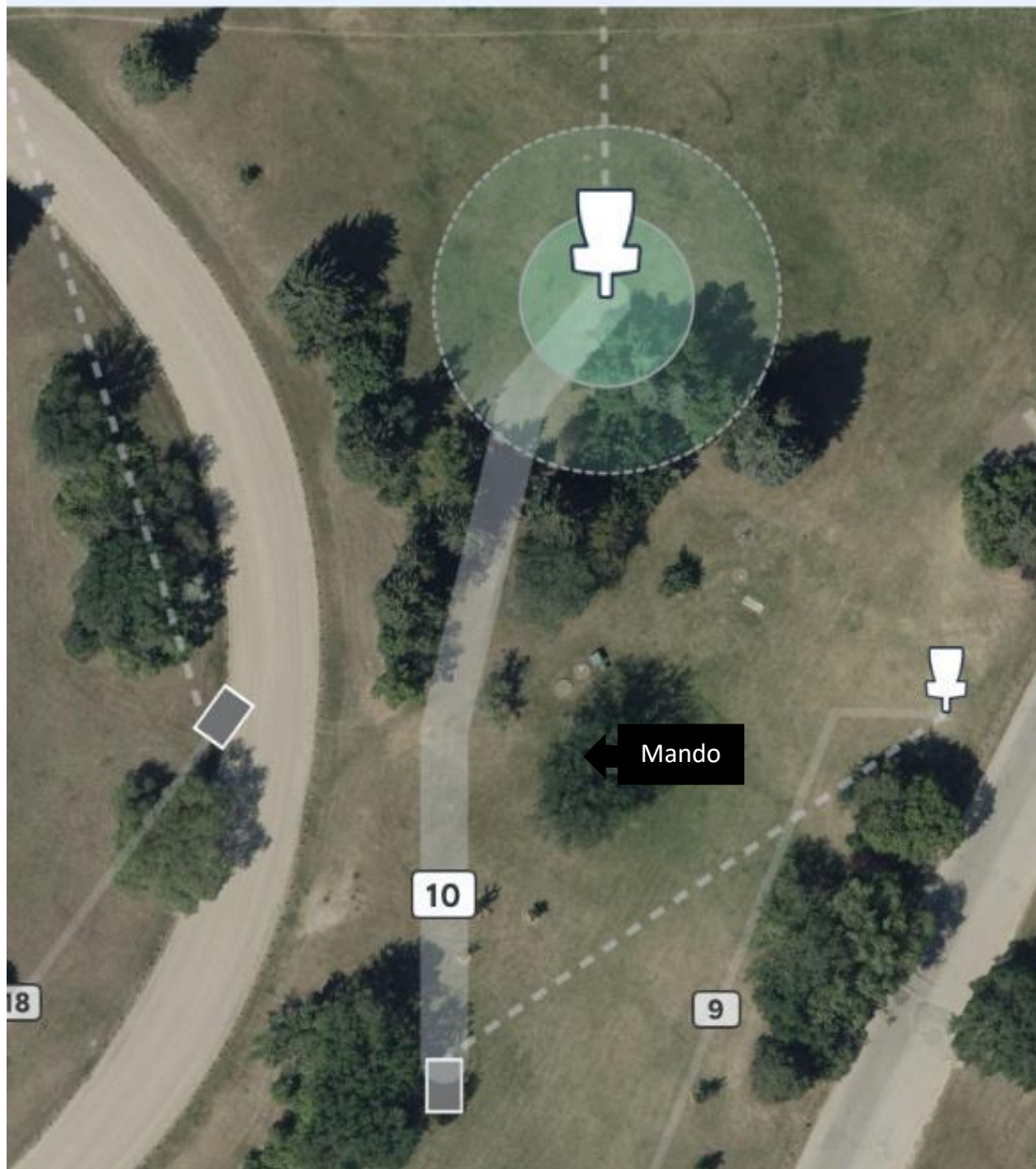

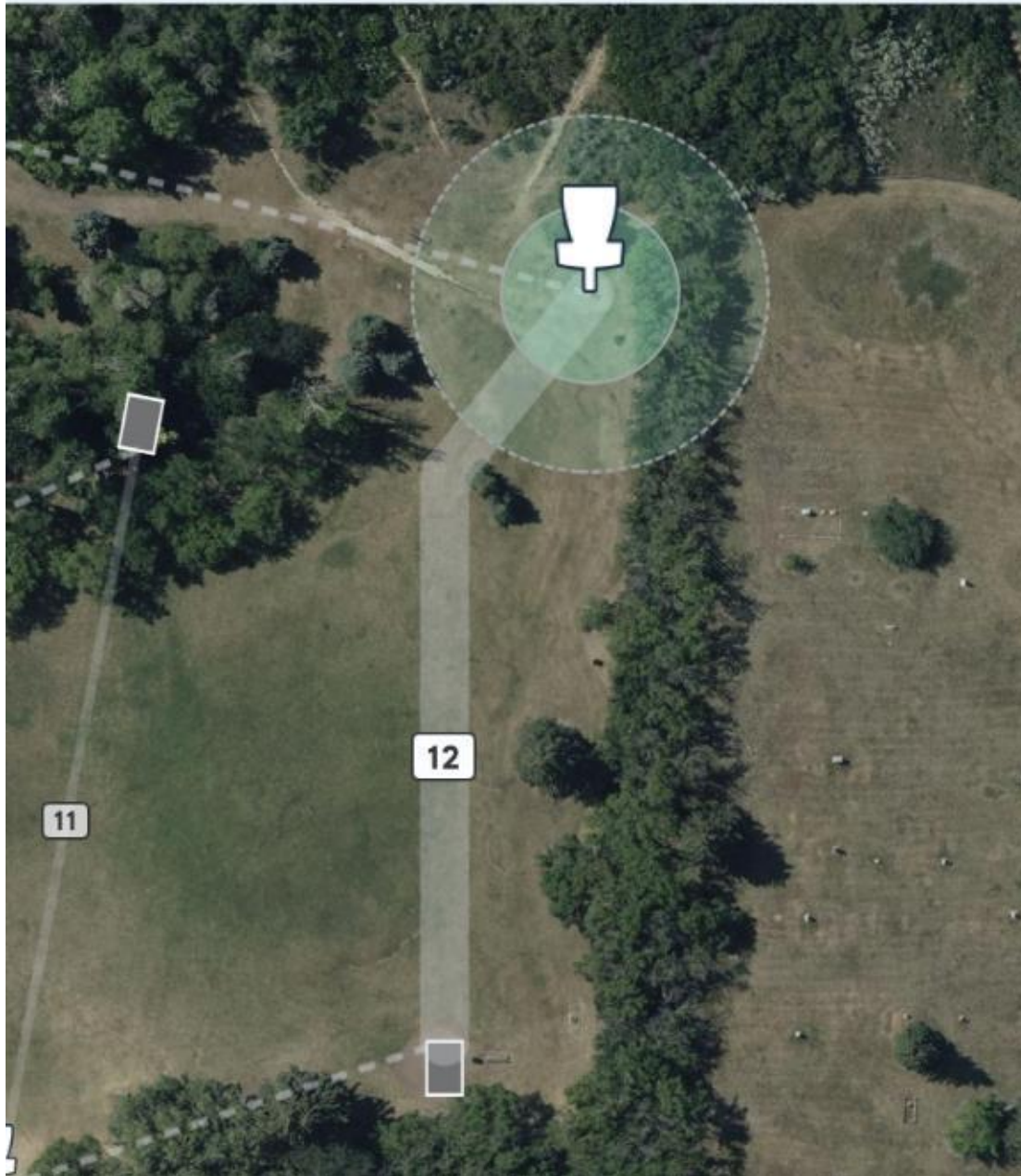

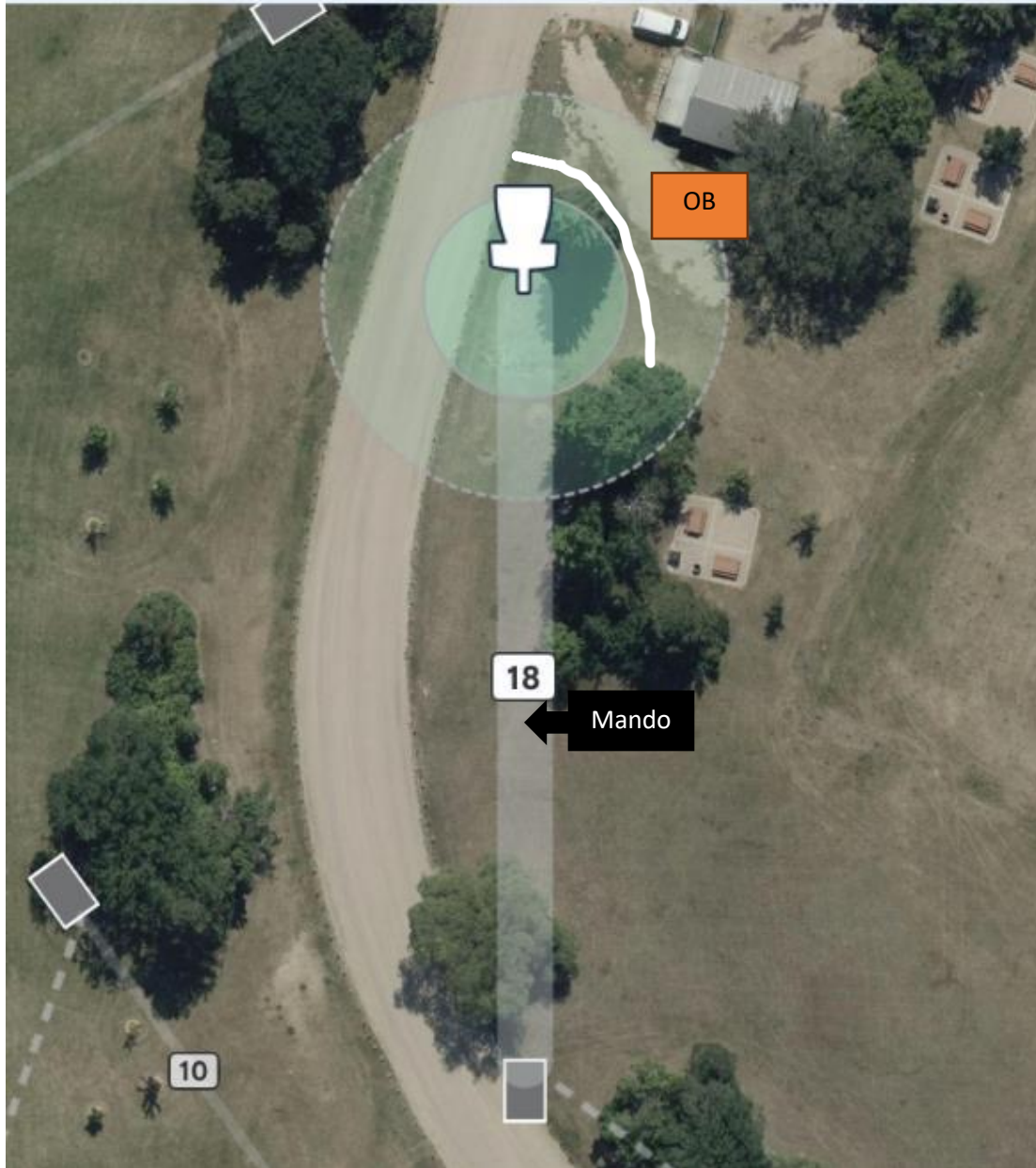
