Alabama State Park Disc Golf Series at Joe Wheeler State Park course layout

Hole 1: 269ft, par3

This hole plays as an island. The tee shot must clear the road to be in bounds. If the drive does not cross in bounds, the player must re-tee with a one-stroke penalty. Road is OB, and all subsequent throws follow normal OB rules. CTP in effect on this hole.

Hole 2: 275ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 3: 227ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 4: 287ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 5: 251ft, par3

No OB. This is a CTP hole!

Hole 6: 276ft, par3

Water is OB. If OB, play from last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

Hole 7: 246ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 8: 325ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 9: 231ft, par3

On or across the road is OB long of the basket. If OB, play from the last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

Hole 10: 307ft, par3

On or across the road is OB long of the basket. If OB, play from the last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

This is a CTP hole!

Hole 11: 283ft, par3

On or across the roads to the right and long of the basket are OB. If OB, play from the last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

Hole 12: 560ft, par4 (temp basket)

On or across the road to the left is OB. The parking lot to the left and long of the basket is OB. If OB, play from the last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

Hole 13: 366ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 14: 296ft, par3

Water is OB. If OB, play from the last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

Hole 15: 418ft, par4

Water is OB. If OB, play from the last place in bounds with a penalty stroke.

Hole 16: 467ft, par4

No OB.

Hole 17: 349ft, par3

No OB.

Hole 18: 302ft, par3

This hole plays as an island. The tee shot must clear the road to be in bounds. If the drive does not cross in bounds, the player must re-tee with a one-stroke penalty. Road is OB, and all subsequent throws follow normal OB rules.

***In general, the only OB is the road when it comes into play with a hole. There are a couple of holes where water is listed as OB... However, I believe the chances of anyone getting in the water on those holes is very unlikely. ***
