

## Towne Lake - Red Tees

### General Notes

Below the playing surface is considered OB in most places where the creek is in play. This means that if you are standing on the fairway and the disc is below your feet on the creek bank then you are OB. Some holes have painted OB that make this rule unnecessary. Refer to your rule sheet for hole by hole OB rules.

### Layout Details

1	Short	3	279	No OB.
2	Long	4	480	Creek and beyond is OB as defined as below the playing surface.
3	Short	3	356	Creek and beyond is OB as defined as below the playing surface.
4	Long	3	306	Creek and beyond is OB as defined as below the playing surface.
5		3	203	Creek and beyond is OB as defined as below the playing surface.
6	Long	3	279	Surrounded by water and beyond is OB left.
7	Short	3	348	Creek and beyond is OB as defined as below the playing surface.
8	Long	3	221	OB in creek defined by a PAINTED LINE. ALL OB drives will go to the marked drop zone. Any additional OB strokes will play from the last place the disc was in bounds.
9	Short	3	292	OB line painted along the tall grass line long and right of the fairway.
10	Long	3	278	NO OB
11	Right	3	253	Surrounded by water and beyond on the right is OB.
12	Long	4	415	NO OB. Players may take relief is their lie is within the fallen tree on the fairway.
13	Long	3	321	NO OB
14	Long	3	290	NO OB
15	Short	4	458	Road and beyond is OB.
16	Long	4	487	Tall grass line on the right is OB defined by a painted line.
17	Short	3	265	Creek and beyond is OB as defined as below the playing surface.
18	Long	4	458	Sidewalk and beyond is OB.
