COURSE LAYOUTS

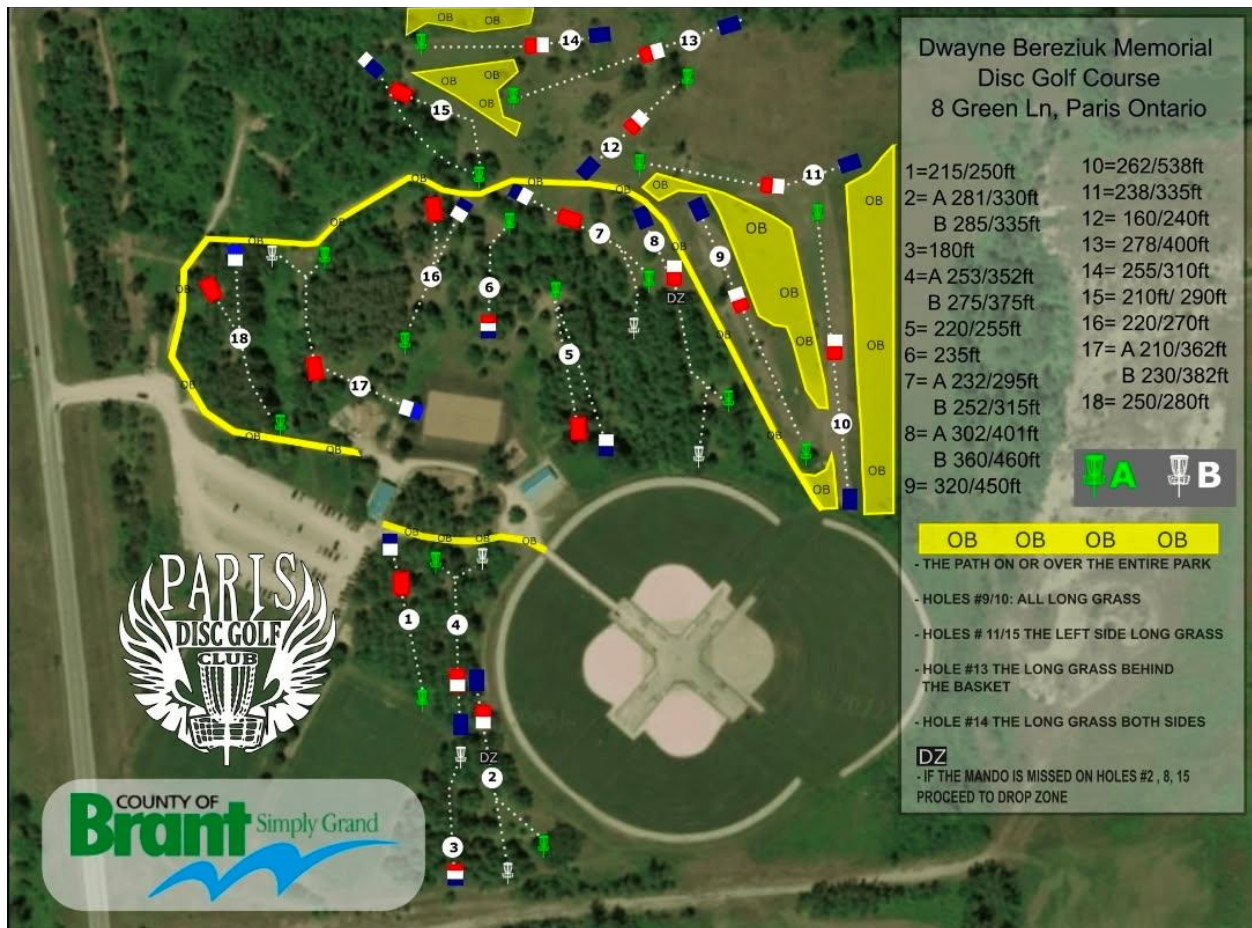
The course layouts will be as follows:

FPO, FP40, FP50 and FA1 will be playing the WHITE TEES LEAGUE LAYOUT #1 to A baskets

All others, including Masters Pros 60+ will be playing RED TEES to A baskets.

Juniors have the option of playing one or two rounds.

PLEASE NOTE that for the RED layout, the ONLY OB for this tournament will be the walking paths (on and beyond), over the fence on hole 10, and the two mandos on hole 2 and 8. These OBs are in place for safety reasons. For the WHITE layout, the OB on the course layout will still apply.



SCORING AND RESULTS

We will be using the PDGA Live Scoring for the event to help things run smoothly and keep everyone informed. The PDGA rules require ALL players (or their caddie) to keep scores for every player on the card. At least one player on each card must use PDGA Live, which is the preferred method of score keeping. However, if you have difficulty with the PDGA Live App, then UDisc or paper scorecards are also acceptable. Paper scorecards will be provided at the registration table. Please remember to confirm the final score with your cardmates at the end of each round.

THE ACCESS CODE FOR THIS EVENT IS: **PARIS26**

In the event of a tie at the end of the second round, the first place winner will be decided using the “sudden death” format. Playoffs will be a rotation of **hole one** and **hole four** until one player achieves the lowest score. This will be done as soon as possible upon the availability of both holes at the end of the day.

TOURNAMENT ACE POT

Many players have already entered the Ace Pot at the time of online registration. However, if you did not, and now wish to do so, you may add to the pot at check-in for \$5.00 cash only.

PLAYERS PACK MERCH VOUCHER

As a part of every amateur player pack, participants will be receiving a \$25 voucher to be redeemed at the **Discy Chicks Disc Golf** sales tent. Mindy and Rob Myall will be on site for the duration the tournament. Although the voucher itself is valid for one year from the date of the tournament, players are encouraged to take advantage of the on-site availability at the time. If the voucher is not redeemed on the day of the tournament, feel free make arrangements with Mindy to meet up with her at a future date and location.

RAFFLE & 50/50 DRAW

We have received a wide variety of donations for raffle prizes for this event. Many participants have already purchased raffle tickets with their registration. If you missed the online opportunity or wish to purchase more tickets, they will be available at the registration table throughout the day. Cash is preferred.
