Thanks for signing up for the 2024 Pot of Gold presented by Innova. The New Orleans Disc Golf Club wants to extend our thanks to all of the people that made this event possible. First and foremost, that is you, the players. Without your support, this event could not happen. We are hoping that the 16th annual Pot of Gold is one to remember. With that said, this guide will prepare you for everything you need to know for the tournament.

The 2024 Pot of Gold is being held on April 13 and 14 at New Orleans City Park and Parc des Familles. It is a 2 day, 3 round B tier event. All players will receive a t shirt and lunch for both days thanks to our sponsors. All amateur players will also receive a 32 oz. Innova thermal Canteen, an Innova towel, an Innova Wristband, and 3 discs: a halo star, a star/champion, and a dx disc. The player packs will feature a variety of molds and will be distributed as first come, first serve. Discs will be available for purchase on Sunday at the following prices, DX—\$14, Champion/Star—\$18, Metal Flake/Color Glow—\$20, and halo—\$25.

With everyone at City Park on Sunday, we will host a couple extra games during the event. There will be a group of vendors stationed near tournament central. Following the tournament, we will host the awards ceremony and raffle. There will be a CTP free to everyone involved in the tournament in which the winner will take home a brand new Innova Basket. Everyone will have the option to purchase additional throws for the CTP challenge as well. It is not one of the holes on the course.

Tee assignments will be posted once registration closes. We will have Sundays Tee times posted following the second round on Saturday. Once registration closes, we will have a rough estimate of each divisions tee times.

All lies are subject to relief from the vertical wooden pillars that line O.B. with 1 meter under normal relief rules. O.B. shots may take a meter in any direction while shots that remain in bounds must be taken perpendicular to the O.B. line.

Holes 3 and 12's Teepads are marked with flags and listed as "Black Tee."

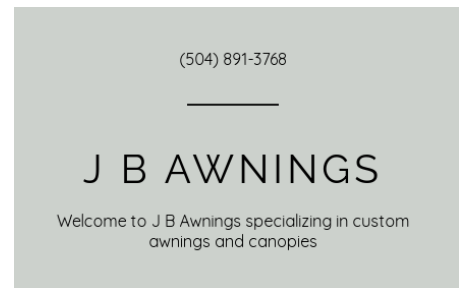

Please do not speed through the parks. City Park has speed cameras on nearly every through street into the park. PDF has a west bank police department on the property and does not want us flying through the park.

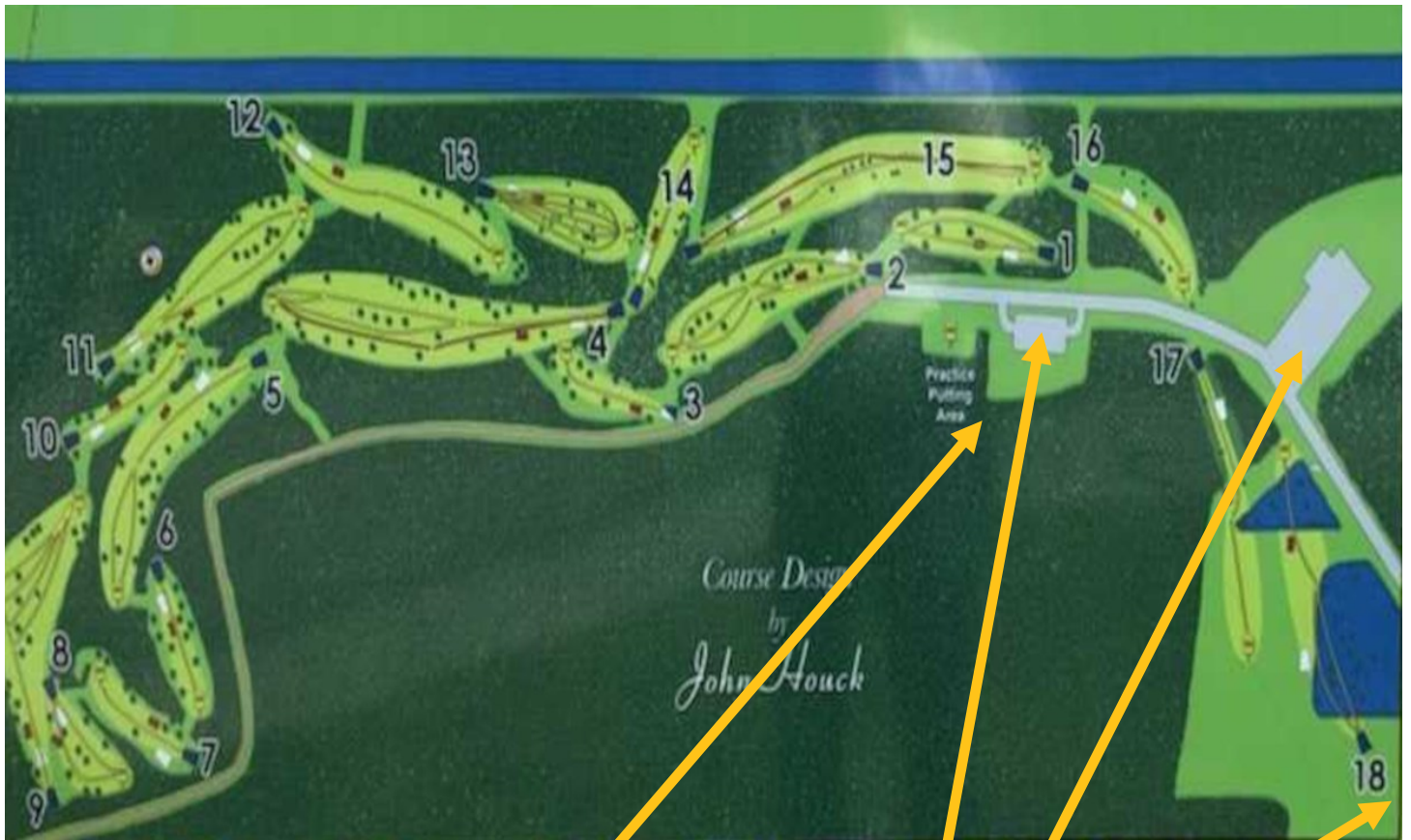
Make sure to hydrate, we will have water and snacks along the courses, but make sure to take care of yourself.
