Feel free to verify with me to confirm your scorecard was properly submitted. To login to live scoring, go to PDGA.com/score and enter the passcode on display at tourney central. #### **Schedule of Events:**

Saturday, May 17, 2025

0730-0825: Check in and pick up your player pack. If you do not check in with me by 8:30 AM, you may lose your spot. **Don't be late!** 

8:30 AM: Quick Player Meeting

9:00 AM: First round shotgun start.

1:00 PM (Approximate): 2<sup>nd</sup> round shotgun start will begin. (I will send the exact 2<sup>nd</sup> round tee time to the email list for the event, via comment on Disc Golf Scene and post on the Upstate Disc Golf Facebook Page. It will be about an hour after all 1<sup>st</sup> round scores have been submitted and have been updated online.)

4:00 PM (Approximate): Trophies/Payouts will be delivered.

#### **OB and Course Rules**

Tiebreaker procedure: 1st place ties will be broken using sudden death playoff starting on hole 1 and continuing along division layout until a winner is decided. Ties for 2nd place trophies and beyond will be determined by who threw the best first round score. If that is a tie, a CTP throw from hole 9 white tee will determine tiebreaker.

**Hole Specific Rules:** 

Hole 1: Blue Tee.

Hole 2: Blue Tee. OB Pond (marked by flags,

or water's edge in absence of flags)

Hole 3: White Tee. OB Pond (marked by flags, or water's edge in absence of flags), Road and beyond (long), and Creek and beyond (white stakes, or water's edge in absence of stakes). There is an optional OB drop zone left of the basket marked on each side by double white flags. Players can opt out of driving and go directly to the drop zone and be throwing 3. OB drives may choose to proceed to the drop zone after taking OB penalty. Normal OB rules are always an option instead of choosing to use the drop zone.

**Hole 4:** White Tee. OB Pond (marked by flags, or water's edge in absence of flags), creek and beyond (white stakes/flags, or water's edge in absence of markers), and flags around the shed mark Relief Area (806.04).

Hole 5&6: White Tee

Hole 7&8: Blue/White Tee.

Hole 9&10: White Tee.

Hole 11: Blue Tee.

**Hole 12:** Blue/White Tee. OB: Fence (right, marked by flags, or inside edge of fence posts in absence of flags).

**Hole 13:** Blue Tee. OB: Fence (right, marked by flags, or inside edge of fence posts in absence of flags).

**Hole 14:** White Tee. OB: Fence (right, inside edge of fence posts, or white flags where present). All creeks play as casual relief.

**Hole 15:** White Tee. OB: Creek and beyond (right, marked by stakes/flags, or water's edge in absence of stakes).

Hole 16: Blue/White Tee.

Hole 17: Blue/White Tee.
