### Layout Details

Hole	Tee	Par	Feet	Notes
1	Front	3	285	OB: White Painted Line on Right and beyond behind basket; fence on left of fairway and beyond.
2	Front	3	300	OB: All Pavement and right of fences around parking spaces and beyond
3	Front	3	195	OB: Pavement walking path marked with white painted lines and pavilion.
4	Front	3	235	OB: Walking path on left and beyond. Road right of basket and beyond. Fence and beyond
5	Front	3	415	OB: Painted line on right side of fairway & behind basket.
6	Front	4	410	OB: Bridge; road and beyond; white painted lines left, right, in ditch before green, and behind the basket and beyond.
7	Front	5	750	OB: Painted line at creek crossing fairway. All asphalt roads. White Painted lines left and right down the fairway prior to the ditch.
8	Front	4	380	OB: Painted lines around creeks. Bridge. Road behind basket and beyond. If drive lands OB, player has option to move to short tee or last in-bounds, with penalty. CASUAL RELIEF AREA: Marked area in orange paint. Player has option to move to DZ without penalty, or play where it lies.
9	Front	3	220	OB: All area before and including road except teepad. If drive does not land in bounds, must retee with penalty. Left of fairway and beyond. MANDO: Middle of fairway must pass to the left. If missed, move to DZ (short tee).
10	Front	3	310	OB: Pavement road left of fairway and beyond.
11	Front	3	300	OB: Pavement road left of fairway and beyond.
12	Front	4	610	OB: Racquetball, tennis courts, and related sidewalk. Road on the right and beyond.
13	Front	5	570	OB: Road on left and beyond; parking lot up the hill on left; paved roads around basket and beyond; Hole 14 tee pads.
14	Front	3	260	OB: Road and everything left and beyond as marked by painted white line.
15	Front	3	275	OB: Road left of fairway and beyond.
16	Front	3	275

**17** Front 3 310 OB: White Painted line to right of fairway.

**18** Front 5 665 OB: White Painted line left side of fairway and behind.
