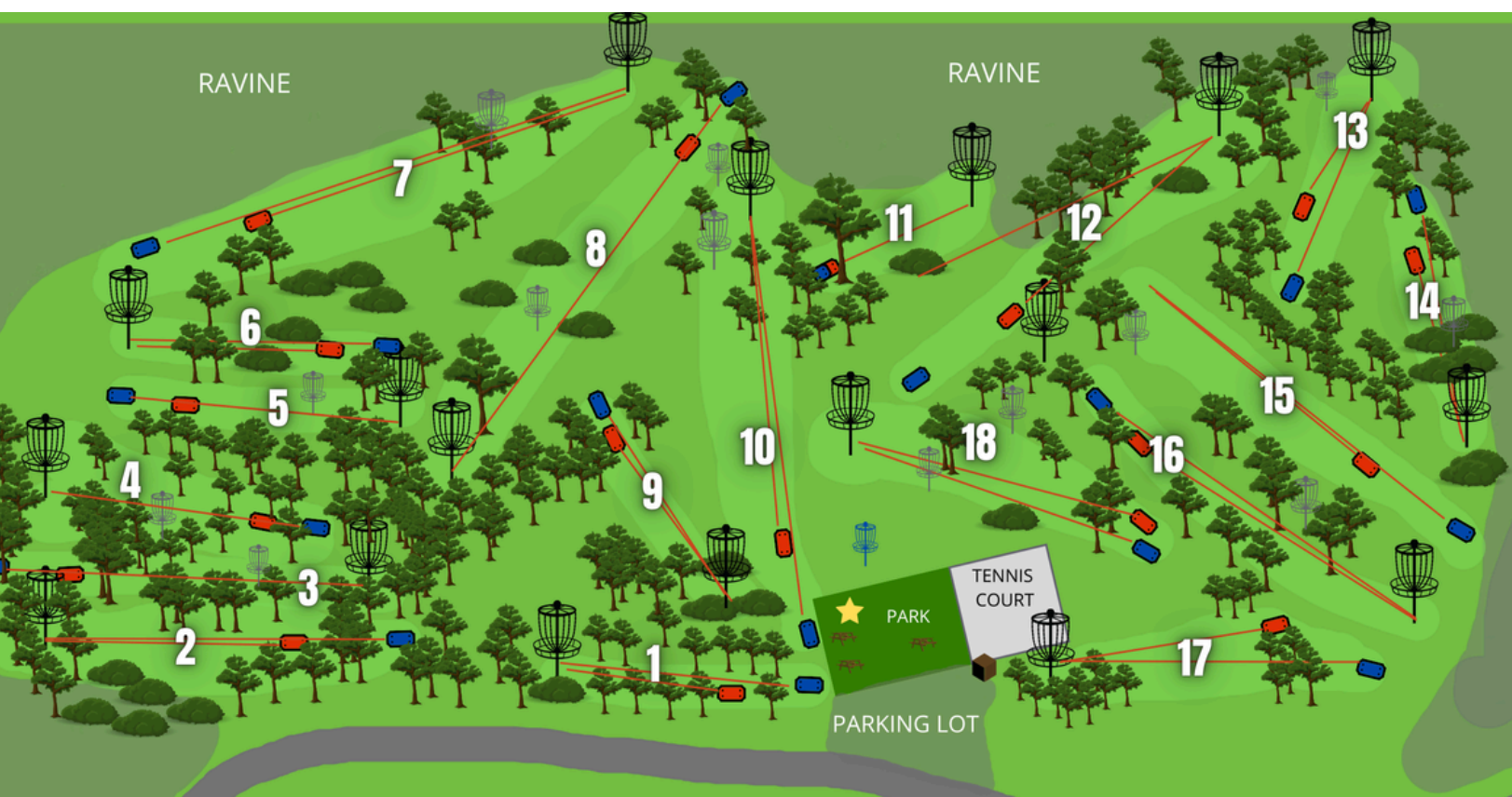




CRUSH CUB SPRING BLOOM

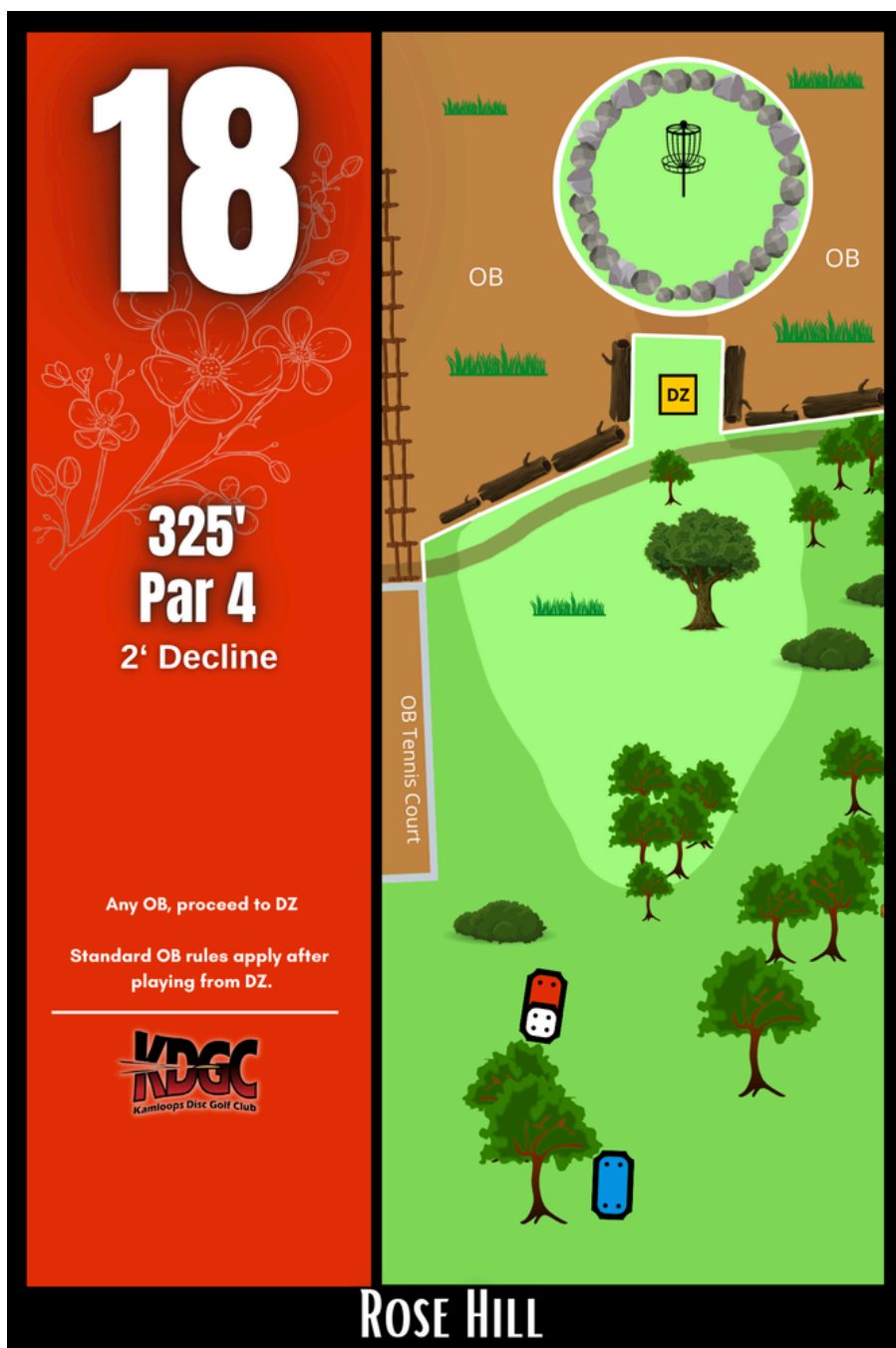

OUT of BOUNDS

Marked with stakes or fenceline, the front of the stake or fence, facing into the fairway, is always the OB line.

Proceed with OB rules

Any Out of Bounds line that finishes goes in an infinity line from the last two stakes

Hazard

Marked by flags. If you land in the hazard take a penalty stroke and play from where it lies.

MANDATORIES

The course has Mandos & Restricted Areas. Please know the rules of play for both.

All of the Mandos have a drop zone.

NEVER unwind from a Mando! This is not allowed!

PLAYOFF HOLES.

In the case of a playoff for 1st, there will be an aggregate playoff. With no winner yet, moving to sudden death.

Aggregate Play holes: 10,11,18

Sudden Death to follow on the same holes 10, 11, 18.
