A Layout, Par 55: Rd 1 Saturday, Rd 2 Sunday

Hole 1: Basket in the left position. Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to DZ if missed 515 ft.

Hole 2: 261 ft.

Hole 3: Double mandatory through to two marked trees. If either mandatory is missed, proceed to the marked DZ. 236 ft

Hole 4: Long position. Par 4. 478 ft

Hole 5: Island hole. Mandatory left of the marked tree. If mandatory is missed, it is a re-tee. If a disc comes to rest outside of the boundary line, it is played as a hazard. 186 ft.

Hole 6: The basket will be in the short right position in the trees. 238ft.

Hole 7: The basket will be in the long position. Mandatory left of the marked tree on the right and mandatory right of the marked tree on the left If either mandatory is missed, proceed to the DZ in the middle. 408 ft.

Hole 8: The basket will be in the right position. 320 ft.

Hole 9: 331 ft. Mandatory left of the marked tree. Drop zone if missed

Hole 10: Island hole. On, under, or past the magic carpet on the left is OB and is played where it was last in bounds. A disc that comes to rest outside of the boundary string to the right and behind the basket is played as hazard. 259 ft.

Hole 11: Normal course hole 11. Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to DZ if missed. 546 ft.

Hole 12: Normal course hole 12. Mandatory left of the marked tree. Proceed to DZ if missed. 283 ft

Hole 13: Normal course hole 13. 183 ft.

Hole 14: Normal course hole 14. 301 ft.

Hole 15: Normal course hole 15. 265 ft.

Hole 16: Normal course hole 16. 310 ft.

Hole 17: Normal course hole 17. 220 ft.

Hole 18: Normal course hole 18. If the disc comes to rest past the OB lines that create the fairway of hole 10, play where it went out. 278 ft

B Layout, Par 54, Rd 2 Saturday, Rd 1 Sunday

Hole 1: Basket in the left position. Mandatory right of the marked tree. Proceed to DZ if missed 515 ft.

Hole 2: 261 ft.

Hole 3: Double mandatory through to two marked trees. If either mandatory is missed, proceed to the marked DZ. 236 ft.

Hole 4: Short position. 338 ft.

Hole 5: Island hole. Mandatory left of the marked tree. If mandatory is missed, it is a re-tee. If a disc comes to rest outside of the boundary line, it is played as a hazard. 186 ft.

Hole 6: The basket will be in the short right position in the trees. 238ft.

Hole 7: The basket will be in the short position. Mandatory left of the marked tree on the right and mandatory right of the marked tree on the left. If either mandatory is missed, proceed to the DZ in the middle. 328ft.

Hole 8: Basket will be in the left position.. 270 ft.

Hole 9: 270 ft. Mandatory left of the marked tree. Drop zone if missed

Hole 10: Normal course hole 19. 250 ft.

Hole 11: Normal course hole 20. 290 ft.

Hole 12: Normal course hole 21. 288 ft.

Hole 13: Normal course hole 22. 261 ft.

Hole 14. Normal course hole 23. Mandatory left of the marked chair lift pole. If mandatory is missed, proceed to the DZ. 264 ft.

Hole 15: Normal course hole 24. Short position. 259 ft.

Hole 16: Normal course hole 25. 439 ft.

Hole 17: Normal course hole 26. 229 ft.

Hole 18: Normal course hole 27. 290 ft.

All Parking lots, paved roads, deck areas are Out of Bounds (OB).
