Akron Disc Golf Course

FORMAT

- Shotgun start
- 11 hole course played twice in succession in the morning, twice in succession in the afternoon. 44 total holes
- Basket positions

Start:	8:00 am
Morning Rounds:	Two rounds at the " Morning " basket locations.
Lunch:	11:30 am estimated (allotted time to be determined based on remaining daylight)
Afternoon Rounds:	Two rounds at the " Afternoon " basket locations.
Awards Presentations:	Immediately following afternoon rounds.

COURSE RULES

- Property boundaries, defined by barbed wire fencing, are **always** OB. Two meter relief from barbed wire fence.
- If your disc slides underneath a rock far enough that it cannot be safely reached with your foot, mark it on top of the rock and play from there.
- Please be courteous to any fishermen or park enthusiasts.
- 2025 - With the recent rains, water will be in play significantly on hole 4 and 5, and is closer to the baskets on holes 7 and 8. It is important to make sure that we make "completely surrounded by water" judgements objectively and fairly, as the water boundaries, being a bit 'temporary' in nature, are sometimes hard to define.

NOTABLE PDGA RULES

- Everyone keeps score! Whether that be paper, UDisc or PDGA, everyone must keep score.
- No drinking or drugging during the event.
- No pets or loud music, service animals are exempt. Players may use earbuds or headphones but they must be able to communicate with their cardmates at all times.
- Lost disc. Remember, this rule means that your disc must be found within 3 minutes of arriving at the point of where you think your disc should be. Please be mindful of this rule, and courteous when enforcing and applying this rule. The holes that are particularly susceptible to this rule are 1, 5, 7, and 8.

SCORING

Scoring can be done either via PDGA.com, PDGA App, UDisc or Paper. We highly recommend everyone using the PDGA app because it will alert you when there is a score mismatch right away.

The passcode for this event will be: **AKRON44**

PLAYOFFS

All playoffs (for first place only) are sudden death and will play the following holes in repeating fashion until a winner is determined.

Holes 1, 2, 3 10, 11

FOOD

Lunch is taken care of for all players and caddies, no need to worry about packing your own. Once round one wraps up, we'll have a full spread ready: meats, cheeses, fresh veggies, fruit, drinks, and maybe even dessert to top it off. Trophies will be awarded to first place only for each division. Trophies are replica Colorado plates based on a historical actual license plate design.


