Practical information

Practice time: Parc Bourdon is a permanent course set up in a public parc. It is open for practice right away. Please note that Swin Golf players have priority access to the parc on Tuesday and Friday afternoons. Respect all non-player parc users and don't enter any private area around the course before being granted permission to do so.

Always send spotters before throwing from the tee of holes 8, 13 and 18.

Ground markings and tee signs will be installed shortly before the tournament.

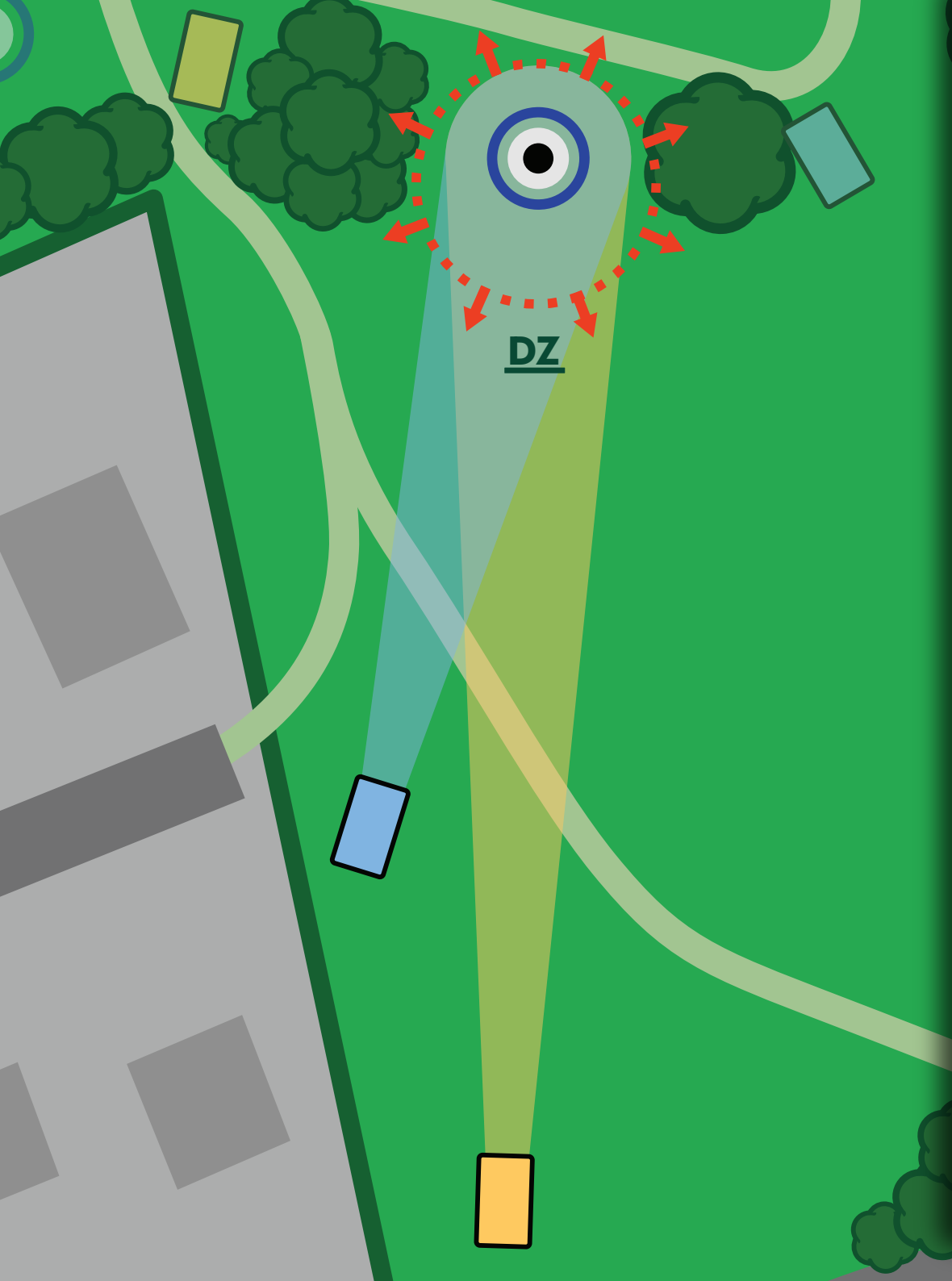

- Outside the island.

If you miss the island on your first shot, proceed to the Drop Zone (DZ) with one penalty stroke. From the second throw onwards, normal Out of Bounds rules apply.

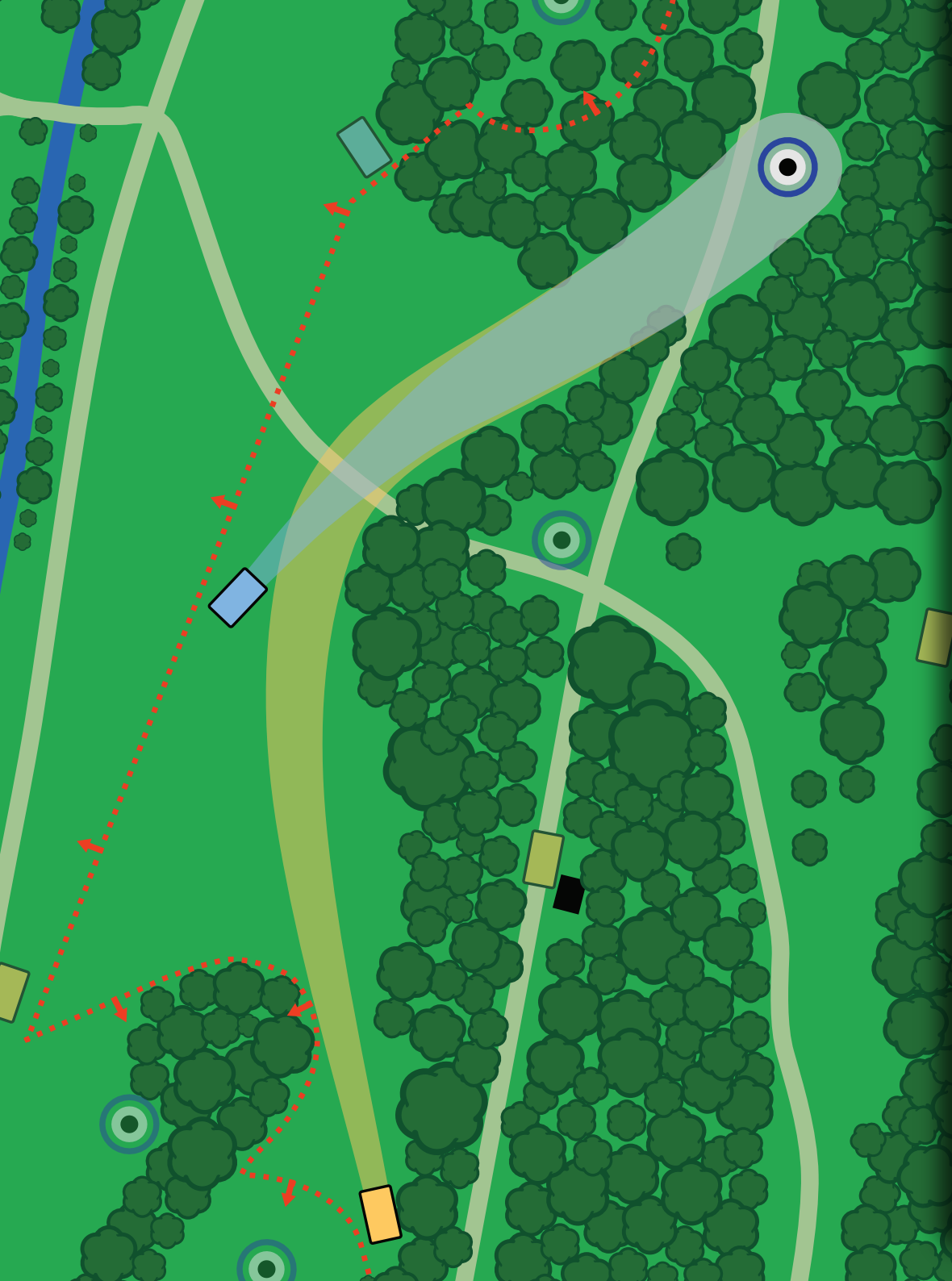

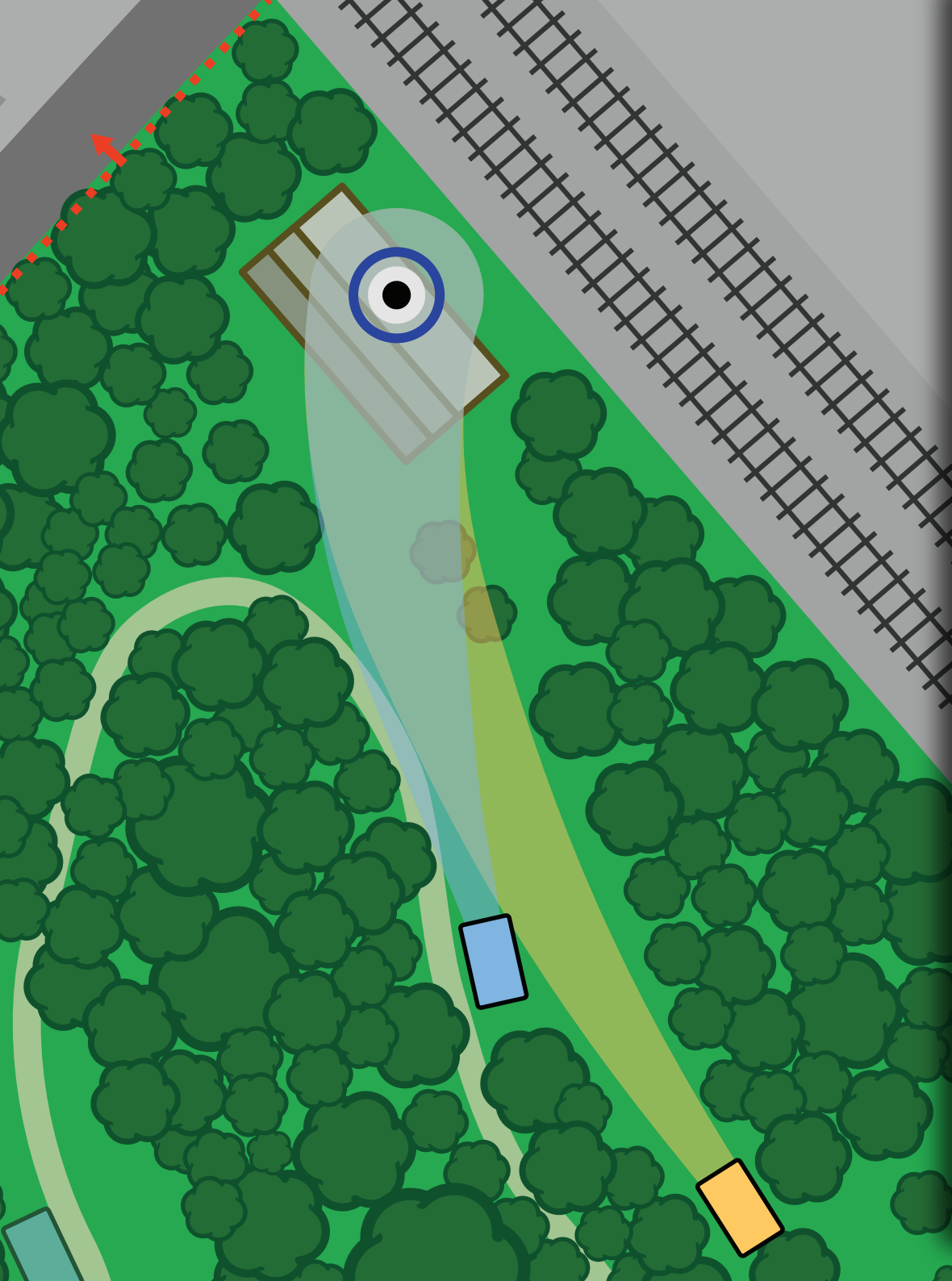

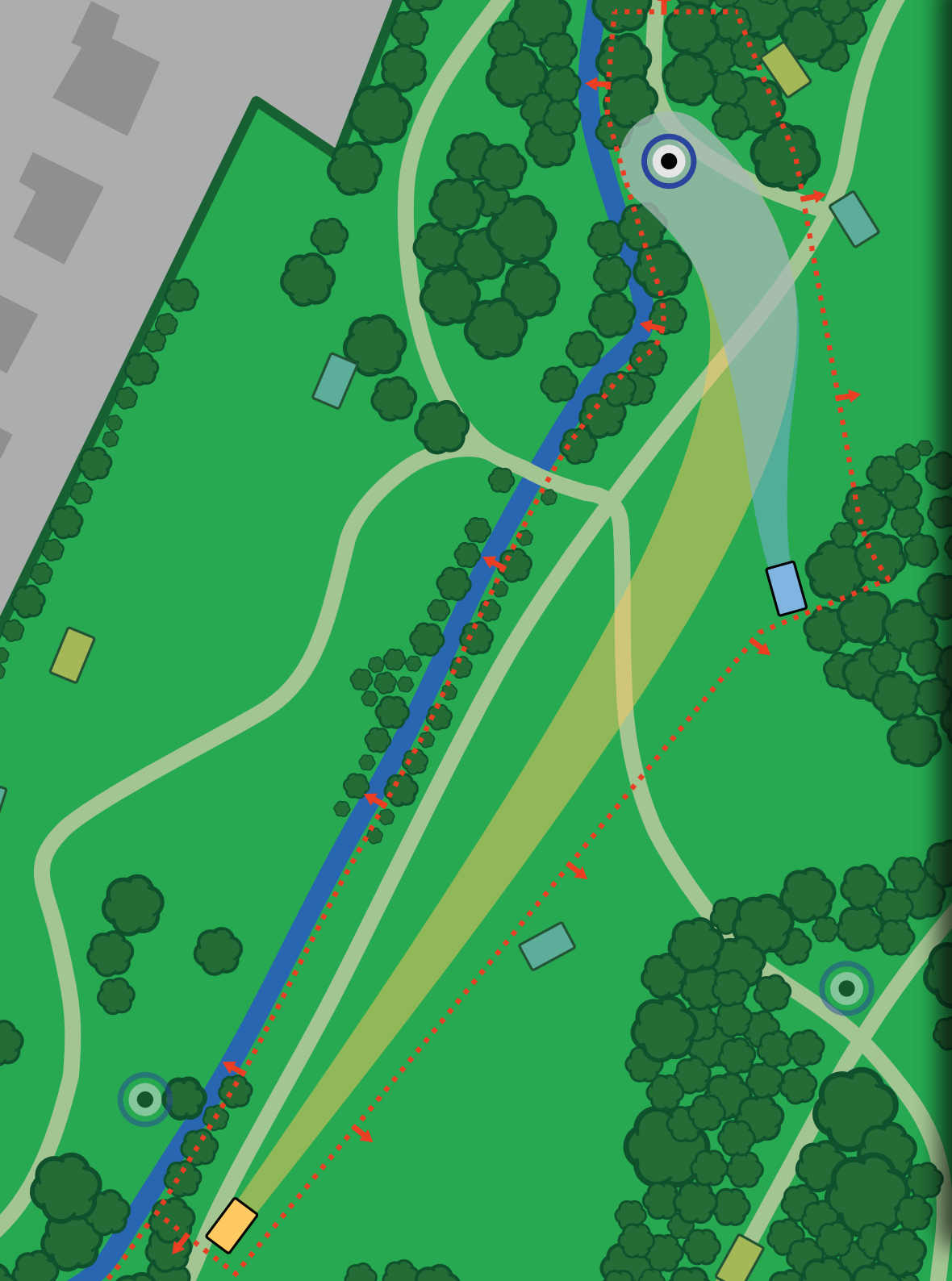

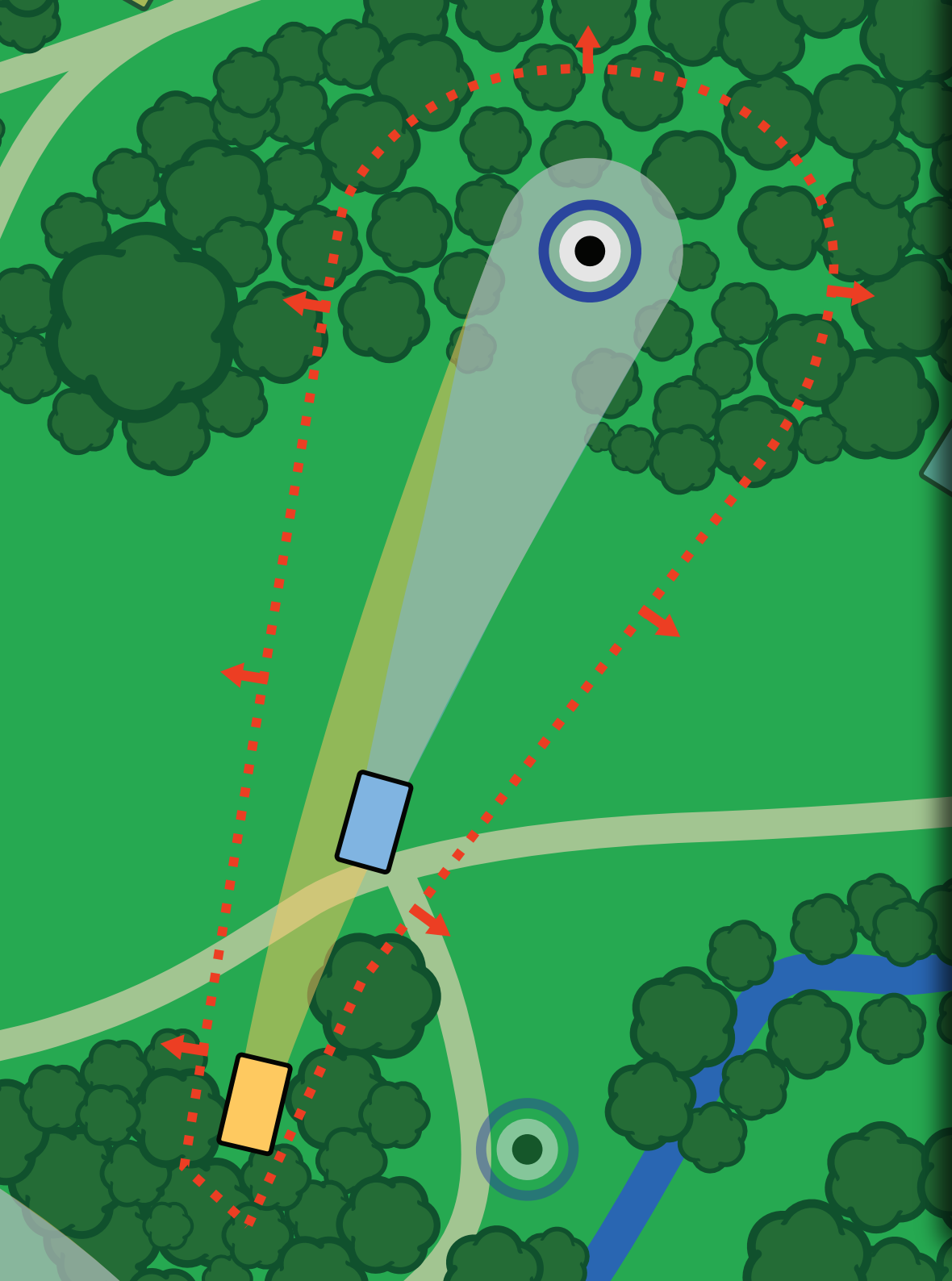

- Long: Over the path (ground markers).
