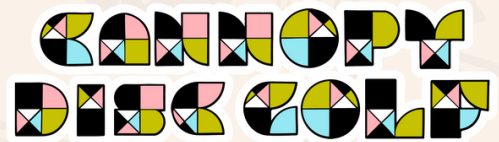

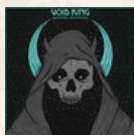

They provide a range of activities, including equine therapy, archery, cycling, and now – a disc golf course. 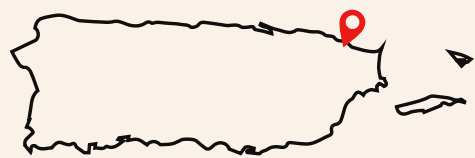

Since moving here in 2022 we've aimed to introduce disc golf to local communities using travel baskets & mostly donated discs. In 2023 we designed Playa Lucia Disc Golf Course in Yabucoa, the first course on the main island. We quickly hosted the first sanctioned event with nearly 50 players in December 23'. In 2024, we established the non-profit Federacion Puertorriquena de Disc Golf, gaining official recognition from the PDGA & PDGA Latino America. With community support, we improved the Playa Lucia Balneario and are retailing new Prodigy & Dynamic Discs as well as some mixed brand used discs + lots of other handmade disc golf merch. 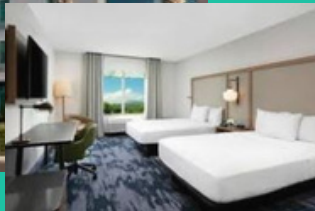

Things to Do in the East (within 1 Hr of San Juan and Courses)

Exploring the eastern region of Puerto Rico, including the enchanting island of Vieques, offers a plethora of attractions that showcase the island's natural beauty, rich history, and vibrant culture. Here's a curated list of must-visit spots:

El Yunque National Forest

Located in the northeast, El Yunque is the only tropical rainforest in the U.S. National Forest System. Visitors can hike through lush trails leading to waterfalls like La Mina and La Coca, observe diverse flora and fauna, and enjoy panoramic views from Yokahú Tower.

Luquillo Beach
