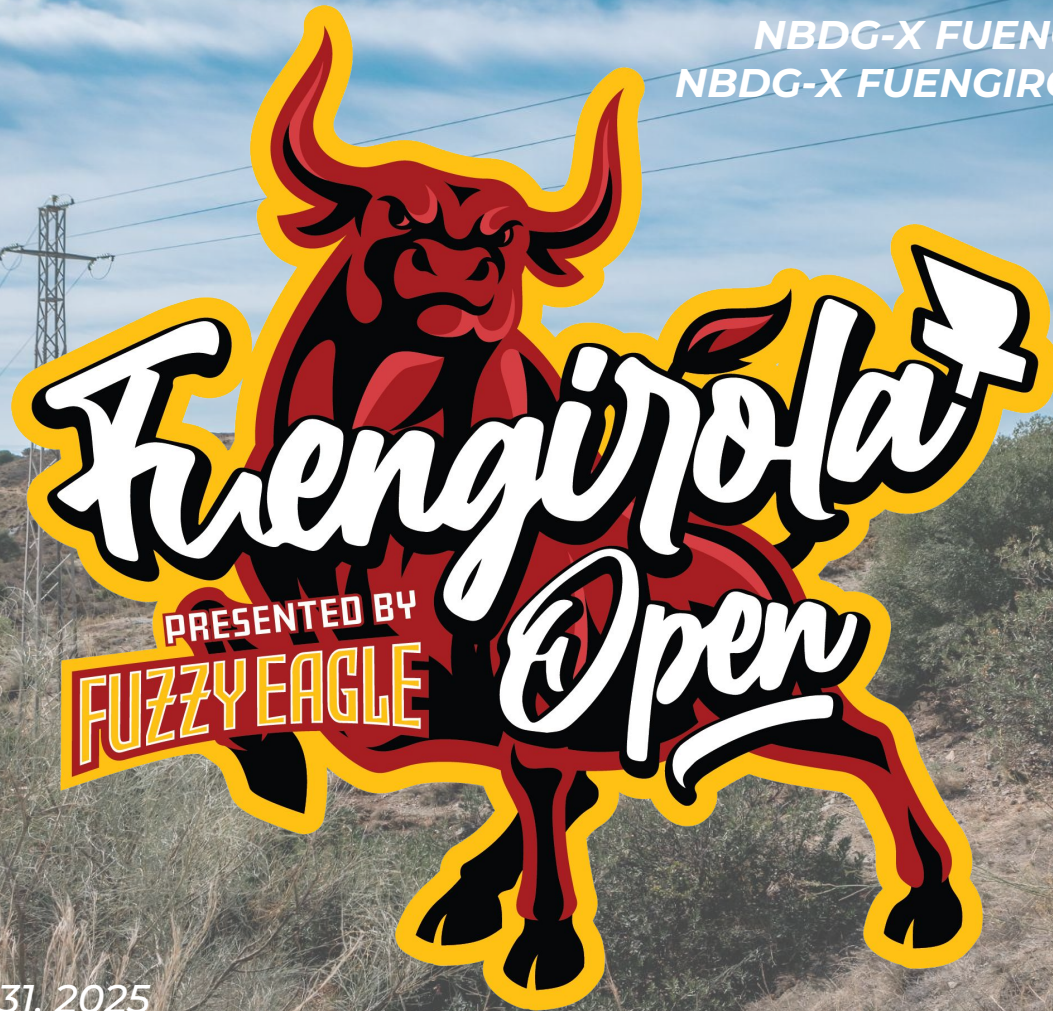

PRACTICING & CASUAL ROUNDS

- There are some restrictions with practicing / warm-up and casual rounds during these two weeks. If there is a competition ongoing, casual playing (including practice and warm-up) **IS NOT ALLOWED** anywhere on that layout. Putting baskets and throwing net at the proshop can be used all the time.
- Respect the given timelines, give way to competition players on other layout and take care of your course fee (pay the daily fee to Proshop or buy week/season pass). Thank you.**

COURSE FEES

- Based on the feedback from season-pass and weekly-pass holders, event entry fees **DO NOT INCLUDE** any course fees (that's why the entry fee is cheaper as in previous years)
- DiscGolfPark Mijas is a pay-to-play course, and course fee must be paid always when you are playing (casual round, practice round, competition round)
- Buy your course fee at the Mijas Pro shop
- Course fees:
 - 10 € / day
 - 50 € / week
 - 75 € / 2 weeks
 - 100 € / month



FUENGIROLA OPEN CHECK-IN

All Fuengirola Open players must check-in for the event and pick their player pack before the first round. Event check-in is possible:

- Tuesday, Nov 4 | 11:00 - 17:00
- Wednesday, Nov 5 | 11:00 - 17:00
- Thursday, Nov 6 | 9:00 - 14:00
At the latest 30 minutes before your tee time



PLAYER MEETINGS

All rounds

Player meeting for each group is held **always 10 minutes before your tee time** at tournament office.

Valid for all events, all rounds - Fuengirola Open, Fuengirola Masters, both NBDG Flex events and NBDG Doubles.



RULE NOTES

PDGA C-tier

Fuengirola Open, Fuengirola Masters and NBDG Flex events are sanctioned as PDGA C-tier events. [PDGA rules](#) and [PDGA competition manual](#) are valid through the event.

Unclear situations

In case of any unclear situation, follow these instructions:

- 1) Check the caddie book for hole specific rules
- 2) Check PDGA rules
- 3) Play with two (or more) different ways. Tournament official will make the ruling after the round is finished

Smoking & alcohol

Smoking and vaping is prohibited during competition rounds from 2 minutes signal to verifying of the scorecards.

Use of alcohol is prohibited during competition round.

Play-off (Open & Masters events)

In case of tied first place, sudden death play is played until the winner is clear. Sudden death holes are **BLUE #1** - **BLUE #2** - **RED #18** until we have a winner.

SCORING

Platform

Scoring platform is [PDGA Digital Scorecard*](#), which can be used through browser or app. Tournament access code will be shared in the group meeting before the round.

Everybody keeps scores

Each player in the playing group must keep scores for all players in the group.

Each player is responsible for their own scores in their own scorecard.

Check, verify and visit

After the round players must CHECK all the scores are correct and matches with other players' scores. If everything is correct, VERIFY the scores in the scoring platform. VISIT tournament office as a group.

NBDG Flex & Doubles events

Disc Golf Metrix scoring. Flex: all players take scores. Doubles: One player takes scores.

* Paper scorecards are available at tournament office if needed.

GENERAL NOTES

Casual relief from torn/spike bushes

If disc ends to a torn/spike bush or dangerously near those, player is allowed to take a casual relief. Player may mark the lie (*marking with mini is required*) just behind the bush, to first possible spot in the line of play towards the basket. Playing from the bush is allowed (*but who would want to do that...*)

[PDGA rule 803.02 A](#)

Dangerous cliffs and gorges

There are some dangerous spots at the course due the rocky hills and gorges. The playing group can decide a spot being **undoubtedly dangerous** and then player may take a relief without penalty. Lie must be marked to first possible safe spot, further from basket in the line of play.

Note: Difficult spot (hills, bushes etc.) is not the same as **dangerous spot**. If you throw a bad shot and the group agrees it is not a dangerous spot, you need to play from there. Or take the optional relief with one penalty.

Teeing areas

DiscGolfPark Mijas tees has a concrete part in front of the turf. Teeing area is limited to the turf, concrete **IS NOT** part of the tee.

Course markings

OB areas, hazards, mandatories and reliefs are marked with stakes and/or painted lines. If there are both markings in one spot, the painted line is the deciding.

Wet conditions

In case of rain and wet conditions, tournament director might announce some extra reliefs for safety, for example expanding the teeing area. Possible extra reliefs will be announced in the group meetings **BEFORE** the round starts. If nothing is announced, no extra reliefs are in use.

Use spotters

There are numerous spots at the course requiring the use of a spotter. Don't be lazy, use the spotter. It will help to find the discs, keep up the pace of play and help being aware of other people in the area.

HOLE NOTES - RED COURSE

Hole 1

OB on the left side, fenced area. Road is not OB.

Hole 2

MUST use spotter in the corner

Hole 4

Use spotter by the green

Hole 5

Watch out for traffic on the road. Road is not OB.

Hole 6

Watch out for players on tee #7.

Hole 8

Use spotter in the corner

Hole 9 - SPECIAL RULE

If your disc ends to the gorge, continue from crossing point or drop zone without penalty. Going to the gorge is dangerous and prohibited.

Hole 10

Use spotter in the corner

Hole 12

Mandatory - Restricted area on left, right and above the gate. If mandatory is missed, continue from DZ with +1

Hole 14

MUST use spotter in the corner

Hole 15

Watch out for players on hole #16

Hole 16

Watch out for players on hole #15

Hole 17

No OB. The white stakes at the green and on right side are marking OB for Blue #3

Hole 18

Road is not OB

MIJAS DISC GOLF COURSE

BY PRODIGY DISC



DISC GOLF IN A NUTSHELL

Disc golf is played much like traditional golf. Instead of a ball and clubs, however, players use a flying disc or frisbee. Disc golf shares with "ball golf" the object of completing each hole in the fewest strokes (or, in the case of disc golf, fewest throws).

1. The target is to throw a golf disc from a tee area to a target which is the "hole".
2. After each throw, the person furthest away from the target throws first.
3. Each throw is to be taken from the spot where the previous throw has landed.
4. The hole is complete when the disc lands in the hole (disc golf target).
5. The winner is the player with least amount of throws used to complete the whole course.
6. Disc golf is designed to be enjoyed by people of all ages.

DISC GOLFER'S CODE

1. PLAY SMART

Never throw into a blind area or when players or other facility users are within range.

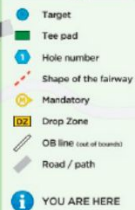
2. RESPECT THE COURSE

Observe all posted rules. No littering, no abuse of equipment or flora.

3. RESPECT THE SPORT

Be positive and responsible. Teach others.

There are a lot of other facility users on the premise. Please make sure you take them into consideration when throwing!

HOLE NOTES - BLUE COURSE

Hole 1

OB island before the basket

Hole 2

OB behind the basket, stake line by the road and beyond

Hole 3

OB on left and on right. **MUST** use spotter in the corner.

Hole 4

OB on left

Hole 5

OB on left

Hole 7 - SPECIAL RULES

Check next page for hole #7 ruling

Hole 8

Mandatory - Restricted area on right. If mando is missed, use tee as drop zone, +1. OB on left. Use spotter in the corner.

Hole 14

Island green. Everything around the island is **HAZARD** (**not OB like the teesign says**). If your any throw ends to hazard, play from there with one penalty. Drop zone is not in use.

Hole 16

OB around the fairway.

Hole 18

OB on right, left and behind the basket. OB island before the green. Drop zone IS NOT in use after OB, only after mando miss.

Mandatory - Restricted area on right. If mando is missed, continue from drop zone, +1.



HOLE 7 - BLUE COURSE

Yes, hole 7 is a weird one and we know it. **These are the hole rules in these events**, no matter what the tee sign at the course says.

RED LINE

Mandatory #1 - Restricted area line for the first mando gate. If this line is crossed, use the first drop zone with one penalty. On the left side of the gate, line goes behind the fence (hitting fence is not mando miss unless the line going towards tee is crossed)

BLUE LINE

Mandatory #2 - Restricted area line for the second mando gate. If this line is crossed, use the second drop zone with one penalty.

YELLOW LINE

Relief area. If your disc ends here WITHOUT crossing any mando line, play from crossing point without penalty.

WHITE LINE

OB line. Normal OB rules if discs ends OB.
