- We are not looking for any ratings series exceptions, so anyone who rates out will have to play their new division without points transferred. This encourages players to seek higher goals and gives players well within the division a chance to compete for the series trophies.

#### Jeff's Thoughts - an Editorial

DG Course review does NOT tell the whole story of the Sasquatch Layout. It has been several years since this layout has been available to the public, but they brought it back with EVEN MORE distance and difficulty, and BOY is it a doozy! At the time of writing, I have only played it in 35+mph winds, but even when those winds are at their usual it IS a factor with so much space in this lake-centered open bowl. The first two holes are your standard Hidden throws, but once you climb the rest of the sled hill and look at that 925 foot BEAST of a hole...you know you're in for a day to remember. Hidden always had that simple way of pulling your disc into that water, that tree bunch, or that ballpark. Now it's just multiplied and the stakes are literally higher!

#### **LUNCH SUGGESTIONS!**


PJ's grill just north on Broadway is a great choice. You also have the chains on US30 and 61st Ave. Pro tip - If you have never had the chicken bake at Costco it is phenomenal (5 BOOM rating!) but like a Mexican joint it will set heavy on such a long course. Tread with caution! Also if you're planning on bringing food, with the length of the course I would recommend at least 2 boxes of Uncrustables or 3 hot dogs to fuel up for the rest of your day.


HOLE 1 - 300 Ft - Par 3

HOLE 6 - 360 Ft - Par 3 OB: On/over road, in the lake




HOLE 7 - 703 Ft - Par 4 Mando: Play left of Squatch-marked tree




HOLE 8 - 460 Ft - Par 3 OB: In ball field (if missed on drive optional drop zone), last inbounds if OB from DZ

HOLE 13 - 180 Ft - Par 3 OB: In water




HOLE 14 - 160 ft - par 3 OB: in water




# HOLE 15 - 352 Ft - Par 3 OB: In baseball field




HOLE 16 - 214 Ft - Par 3 OB: On/over road, on Sully Property



HOLE 17 - 411 Ft - Par 3 OB: In river/pond, On/over road




# HOLE 18 - 205 Ft - Par 3 OB: In water, on/over main road - proceed to last inbounds

#### **OUT OF BOUNDS MASTER SHEET**

This is a PDGA Sanctioned event and players are required to follow all guidelines as described in 806.02. This is fully accessible via the PDGA app. Reminder that any disc IN QUESTION of being in bounds (might be a millimeter on the in-bounds, one blade of grass) - the call should go in the thrower's favor.

Hole 1: On/over parking lot, in pavilion, over fence

Hole 2: Over fence

Hole 3: Over fence, on/over road, in creek

Hole 4: On/over road, in creek

Hole 5: On/over road, in lake/creek

Hole 6: Over fence, on/over road, in the lake

Hole 7: Mando left of tree

Hole 8: In the ball field, optional drop zone, last on

after DZ

Hole 9: none

Hole 10: On/over road, in lake or creek

Hole 11: Over fence line

Hole 12: In ball field

Hole 13: In water

Hole 14: In water

Hole 15: in baseball field

Hole 16: On/over road, on Sully Property

Hole 17: In water, on/over road

Hole 18: In water, go to last inbounds

Hole 17: In water, on/over road - bridge and bridge

path is NOT OB

Hole 18: On/over road, in lake
