General Information

- Tournament will play rain or shine. If dangerous weather occurs, players will be notified to suspend play via the PDGA live app and 3 horn blasts. The event will follow PDGA rule 1.07 to suspending and resuming of play.
- Casual relief will be allowed, with no penalty stroke, should a disc come to rest near dangerous animals, such as venomous snakes or stinging insects, or dangerous plants, such as poison ivy in accordance with Rule 803.02(A).



Tournament Format

- All divisions will play three (3) rounds of 18 holes with tee times beginning on Friday, June 6th.
 - Round 1 - Friday, June 6th - Knob Hill Park
 - Round 2 - Saturday, June 7th - Deer Lakes Park
 - Round 3 - Sunday, June 8th - Lakeview DGC at Moraine State Park
- Tee times for round 1 have been posted to the [PDGA page](#) for the event and will be posted for rounds 2 and 3 immediately after the conclusion of play on Friday and Saturday.
- All competitors must be at the tee pad of the starting hole at least 2 minutes before their tee time.

Amateur Player's Packs and Payouts

- Amateur player's packs will consist of a Big Accessories Crusher Bucket Hat with a PFD logo valued at \$25.
- Player packs can be picked up upon check-in at Knob Hill Park on Friday before your first round.
- Amateur payouts will be completed from the PFD stock on Sunday at Moraine State Park following the conclusion of play for each division.
- At a minimum, \$25 from each entrant will go to the prize pool with each division paying 45% of the entrants.
- Projected payouts have been posted to the [PDGA page](#) for the event. Final payouts will be posted Saturday evening after the conclusion of play.

Scorekeeping

- We will be using PDGA Live Scoring for this tournament at pdga.com/score.
 - Access Code: PFDO2025
 - Access code is not case sensitive
- All players are required to maintain a scorecard independently for their group. (Rule 808A)
- Acceptable scoring methods:
 - Live scoring (preferred)
 - UDisc scoring which must be shown to the TD in person then screenshotted and sent to the TD within 30 minutes of your round finishing.
 - Paper score which must be handed in within 30 minutes of when your round finishes or that player will receive a penalty. (Rule 808F)
- Paper score cards will be available at Tournament Central upon request.

Ace Pot

- The total ace pot for this event is \$395! The pot will be combined across all divisions will be split by all aces.
- A CTP will be placed on the designated holes at each course. In the event an ace is not hit during play, the ace pot will be split across the three CTP winners. The CTP will not be in play if an ace is hit. The CTP holes for the ace pot are as follows:
 - Knob Hill - Hole 17
 - Deer Lakes - Hole 11
 - Moraine - Hole 3



50/50 CTP

- The total 50/50 CTP pot for this event is \$93. The pot will be combined across all divisions and will be split across the three days with each CTP winner taking home \$31.
- The 50/50 CTP will be located on the designated holes at each course shown below with the prize split across the three CTP winners. The proceeds of this CTP will go to the tournament directors to cover incidental costs.
 - Knob Hill - Hole 15
 - Deer Lakes - Hole 2
 - Moraine - Hole 1



Tie Breakers

- In the event of a tie for first place after each division's final round, all tied competitors will compete in a playoff immediately after the conclusion of their round. If you are not on the final card, and have a chance to finish in the tie, you must remain near Tournament HQ until all cards in your division are complete.
- Playoffs will play the sudden death format on Holes 1, 2, 13, and 18 at Moraine State Park on a loop until a winner is decided.
- Sudden death - Each competitor plays the hole as normal. Any competitor who shoots a higher score than the other competitors will be eliminated. The last competitor remaining will be declared the winner.
- Individuals who lose the playoff will take solo or a split second place.
- Example: Players A, B, and C all finish at -10 tied for first after the final round. Each player plays Hole 1. Player's A and C score par while Player B cards a bogey. Player B is eliminated and Players A and C proceed to Hole 2.

Knob Hill Park DGC

- The course is located at 415 Knob Rd, Wexford, PA 15090.
- Tournament check-in and player pack pickup will be located at the Jim Eckert Pavilion near Hole 17's basket.
- All players will begin their round on Hole 18 and will then proceed to Hole 1, finishing on Hole 17.
- The park has running water and permanent bathrooms located between the tee of Hole 18 and the playground, between Hole 18 and Hole 1, and to the west of Overlook Pavilion adjacent to Hole 17's tee. Unfortunately there are no other restrooms set on the course. An additional water and snack station will be set up adjacent to Hole 8's white tee.

Knob Hill Park DGC

- This is a municipal park, and while the disc golf course is separate from the main areas, other park goers occasionally walk the course and trail. Therefore all players are urged to remember to be considerate of non-disc golf park users during the tournament.
- Practice baskets will be set up between Jim Eckert Pavilion and the playground for warm up prior to the round.

Deer Lakes Park DGC

- The course is located at 105 Cattail Dr, Tarentum, PA 15084.
- Tournament check-in will be at Hole 1 at the end of the Blue Gill parking lot. A pop up tent will be set up for players to check in at.
- The park has water spigots at three locations; near the green of Hole 7, between Hole 11's tee and Anglers Shelter before you walk down to the red tee area, and in Hole 18's fairway.
- A Porta Potty is located between the walk from Hole 10 to Hole 11 and permanent pit toilets are located near the tees of Hole 17.

- This is a municipal park, and while the disc golf course is separate from the main areas, other park goers occasionally walk the course. Therefore all players are urged to remember to be considerate of non-disc golf park users during the tournament.
- Practice baskets will be set up around Blue Gill parking lot for warm up prior to the round.

Deer Lakes Park DGC

- On Hole 6, the out-of-bounds area is defined by rocks. The OB line is considered the far inside of the rocks; therefore, any shot that is touching or overhanging a rock is considered in-bounds.
- On Hole 15 across the pond, the OB line is defined by the cable strung between the rocks.
- Differing from previous events, out-of-bounds tee shots on Hole 15 are **NOT** required to go to the drop zone. Players may either throw their next shot after a penalty from the drop zone or from where the disc went OB.
- For holes in which the road comes into play, the asphalt is out-of-bounds while the concrete curb is in-bounds; therefore, any shot which is touching or overhanging the concrete curb is considered in-bounds.

- Permanent restrooms are located near the parking lot and bike path in addition to a Porta Potty at the crossing between Holes 4, 10, and 11.
