 - **Check in:** Check in with the TD begins at HQ at 8:00am. The player meeting will begin at 8:30am and the TD will go over course rules and answer questions.
 - **Lunch Break:** Players will have a lunch break that is at least 1 hour and 15 minutes long after the last card has submitted their scores. Round 2 starting holes will be posted during the lunch break. You must arrive at your starting hole at least 10 minutes before Round 2 begins. Round 2 will include some CTP prizes.
 - **Post Event:** Stick around after the event for pictures and prizes! Payout and invitations will be distributed within 48 hours of the end of the event.
- **General Information:**
 - **Coal Creek is a pack it in, pack it out course** - Please respect the courses and property. Restroom facilities are near hole 1 tee / hole 18 basket
 - **PDGA Live Scoring** - We will use PDGA live scoring and either a UDisc or paper backup. The PDGA live password is: **powererie**
 - **Water** - We will have water bottles set up on the course and at check in. Bring more water than you think you need!
 - **Parking** – The course provides limited parking near hole 1, car-pooling is highly recommended. There is also parking at Coal Creek Park and the course can be reached via the Coal Creek trail.
- **Courses:**
 - **LAYOUT 1- Par 3 layout** - All divisions
- **General Course Rules and OB - Applies to all holes.**
 - The Cottonwood Extension Ditch is a large ditch that winds throughout the course. Discs that come to rest in or beyond the ditch are out of bounds. In all cases, the flat top surface of the ditch bank nearest the fairway currently being played is in-bounds. OB markers will be used behind baskets and other areas that are more prone to a disc entering the ditch.
 - If you are unsure of any rules or a lie, **play a provisional** and talk to the TD after the round.

- Removal of wildlife. Coal Creek Open Space is home to a number of animals.
- Discs must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Don't damage or remove trees or branches.
- Return lost discs. Found discs are collected at the Fire Community Center located at 10000 1st Avenue.
