Western Pennsylvania Series

The Western PA Series (WPAS) will consist of a dozen events over the course of 2025. Placement in each event will be worth points with your best 5 events counting towards your point total.

For 2025, PDGA divisions have been consolidated into 4 pools for points.

- All Pro Players
- ♦ Advanced (FA1/MA1) and Intermediate (FA2/MA2) amateurs
- Recreational (FA3/MA3) and Novice (FA4/MA4) amateurs
- Age Protected Amateurs (Junior and 40+ Amateur divisions)

A per player fee is collected from all WPAS events to build the Series Champions purses. The top placers in each of the pools at the end of the season will be paid out in cash and awarded series trophies.

New to this year is the introduction of "Majors." Majors will consist of the 4 founding series events and will be worth 1.5x points.

We are a group of volunteers in the community who have come together to spread the joy of disc golf to others in the greater Pittsburgh Area.

General Information

- Tournament will play rain or shine. If dangerous weather occurs, players will be notified to suspend play via the PDGA live app and 3 horn blasts. The event will follow PDGA rule 1.07 about suspending and resuming of play.
- Casual relief will be allowed, with no penalty stroke, should a disc come to rest near dangerous animals, such as venomous snakes or stinging insects, or dangerous plants, such as poison ivy in accordance with Rule 803.02(A). You may also take relief from running water or standing water unless marked as OB or Relief.
- ❖ We hope to have spotters available for a few holes. In the event we do not, PLEASE have the back of the box spot the first 2 shots, then swap with one of the individuals who threw first. In particular, please take this action on holes 8, 11, 12, 15, and 18 as needed.

Tournament Format

- Competitors will play one (1) round per day in a tee time format starting on hole 1.
- All competitors will tee from Hole 1's white tee, then will follow their assigned layout with the following exceptions: All competitors will play Hole 18 from the red tee as par 3's.
- Official Divisional tee order: FPO, Masters Pros, MPO, FA1, Juniors, Masters Ams, MA4, MA3, MA2, MA1
- Tee times will begin by 9:00AM and the last group will tee off no later than 3:00PM to ensure all competitors will be able to complete the round with plenty of daylight to spare.
- Competitors must check-in and be near hole 1 at least 5 minutes before your assigned tee time begins. Anyone arriving after this time will incur a 2 stroke penalty.

Scorekeeping

- We will be using PDGA Live Scoring for this tournament.
 - Access Code: Slap
 - Access code is NOT case sensitive
- All players are required to maintain a scorecard independently for their group. (Rule 808A)
- Acceptable scoring methods:
 - Live scoring (preferred)
 - Paper score which must be handed in within 30 minutes of when your round finishes or that player will receive a penalty. (Rule 808F)
- Paper score cards will be available at Tournament Central upon request.

Player's Packs, Ace Pot, and

- Amateur player's packs will consist of a PREM Disc and a custom stamped Zing Snipe.
- Pro's do not receive a player's pack, but must check-in and will receive their CTP entry tickets.
- There is a \$5 ace pot available during registration. Day of signups for the ace pot will not be allowed. If there are no aces hit during the event by ace pot registrants, the pot will be split between the Big Beaver course improvement fund and the WPAS Champion's purses.
- Each participant will receive two (2) tickets for the all day long CTP challenge. The top 3 closest shots will receive prizes when they check in on day 2. Additional attempt tickets may be purchased on the day of, in cash for \$1 each.

- The course is located across the street from 204 Park Lane, Darlington PA, 16115. Search "Big Beaver Disc Golf Course" on Google maps or follow the link below. https://maps.app.goo.gl/egetHzQLd4xnKoGM8
- The park has running water, vault toilets in the main lot, and WiFi at the pavilions.
- The parking lot and the extension should be enough space for all competitors provided you park considerately. The gate may be open for additional parking in the coned and taped off area. There is a small overflow lot. See the pictures section on DGScene for where it is located. DO NOT PARK ON ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY OR THE SIDE OF THE ROAD.
- This is a municipal park, and therefore all players are urged to remember to be considerate of park goers during the tournament.
- There will be at least 1 practice basket and throwing net set up near hole 1. A warm up area is available in the grassy space between the pavilion and hole 18's basket. A water jug and snacks will be provided between holes 9 and 10 and at tournament central.

Layout Assignments


- MPO, MP40, and MA1 will play the Blue Tees Layout with the following exceptions.
 - ➤ Hole 1 White Tee
 - ➤ Hole 7 White Tee (Par 4)
 - Hole 18 Red Tee (Par 3)
- ❖ FPO, FA1, MP50, MA2, MA3, MA40, and MJ18 will play the White Tees Layout with the following exceptions.
 - ➤ Hole 18 Red Tee (Par 3)
- All other divisions will play the Red Tees Layout with the following exceptions.
 - Hole 1 White Tee
 - and Hole 18 will play as the normal par 4

Tie Breakers

- All competitors competing for the win must remain at the event until their entire division has completed their 2nd round. In the event of a tie for first place after round 2. All tied competitors will compete in a playoff.
- Playoffs will play the sudden death format on Holes 1, 2, 3, and 18 on a loop until a winner is decided.
 - Sudden death Each competitor plays the hole as normal. Any competitor who shoots a higher score than the other competitors will be eliminated. The last competitor remaining will be declared the winner.
 - Individuals who lose the playoff will take a solo or split second place.
 - Example: Players A, B, and C all finish at -10 tied for first after day 2. Each player plays Hole 1. Player's A and C score par while Player B cards a bogey. Player B is eliminated and Players A and C proceed to Hole 2.
- If there is a playoff, the next tee time will be delayed 1 time gap to allow for the playoff to proceed.

Hole 1 - Par 3
Pin Position - C
Blue Tee & Red Tee Not In Use
White Tee - 327' (100 m)


- ❖ All divisions to throw from White Tee
- Out of bounds right and long of basket marked by white flags.
- Rocky trench on left side of fairway plays as casual relief

Hole 2 - Par 4
Pin Position - C
Blue Tee - 423' (129 m)
White Tee - 386' (118 m)
Red Tee - 307' (94 m)

- Out of bounds in creek between Blue and White Tees marked by white flags and paint.
- Out of bounds lines extend indefinitely for this hole marked by white painted arrows. These lines are ONLY in play for hole 2.



Red Tee - 338' (103 m)

No out of bounds

Red Tee - 331' (101 m)

- No out of bounds.
- Mandatory Casual Relief area marked by red flags.











- Take caution if groups are teeing from hole 9's Blue or White tees





Blue Tee - 339' (103 m)
White Tee - 280' (85.344 m)
Red Tee - 219' (67 m)

- No out of bounds.
- If playing the Blue or White Tee, please use a spotter.
- Creek is optional casual relief

Hole 12 - Par 4
Pin Position - A
Blue Tee - 477' (145 m)
White Tee - 371' (113 m)
Red Tee - 319' (100 m)

- Mandatory marked by sign and tape. The line marking the mandatory plane is marked by flags and paint.
- Red tee is drop zone for missed mandatory
- Please use a spotter for tee shots.

Hole 16 - Par 5
Pin Position - A
Blue Tee - 790' (241 m)
White Tee - 707' (215 m)
Red Tee - 603' (184 m)

- Out of bounds in or over marked creek on left side of the fairway that continues around the back of the green towards Hole 17. Out of bounds is marked by white flags. Out of bounds continues indefinitely along the line marked by white spray painted arrows at start of creek. This out of bounds line is ONLY in play for hole 16 & 17.
- You ARE teeing from OB if playing the Blues red tee drop zone if you do not cross

Hole 17 - Par 4
Pin Position - A
Blue Tee - 464' (141 m)
White Tee - 407' (124 m)
Red Tee - 374' (114 m)

- Out of bounds creek on left side of fairway marked by white flags. Out of bounds continues indefinitely along the line marked by white spray painted arrows
- You ARE teeing from OB red tee drop zone if you do not cross.
- Unmarked creek past the white flags plays as a optional casual relief area

Hole 18 - Par ³/₄ Pin Position - A

Blue Tee & White Tee Not In use

Red Tee - 373' (114 m)

- ❖ All divisions to throw from Red Tee
- No out of bounds.
- Casual relief may be taken from any standing water or creeks.
- All divisions playing the Blue or White layout will play this hole as a par 3.
- All divisions playing the Red layout play this hole as a par 4.
