Valley Park Disc Golf Course - Valley Front 9 Long, Back 9 Short

Layout Details

Hole Tee Par Feet Notes

1	Long	4	506	OB on or across road or in pavilion. OB over fence. Pond is OB. If Disc comes to rest in Pond from the Long Tee, the player may choose last in bounds or use the short tee with penalty. From Shorts, if shot lands in Pond, proceed to marked drop zone or play from last in bounds. (Paths are in bounds)
2	Long	5	720	OB in or over any fence. OB over road on Right. OB on or across Path left (painted). OB Staked along creek line and around basket up to the fence line. Double Mando - If missed proceed to drop zone. Up to 2 Meters relief on any barbed wire fence.
3	Long	3	325	OB staked left in rough. OB over fence. Up to 2 Meters relief on any barbed wire fence.
4	Long	3	223	OB over fence. OB long Staked.
5	Long	3	273	OB left of stakes and beyond Path long.
6	Long	3	384	OB right of Hole 5 and fence long.
7	Long	4	432	Over fence right OB. Mando Right, if missed proceed to drop zone. (Path is not OB)
8	Long	3	206	OB on or across path right.
9	Long	3	219	OB stakes across creek on Hole 5 long of basket.
10	Short	3	220	OB stakes across the creek on Hole 11.
11	Short	3	216	From the Tee, if disc does not at any point cross creek in bounds, proceed to the marked drop zone. OB is staked and on or across Path. (If disc crosses in bounds and then lands OB, you may take penalty shot last in bounds or use the drop zone)
12	Short	3	290	There is a Mando Left if missed, proceed to the DZ. OB is defined by Stakes (There is an area in the middle late in the fairway that is OB for safety reasons. The peninsula on the right across the bridge is OB as well). On or across path long of basket OB.
13	Short	3	175	From the Tee, if disc does not at any point cross creek in bounds, proceed to the marked drop zone. OB is staked and on or across Path. (If disc crosses in bounds and then lands OB, you may take penalty shot last in bounds or use the drop zone)
14	Short	4	475	Mando left, if missed proceed to the drop zone. Over or

				inside any fence is OB. Pond is OB (if disc is touch any part of land, then it is safe).
15	Short	3	171	Mando Right, if missed you must retee. This hole is an Island. Any disc that is outside of the island, plays as a Hazard. Play the shot where it lies with Penalty. If any part of the disc is touching the wood outline, you are safe. If disc goes in Soccer field, play the disc where it crossed the fence with penalty. (Do not play lie from Soccer field. Also, you may NOT get 1 meter relief on island border)
16	Short	3	229	Triple Mando, must go through the wood structure. Proceed to drop zone if missed. OB is on or across Left Walking path, long of basket, and gravel road right. (OB on right side of Wood or across, if you are touching grass left of the wood, you are safe)
17	Short	3	258	On or across parking lot is OB. (If you are touching grass left of wood, you are safe.). Walking paths and beyond are OB.
18	Short	4	479	Mandatory Left, if missed proceed to the Drop Zone. Walking Paths are NOT OB.

Bridge Park - Long Tee (White) to Red Basket

Hole Tee Target Par Feet Notes

1	Long	Red	3	220	Mando Right: if missed, proceed to Short Tee. All areas except for the green(WV silhouette, area defined by string) are considered hazard. Add one stroke and play from where it lies. Creek is OB. On or across road is OB.
2	Long	Red	3	258	Left and beyond Stakes is OB.
3	Long	Red	3	248	Left and beyond Stakes is OB.
4	Long	Red	3	408	Left and beyond Stakes is OB.
5	Long	Red	3	328	Left, Long and beyond Stakes is OB.
6	Long	Red	3	428	Left and beyond Stakes is OB.
7	Long	Red	3	308	*Do not play to 14s basket* Basket for 7 is a blind shot from the Tee. OB staked way right.
8	Long	Red	4	368	Left and beyond Stakes is OB. Small Creek (with no Stakes) is NOT OB and plays casual. You may have casual relief behind lie in direct line to basket if surrounded by water in bounds.
9	Long	Red	3	300	Small Creek (with no Stakes) is NOT OB and plays casual. You may have casual relief behind lie in direct line to basket if surrounded by water in bounds.
10	Long	Red	3	268	Small Creek (with no Stakes) is NOT OB and plays casual. You may have casual relief behind lie in direct line to basket if surrounded by water in bounds.
11	Long	Red	4	356	OB Staked on the right side of fairway separating hole 11 and 12. Left and beyond Stakes is OB. Small Creek (with no Stakes) is NOT OB and plays casual. You may have casual relief behind lie in direct line to basket if surrounded by water in bounds.
12	Long	Red	3	385	OB Staked on the right side of fairway separating hole 11 and 12 and OB painted left.
13	Long	Red	3	290	Mando Right: if missed, proceed to Short Tee. OB left in ball field.
14	Long	Red	3	388	OB left in ball field. (Red Clay defines OB line) Way Right and beyond Stakes is OB.
15	Long	Red	3	380	Mando Right: if missed, proceed to Short Tee. OB staked left and short of White Basket. Way Right and beyond Stakes is OB.

16	Long	Red	3	368	Parking lot/sidewalk is OB. Way right and beyond Stakes is OB.
17	Long	Red	3	305	Double Mando, (the tallest part of the big tree defines the mando on the left) If mando missed, proceed to the Drop Zone. OB Staked right BEFORE Mando (No OB right after mando) Parking lot/sidewalk is also OB.
18	Long	Red	3	268	Mando Left: if missed, proceed to Short Tee. Road/sidewalk left and beyond is OB. Long and beyond Stakes is OB.

1	Short		3	200	ALL POOLS SHORTS. On or Across road is OB. Stakes define OB.
2	Long		3	350	On or Across road is OB.
3	Long		3	325	On or Across road is OB. Creek is casual.
4	Long		3	330	OB disc fully surrounded by water in creek. OB on or across Road. OB defined by Stakes.
5	Long		4	470	From Long Tee, if disc never crosses in bounds, proceed to the Short Tee with penalty. From Short Tee, if disc never crosses in bounds proceed to the marked Drop Zone. If disc crosses in bounds and then lands OB the player has the option to take last in bounds or from the Drop Zone. There is a forced carry from both Tees. White Stakes left, long and right define OB line. On Road and right and on Bridge are OB.
6	Long		3	195	This hole plays as an Island. If missed from tee proceed to marked Drop Zone. Any subsequent OB shots plays last in bounds.
7	Long		3	313	On or across road is OB.
8	Long		3	275	On or Across road is OB
9	Long		3	230	Please be very cautious when climbing or putting on the rock. You may receive optional casual relief (with no penalty) on the rock if footing is not safe taken in a direct line away from the basket to the next playable lie. (Disregard sign on rock, you must complete the hole by making it in the basket).

11	Short		3	248	On or Across road is OB.

13	Short		3	185	This hole is an island. If Tee shot never crosses in bounds, advance to drop zone. If disc crosses in bounds and lands OB the player has the option to take last in bounds or proceed to Drop Zone.
14	Short	Long	4	585	PLAY TO LONG BASKET. Road left defined by painted line is OB. In Creek surrounded by water is OB. There is a temp Hole A after 14.
A	Temp		3	230	This hole is an island. Any shot outside of

string plays as a hazard. Painted line on 14 is OB.

15	Short	Long	5	760	PLAY TO LONG BASKET. On or across walking path left, long of basket, and right of Stakes is OB.
16	Short		4	434	Painted line left and beyond is OB. There is only 1 painted line for the road. Any lie right of painted line is in bounds. Surrounded by water in creek and beyond is also OB.
17	Short	Long	4	566	PLAY TO LONG BASKET. Painted line left and beyond is OB.
18	Short		4	525	Painted line left and beyond is OB. Baseball field is OB.
