

Chris Greene Lake Caddie Book

General Notes:

- Chris Greene Lake is a public park. While we have reserved (and been granted) exclusive use of the disc golf courses at both parks, there will be other members of the public enjoying the park amenities.
- You are representing our sport to these bystanders who may be unfamiliar with the course layout or how disc golf works, please be mindful of this when playing holes and remember the Disc Golfer's Code: "Never throw into a blind area or when players, spectators, pedestrians, or other facility users are within range."
- We will do our best to provide spotters on holes where spectators or other players could potentially be in the throwing lines, however that will be dependent on how many volunteers we have during the day. If necessary, you may send someone from your card to spot throws.
- Ticks, poison ivy, and thorns may be present throughout the courses. Please prepare appropriately, no relief is granted for plants. Barbed wire at Chris Greene Lake is the only hazard that allows for relief.
- Chris Greene Lake is a physically strenuous course with lots of walking and elevation change. Please ensure you bring enough water or snacks for the duration of play.
- **Tiebreakers for 1st place will be a sudden death playoff with holes 1, 2, and 10 on a loop.**

Lot 1- Holes 6,7,8

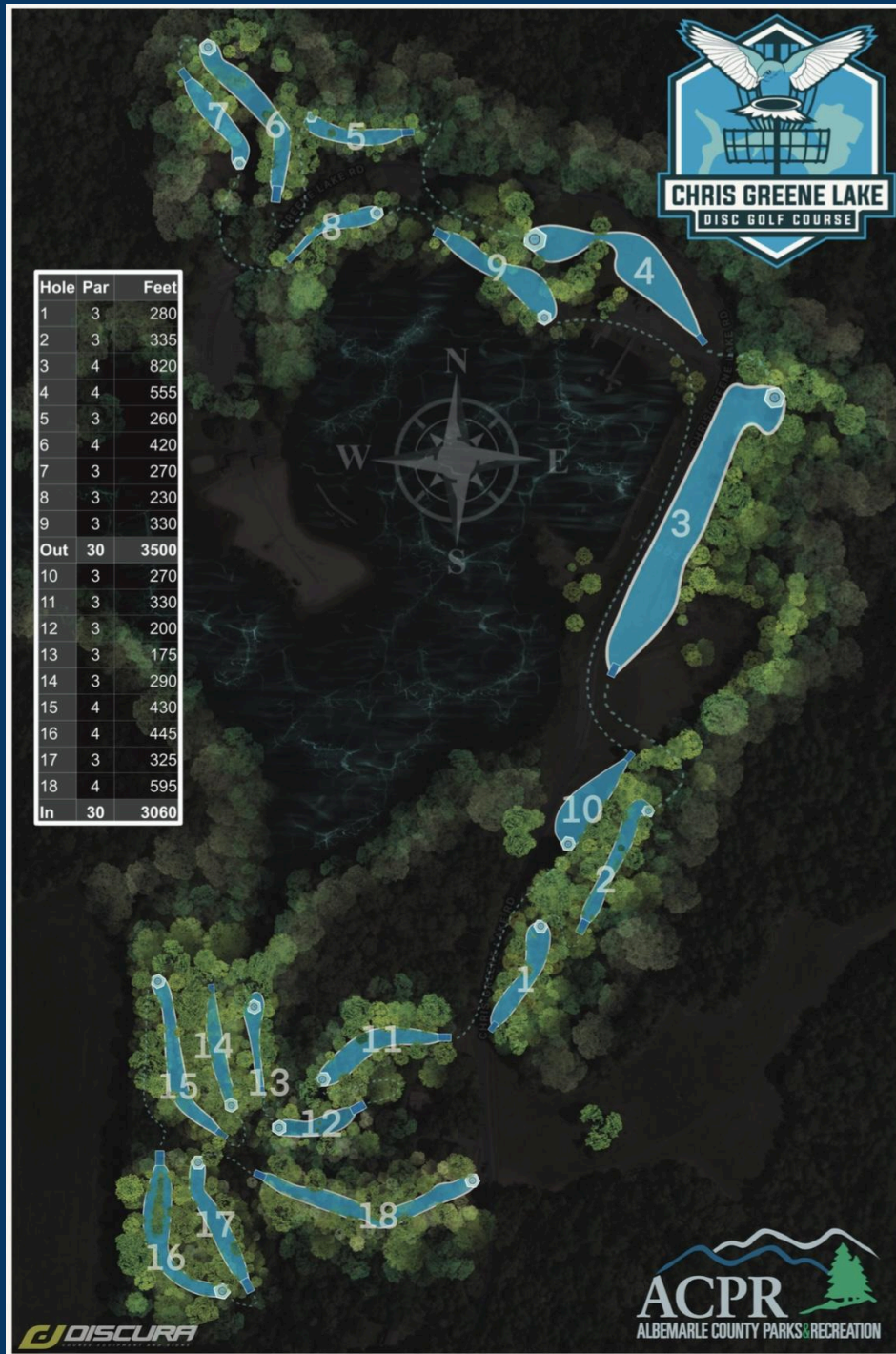
Lot 2- Holes 5, 6, 8, 9

Lot 3- Holes 4, 9

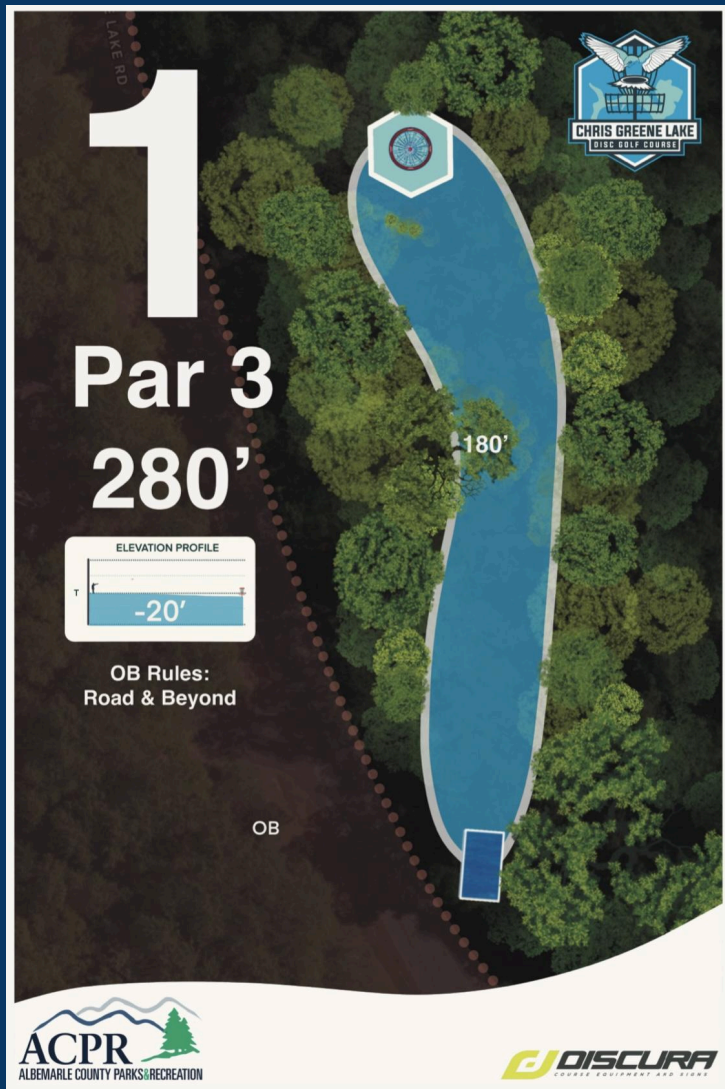

Par 3

Length: 280 Feet

Rules: Pavement and beyond on left side is OB.

Hole 2

Length: 335 Feet

Rules: Marked rope and beyond are OB

Note: There are several large piles of sticks, branches, and logs on the left side of the fairway. If a player's disc comes to rest in the middle of a pile of branches/logs and is deemed unplayable by the card collectively, for the safety of the player they may take casual relief behind their lie.

Hole 3

Par 4

Length: 820 Feet

Other Notes: Pavement to the left and beyond is OB. Discs landing in drainage Creek on the right side fully surrounded by water are OB. A mandatory lost disc/OB dropzone has been marked for tee shots on this hole approx 200 feet on the flat landing zone. On your initial drive only, if you go OB or cannot find your disc in the allotted time, proceed to the drop zone that is on the flat walkway on the dam about 220 feet in front of the tee pad with a 1 stroke penalty. DO NOT RE-TEE. All subsequent OB or lost discs play normal rules.

Hole 4

Hole Details

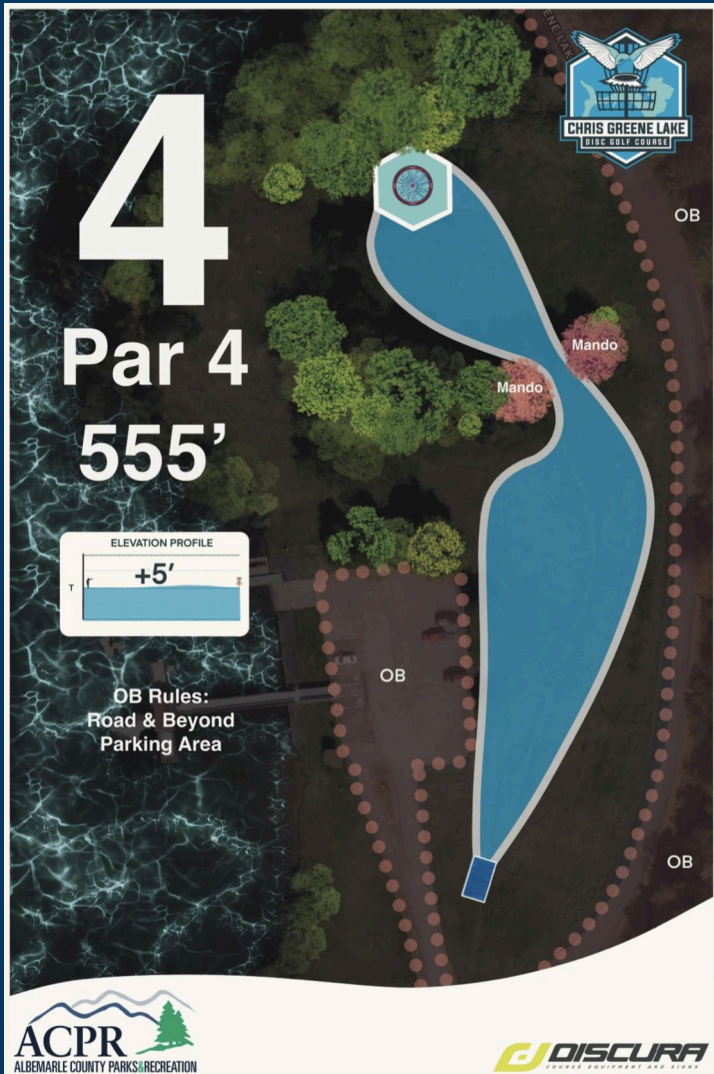
Par 4

Length: 555 Feet

Rules: Pavement and beyond on the right side is OB. Paved parking area and road on the left are OB.

Double Mando is in play. Mando extends vertically from the most outside portion of Mando signs (not the angle of the limb it is on). Please proceed to drop zone if Mando is missed. Drop zone will be marked approx 50 feet short of Mando gap.

Other Notes: Please be mindful of cars and people before throwing.



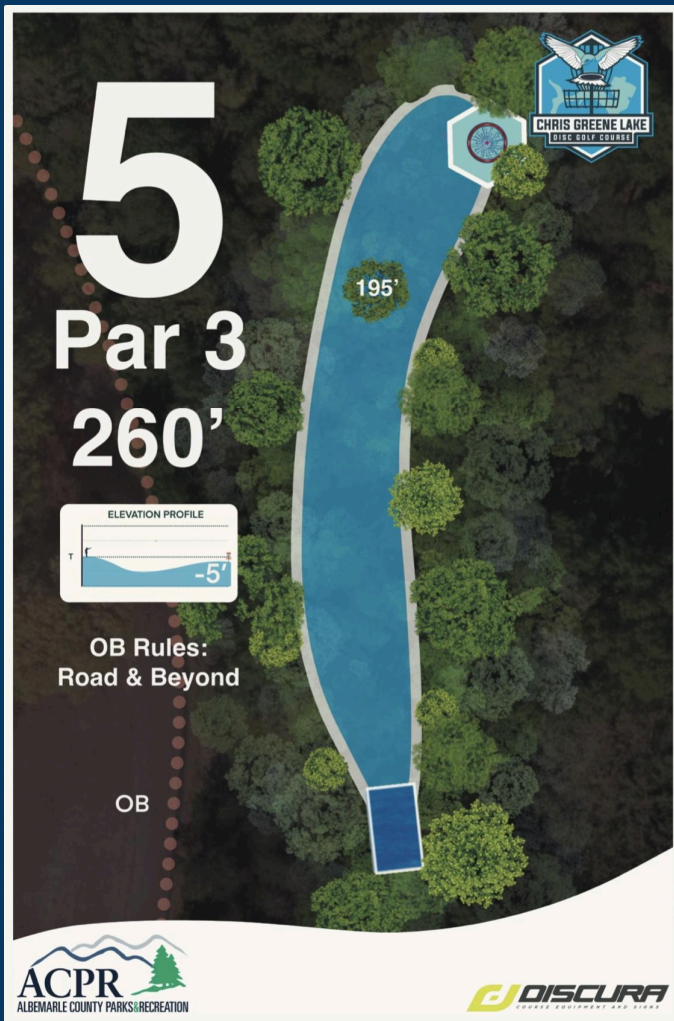
Hole 5

Length: 260 Feet

Other Notes: Pavement and beyond is OB.

Length: 420 Feet

Mando - If missed proceed to drop zone in fairway with a stroke penalty.

Other Notes: Previous tournaments OB have been removed

Length: 270 Feet

Other Notes: Previous tournaments OB have been removed



Hole 8

Hole Details

Par: 3

Length: 230 Feet

Other Notes: Discs completely surrounded by water are OB.
Pavement and beyond on left side is OB.



Hole 9

Hole Details

Par 3

Length: 330 Feet

Other Notes: Discs completely surrounded by water are OB. If OB off the tee, proceed to the marked drop zone past the water about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up the hill on the left. Any subsequent OB will be played normally (taken from where the disc last went OB).

If you do not feel comfortable throwing across water from the tee, you may elect to proceed to the drop zone, throwing for your 3rd shot.

Please ensure the green is clear before teeing off.



Hole 10

Length: 270 Feet

Other Notes: Pavement and beyond is OB.
Please be mindful of cars before throwing.



Hole 11

Par 3

Length: 330 Feet

Note: There is limited visibility from the tee. If no spotter is present, please ensure the fairway/green are clear before teeing off.

Length: 200 Feet



Hole 13

Length: 175 Feet

Other Notes: Marked rope/paint and beyond is OB. Throws off the tee landing OB, proceed to the marked drop zone (Short and left of basket up hill).

Normal OB rules apply on all subsequent shots (taken from where disc was last in bounds with penalty stroke).

NOTE: Large logs have been added to the green of hole 13. These are part of the course and cannot be moved or relocated to benefit your stance.



Hole 14

Hole Details

Par 3

Length: 290 Feet

Other Notes: Inside of marked ditch (designated by ropes) is OB. The bridge structure itself is also OB.



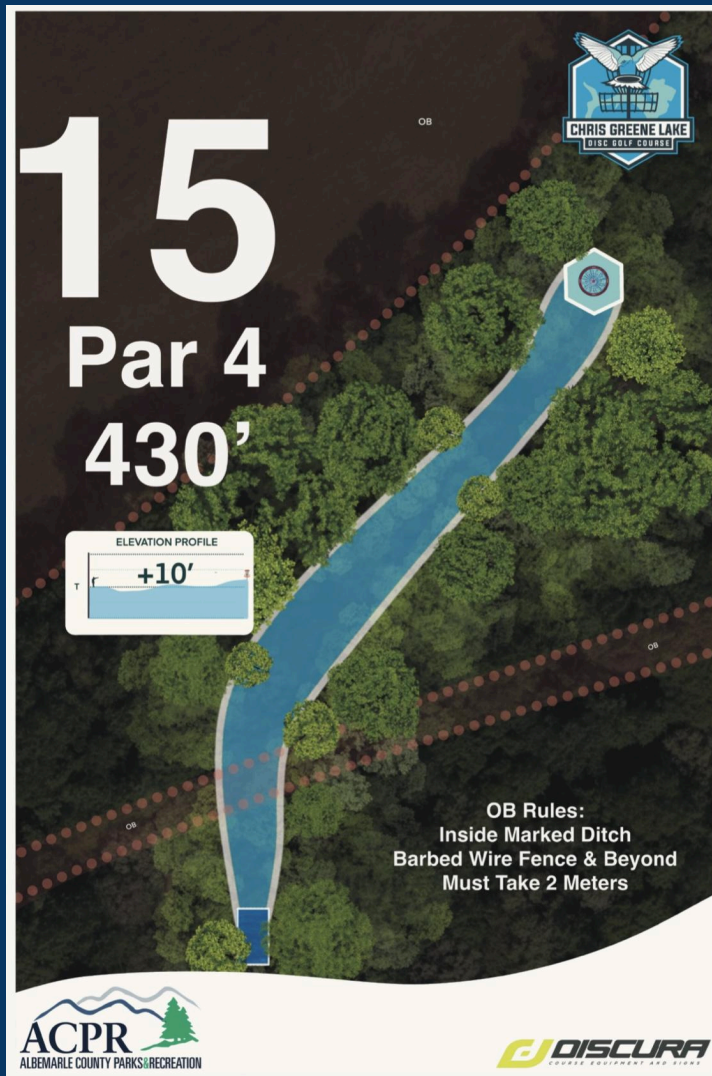
Hole 15

Par 4

Length: 430 Feet

Other Notes: The Inside of the marked ditch is OB. Any barbed wire fence and beyond is OB; must take 2 meters relief off of fence.



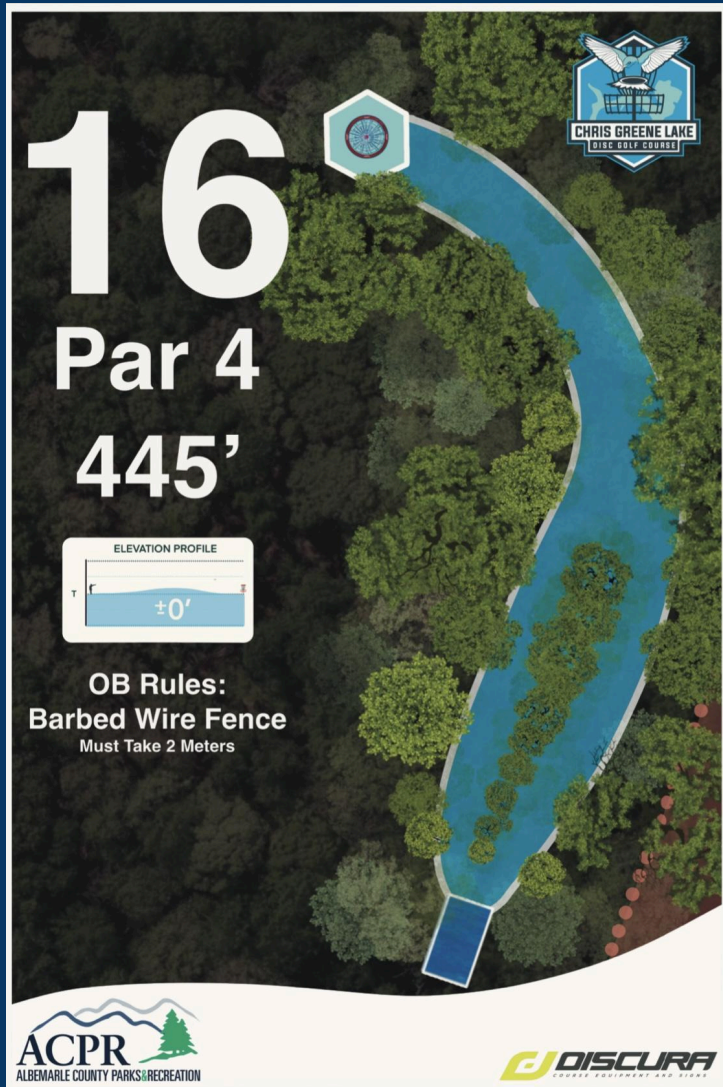
Hole 16

Length: 445 Feet

Other Notes: Any barbed wire fence and beyond is OB; must take 2 meters relief off of fence.

Length: 595 Feet

Other Notes: Discs surrounded by asphalt are considered OB (including the parking lot). Discs landing beyond the road are also OB.

Please be mindful of any cars before throwing.
