Tournament will play rain or shine. If dangerous weather occurs, players will be notified to suspend play via the PDGA live app and a 3 horn blasts. The event will follow PDGA rule 1.07 to suspending and resuming of play.

Casual relief will be allowed, with no penalty stroke, should a disc come to rest near dangerous animals, such as venomous snakes or stinging insects, or dangerous plants, such as poison ivy in accordance with Rule 803.02(A).

Western Pennsylvania Series

The Western PA Series (WPAS) will consist of a dozen events over the course of 2025. Placement in each event will be worth points with your best 5 events counting towards your point total.

For 2025, PDGA divisions have been consolidated into 4 pools for points.

- All Pro Players
- Advanced (FA1/MA1) and Intermediate (FA2/MA2) amateurs
- Recreational (FA3/MA3) and Novice (FA4/MA4) amateurs
- Age Protected Amateurs (Junior and 40+ Amateur divisions)

A per player fee is collected from all WPAS events to build the Series Champions purses. The top placers in each of the pools at the end of the season will be paid out in cash and awarded series trophies.

New to this year is the introduction of "Majors." Majors will consist of the 4 founding series events and will be worth 1.5x points. Autumn's End is the FINAL Major of the year for WPAS!

We are a group of volunteers in the community who have come together to spread the joy of disc golf to others in the greater Pittsburgh Area.

Tournament Format & Player's Packs

- Competitors will play two (2) rounds of 18 holes with a shotgun start.
- Saturday divisions will start at 8:30AM. I know its earlier than normal, but with a full course and low daylight, I want to make sure everyone gets a chance to finish the event.
- Sunday round 1 will start at the usual **9:00AM**.
- Lunch break after round 1 begins when the last card is submitted. Lunch break will last 1 hour. Tee time for round 2 will be announced on the Disc Golf Scene page, PDGA Live, and at tournament central.
- There will be CTP's available at no cost to players on holes 1 and 17. CTPs are in effect for both rounds.
- The Ace Pot will pay out 100% if an ace is hit by an individual who signed up. If no ace is hit, a throw-off will be conducted for 50% of the pot with the other 50% going to the event.
- Amateur player's packs will consist of a custom stamped Innova disc, a Star Fox, and GOAT towel supplied by Camber. See the about section on DGScene for available molds. Molds will be first come first serve though some will be held in reserve to ensure availability for both days.

Scorekeeping

- We will be using PDGA Live Scoring for this tournament.
 - Saturday Access Code: Autumn1
 - Sunday Access Code: Autumn2
- All players are required to maintain a scorecard independently for their group. (Rule 808A)
- Acceptable scoring methods:
 - Live scoring (preferred)
 - ➤ UDisc scoring which must be shown to the TD in person then screenshotted and sent to the TD within 30 minutes of your round finishing.
 - Paper score which must be handed in within 30 minutes of when your round finishes or that player will receive a penalty. (Rule 808F)
- Paper score cards will be available at Tournament Central upon request.

- The course is located at 124 Lakeview Beach Road, Portersville, PA 16051
 - https://maps.app.goo.gl/aeugQS6FnLBzSXE38
- There will be at least 1 porta-john at the hole 4/hole 11 crossing, and an additional one near Tournament HQ if the bathrooms are not available.
- This is a state park, and while the disc golf course is separate from the main areas, other park goers occasionally walk the course. Therefore all players are urged to remember to be considerate of non-disc golf park users during the tournament.
- The practice baskets and open space on the other side of the parking lot from the course will serve as the warm-up areas.

Series Awards

- Series winners and placers in each pool will be announced upon the completion of round 2 and the update of the series points. Winners of the event and CTP awards will be announced prior to the Series Winners.
- Series champion and placement ceremony will include cold beverages and snacks available to everyone competing. Please stick around to celebrate our series champions and everyone who comes out to compete this weekend!
- Series champions will be paid out in cash as part of the announcements.

 Runner-ups and placements for divisions which had enough competitors will be announced as well, but payouts for those places will be via paypal.

Tie Breakers


- In the event of a tie for first place after round 2. All tied competitors will compete in a playoff.
- Playoffs will play the sudden death format on Holes 1, 2, 13, and 18 on a loop until a winner is decided. Order of tee will rotate each hole. Initial tee order will be decided by round 2 hot round, or a disc or coin flip in the event of a tie for hot round.
 - Sudden Death Each competitor plays the hole as normal. Any competitor who shoots a higher score than the other competitors will be eliminated. The last competitor remaining will be declared the winner.
 - Individuals who lose the playoff will take solo or a split second place.
 - Example: Players A, B, and C all finish at -10 tied for first after day 2. Each player plays Hole 1. Player's A and C score par while Player B cards a bogey. Player B is eliminated and Players A and C proceed to Hole 2.

- **All Other Divisions: White-White**

Gold Tee - 373'
Blue Tee - 328'
White Tee - 272'

- Out of bounds on or over paved parking lot behind tees.
- Out of bounds in marked area of creek right of basket and fairway near hole 18's fairway.




Hole 2 - Par 4
Pin Position - C
Gold Tee - 504'
Blue Tee - 435'
White Tee - 389'

Out of bounds in creek crossing in front of pins and right of fairway marked by white rope line.



Hole 3 - Par 3
Pin Position - B
Gold Tee - 290'
Blue Tee - 254'
White Tee - 208'

- Out of bounds on or over paved road right of fairway and pin.
- Out of bounds in rock garden near pins marked by white rope line.

White Tee - 347'

Out of bounds on or over paved road behind tee positions.



Out of bounds on or over paved road right of fairway. Drainage trench crossing the fairway near tee pads plays as casual relief.



Hole 11 - Par 3
Pin Position - B
Gold Tee - 360'
Blue Tee - 300'
White Tee - 265'

- Out of bounds on or over paved roads behind tees and beyond pin positions.
- Drainage ditch crossing in front of tee pads plays as casual relief and IS NOT out of bounds. Ignore any signs or markings otherwise.

Out of bounds on or over paved road behind gold tee.





Out of bounds between white rope line marked creeks crossing fairway, long left of pin, and right of pin. Out of bounds tee shots MAY proceed to turf dropzone with a 1 stroke penalty. Otherwise, and all other out of bounds play normal out of bounds rules.
