Tee times will be posted on the PDGA event page this Wednesday night for all Pro Divisions and on Thursday night for all Amateur Divisions - <https://www.pdga.com/tour/event/93680>. Please double check tee times the morning of the event in case there are any last minute drops or changes.

The weather forecast is looking awesome with highs in the upper 70's! There is a slight chance of rain. Hope for the best, but be prepared for the worst.

*****All players must check in 5 minutes before their scheduled tee time at the Starter Tent by hole #1. Failure to do so will result in a 2 throw penalty.*****

This is a PDGA Sanctioned B-Tier event that is 3 rounds for all Pro Divisions and 2 rounds for all Amateur Divisions. All PDGA rules and guidelines must be followed. **NO SMOKING or VAPING** of any substance in any buildings or on the property will be permitted. There is a designated smoking area by the fire pit. Violations will result in dismissal from the property and the event.

There is \$1,500 added cash to the pro purse for this event. For Amateurs, this is a trophy only event and everyone will receive a great players pack that includes \$2,500+ in added merch thanks to our generous sponsors!

Scoring

The PDGA Digital Scorecard is the official scorecard for this event. The PDGA Digital Scorecard can be found at www.pdga.com/score or we highly recommend that you download the free PDGA app. The PDGA app not only allows you to keep score in the tournaments, but also allows you to follow live scores and search the PDGA rules. There is great cell coverage at the course, but T-Mobile and AT&T customers have experienced some signal issues. We will have a hotspot at the Starter Tent to allow players to start and finalize their Digital Scorecard if needed. The event passcode will be given out at the Starter Tent.

Layouts

MPO, MP40, MP50 and MA1 all play the Pro Layout.
FPO, FP50, MP60 and all other AM divisions (except MA1) play the Short Layout.

In the case of a tie for 1st place, there will be a Sudden Death Playoff on holes 1 -18 until resolved.

Vendor Village at the Pavilion

Several vendors will be set up at the Pavilion all weekend. All Out Disc Golf, JoJo's Tacos, Arizona Mountain Coffee and Just Bee Bodyworks will all be on-site. We will also have some fun side events going on throughout the event as well.

Camp and Misc Stuff

Stay hydrated! You are playing at 7,000 ft. elevation. There are several great-tasting-well-water spigots to fill up your bottle around the property. There will also be a few water coolers around the course as well. Be sure to bring a re-useable style water bottle like a Hydro-flask with you.

No illegal substances and **NO SMOKING** of any substance in any buildings or on the property will be permitted. There is a designated smoking area by the fire pit. Violations will result in dismissal from the property and from the event.

Campfire **ONLY** allowed at the main fire pit. (If forest restrictions permit). No personal camp fires allowed. Camp stoves are allowed for cooking.

Kitchen is **NOT** available for cooking or general use and is for event staff only.

Ice from the machine in the kitchen will be available for participants. Hands must be washed before access. (Adults only, please.)

Family amenities include a playground, volleyball court, basketball court, and swings. Weather permitting, there may be four-wheeler train rides around the property during breaks and after the rounds for children.

We aim for this year's event to be a family friendly environment. All visitors are expected to respect the property and other visitors while staying by keeping music and other noises to a neighborly level.
