

- OB lines are marked with a string. If the string is broken, you are allowed to make it to a straight line
- All mandatory lines continue to infinity (from the end of markings), but those effect only to the designated hole
- Alternate 18th tee for only the Scottish Layout is NOT shown on this map

SPECIAL SAFETY NOTE

WHITE #7 | BLUE #8

There is a big underground bees nest on hole W7 / B8, in the corner of the fairway.

DANGEROUS AREA RELIEF: If your disc lands in roped-off area around the nest mark your lie behind the rope on the line of play from where it entered the nest area to first possible safe spot to throw.

If you find any other other bees nest, please inform event staff and other players. Play the area like [PDGA rule 803.02](#) says.

WHITE LAYOUT

HOLE #1 | Par 3 | 92 m

Flat fairway with a huge guardian cork tree. Trees down the entire right side are punishing.

RELIEF AREA: If your disc lands in the giant pile of wood next to the fairway mark your lie behind the pile (on the line of play from where it entered the pile), to first possible safe spot to throw.

HOLE #2 | Par 3 | 54 m

Steep uphill, but not too long. Try to hit the gap between pines up onto the rock shelf.

HOLE #3 | Par 3 | 70 m

Fairly straight steep downhill into a tunnel. Rough surrounding the basket is thick with thin trunks.

CASUAL RELIEF: If you disc ends anywhere behind the wooden fence on the green, you can choose to play from there OR you can move to the temporary drop zone (just outside circle 1) without penalty

HOLE #4 | Par 3 | 81 m

Slightly downhill tee shot to basket far up on a hill to the right. Rough on the hill to the right, before the basket & along the fairway is nasty.

HOLE #5 | Par 3 | 88 m

Gaps to choose! Pay attention to cars and other people.

RELIEF AREA: If your disc lands in the giant pile of wood next to the fairway mark your lie behind the pile (on the line of play from where it entered the pile), to first possible safe spot to throw.

HOLE #6 | Par 4 | 111 m

Two accurate shorter shots needed for a birdie chance. Orange Flag is on top of the basket, which is very guarded by small cork oaks. Very rough area long of the basket.

HOLE #7 | Par 4 | 99 m

MANDATORY: Must be passed from right. If mando is missed, continue from the 1st drop zone with one penalty shot.

DOUBLE MANDATORY: Must pass between mandos. If any mando line is crossed, continue from the 2nd drop zone near the left Mando tree, with one penalty shot.

!! The road crossing the fairway IS NOT OB, local rule is not valid !!

HOLE #8 | Par 3 | 76 m

Two lanes to choose from with one pesky, small cork tree halfway down the left gap. Hanging basket.

WHITE LAYOUT

HOLE #9 | Par 3 | 93 m

Slightly uphill, more than one gap to choose.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Hole 17 island green on the left. Normal OB rule.

HOLE #10 | Par 3 | 38 m

Short touchy shot, often windy. Pay attention to players on hole 15.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Across the road (string line behind the basket).

HOLE #11 | Par 3 | 61 m

The basket is on a steep hill, guarded by a twisted cork tree and some shrubs. Eucalyptus area is NOT OB but it's nasty in there.

HOLE #12 | Par 3 | 82 m

Steep downhill straight shot, often windy. Basket's on a rock shelf.

Watch where you land, though, grass swallows up discs.

HOLE #13 | Par 3 | 55 m

Steep uphill, fairly straight. Look for the Orange Flag on the tree, the basket is about 4 meters behind and slightly right of that Flag. Left side of the fairway and green are jail, so many trees.

HOLE #14 | Par 3 | 52 m

Look for orange Flag on top of the basket. Steep green with rollaways very possible.

HOLE #15 | Par 3 | 48 m

Straight shot, slight fade at end. Pay attention to players on hole 12.

OUT OF BOUNDS: All along right side of the road by the Eucalyptus area.

HOLE #16 | Par 3 | 70 m

No OB but both the far left side (behind dead tree) & the right side Eucalyptus are thick rough. If you go deep left you probably won't find your disc.

HOLE #17 | Par 3 | 68 m

ISLAND GREEN: Everything around the island green is HAZARD. If any throw ends to hazard, continue from that spot with one penalty shot.

HOLE #18 | Par 4 | 122 m

Pay attention to road traffic and people around holes 6 and 7.

DOUBLE MANDATORY. If mando is missed, continue from drop zone (below the mandos, in the corner of fairway).

BLUE LAYOUT

HOLE #1 | Par 3 | 75 m | Short tee, same basket as White #1
Flat fairway with a huge guardian cork tree. Trees down the entire right side are punishing.

RELIEF AREA: If your disc lands in the giant pile of wood next to the fairway mark your lie behind the pile (on the line of play from where it entered the pile), to first possible safe spot to throw.

HOLE #2 | Par 3 | 52 m | Short tee, same basket as White #2
Steep uphill, but not too long. Try to hit the gap between pines up onto the rock shelf.

HOLE #3 | Par 3 | 58 m | Short tee, same basket as White #3
Fairly straight steep downhill into a tunnel. Rough surrounding the basket is thick with thin trunks.

CASUAL RELIEF: If you disc ends anywhere behind the wooden wall, you can choose to play from there OR you can move to the temporary drop zone (just outside circle 1) without penalty

HOLE #4 | Par 3 | 72 m | Short tee, same basket as White #4
Slightly downhill tee shot to basket far up on a hill to the right. Rough on the hill to the right, before the basket & along the fairway is nasty.

HOLE #5 | Par 3 | 88 m | Same tee and basket as White #5
Gaps to choose! Pay attention to cars and other people.

RELIEF AREA: If your disc lands in the giant pile of wood next to the fairway mark your lie behind the pile (on the line of play from where it entered the pile), to first possible safe spot to throw.

HOLE #6 | Par 3 | 50 m
Short throw to the basket out of the tunnel and up to the left.

HOLE #7 | Par 3 | 61 m | Blue tee, same basket as White #6
Guarded by small corks all around. Flag on top of the basket.

HOLE #8 | Par 3 | 70 m | Short tee, same basket as White #7
Uphill, between the two mandos.

DOUBLE MANDATORY: Must pass between mandos. If mando is missed, continue from drop zone near left Mando tree, with one penalty shot.

!! The road crossing the fairway IS NOT OB, local rule is not valid !!

BLUE LAYOUT

HOLE #9 | Par 3 | 69 m | Blue tee, same basket as White #5
Down the road, basket on the left. BUSY AREA, pay attention to other players and cars.

HOLE #10 | Par 3 | 62 m | Blue tee, same basket as White #8
One main gap to hit, really tight lane to the right of it. BUSY AREA, pay attention to other players and cars.

HOLE #11 | Par 3 | 52 m | Blue tee, same basket as White #9
Low ceiling, slightly uphill. Front of the green is guarded by huge, fallen cork limbs.

HOLE #12 | Par 3 | 38 m | Same tee and basket as White #10
Short touchy shot, often windy. Pay attention to players on hole 15.
OUT OF BOUNDS: Across the road (string line behind the basket).

HOLE #13 | Par 3 | 55 m | Short tee, same basket as White #11
The basket is on a steep hill, guarded by a twisted cork tree and some shrubs. Eucalyptus area is NOT OB but it's nasty in there.

HOLE #14 | Par 3 | 48 m | Blue tee, same basket as White #12
Basket's on a rock shelf. No OB. Watch where you land, though, grass swallows up discs.

HOLE #15 | Par 3 | 52 m | Short tee, same basket as White #15
Straight shot, slight fade at end. Pay attention to players on hole 12.
OUT OF BOUNDS: All along right side of the road in the Eucalyptus area.

HOLE #16 | Par 3 | 64 m | Short tee, same basket as White #16
No OB but both the far left side (behind dead tree) & the right side Eucalyptus are thick rough. If you go deep left you probably won't find your disc.

HOLE #17 | Par 3 | 68 m | Same tee and basket as White #17
!! No hazard rule or island green for Blue layout !!

HOLE #18 | Par 4 | 122 m
Same tee and basket as White #18.
Pay attention to road traffic and people around holes 6 and 7.
DOUBLE MANDATORY. If mando is missed, continue from drop zone (below the mandos, in the corner of fairway).

SCOTTISH LAYOUT

The SCOTTISH LAYOUT is a combination of White and Blue layouts. If nothing else mentioned, the hole rules and details are exactly the same as on the original White/Blue layout hole.

HOLE #1 = White #1 | Par 3 | 92 m

HOLE #8 = Blue #8 | Par 3 | 70 m

HOLE #15 = White #15 | Par 3 | 48 m

HOLE #2 = Blue #2 | Par 3 | 52 m

HOLE #9 = White #18 | Par 4 | 122 m

HOLE #16 = Blue #16 | Par 3 | 64 m

HOLE #3 = White #3 | Par 3 | 70 m

HOLE #10 = Blue #10 | Par 3 | 62 m

HOLE #17 = White #17 | Par 3 | 68 m

HOLE #4 = Blue #4 | Par 3 | 72 m

HOLE #11 = White #9 | Par 3 | 93 m

HOLE #18 = Modified #18 | Par 3 | 110 m
Alternate tee, regular #18 basket.
A straight shot. Tee is below the left Mando tree on the fairway of 7 White. You can see the 18th basket clearly from it.

HOLE #5 = White #5 | Par 3 | 88 m

HOLE #12 = Blue #12 | Par 3 | 38 m

HOLE #6 = Blue #6 | Par 3 | 50 m

HOLE #13 = White #11 | Par 3 | 61 m

HOLE #7 = White #6 | Par 3 | 99 m
Yes, White #6, not #7

HOLE #14 = Blue #14 | Par 3 | 48 m

Tee is not visible in the course map.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Saturday-Sunday, December 6-7, 2025
- Three competition rounds
- PDGA C-tier, no membership requirements
- [PDGA Rules](#) and [PDGA Competition Manual](#) in use

IF YOU HAVE RULE ISSUES

1. Check the caddie book and course map for hole rules
2. Check PDGA rules
3. Play with two different ways. TD will make the ruling after your round is finished

PLAY-OFF

- In case of tied first place, sudden death is played on holes White #1, #9 and #18, until there is a winner.

SCORING

- Official scoring platform is [PDGA Digital Scorecard](#). Paper scorecards available at Tournament office if needed
- Tournament access code will be shared at Tournament office and in Player meeting
- Each player in the playing group must keep scores for all players in the group
- Each player is responsible for their own scores in their own scorecard

CHECK - VERIFY - VISIT

- After the round players must CHECK the scores are correct and matches with other players' scores. If everything is correct, VERIFY the scores. VISIT tournament office as a group

OUTSIDE OF TOWN

- **Naturarte Rio** is a Boutique Hotel run by the same people as Naturarte Campo. It is driving-distance (10 minutes) from the course. The Naturarte family owns the land the disc golf course is on and they are extremely supportive of the effort to bring disc golf to the region. But their rooms are a bit more expensive.
- **Vila Nova de Milfontes** is a beautiful beach town 25 minutes west of the course. Plenty of hotels and hostels in that town as well. **Café Stress Free** is a lovely spot with rooms to rent. And **Cerca da Vitoria Apartamentos** is another great spot with nice rooms with views of the river and ocean and a pool.

FOOD & DRINKS

Snack Bar A-Teimosa

A 2-minute walk across the street from the course. Take a right out of the course driveway, then take your 1st left. Drinks, coffee, beer, bottles of water, juice, etc., and then use their bathroom. They might do grilled cheese and grilled ham and cheese as well (tosta & tosta mista).

Panadaria de Aldeia (Village Bakery)

Open 6:00. to 17:00 every day but Sunday. Bread and rolls, breakfast and lunch menu. Burgers, sandwiches, croissant sandwiches, etc. One of the only places open early in the day. Coffee and tea, water, beer, etc.

Café Pinguim

Open every day from 10:30 to 22:00. 7-minute walk from the course. Lunch 12-14:30, Dinner 19:00-21:00. Traditional Portuguese menu with different pork dishes, omelettes for lunch and dinner, and a great Chicken Piri-Piri. Everything comes with french fries and a small salad. You can get a 'tosta mista' or 'tosta' off hours. Maybe the only place with Estrella on tap.

Espaço Nativa

Open Tue-Thu 12-17. Fri 12-24, Sat 18-24. Closed Sun & Mon. Vegetarian menu available, coffee, baked goods. Not a traditional Portuguese place, kind of a fusion cuisine with communal farm-to-table local foods. Driving distance from the course, maybe 5-8 minutes.

Ar Terra Bistro

Closed on Wed & Thu. Open all other days from 17:30 to 23:30. Indoor seating, with a balcony with a few outdoor tables and some tables outside by the main entrance. Fusion cuisine with a varying dinner menu. Funky, cool vibe and really nice people running the place. Might have some I.P.A. bottles on the menu, sometimes.

O Moinho

2 minute walk, across from the course next to Snackbar A Teimosa. Traditional Portuguese food: seafood, chicken, pork and beef. Beer, coffee. Lunch and dinner, probably similar to Pinguim in the hours they cook and serve food.

FOOD & DRINKS

Ferrador

Closed on Monday. Open Tue-Fri 18:00-22:00. Sat-Sun lunch hours (12-14:30), close for a bit and then open for dinner 18:00-22:00. In the center of town. Traditional Portuguese with a twist. It's in the remodeled village blacksmith's shop. Seafood, beef, pork, chicken. The menu varies. Indoor/Outdoor seating. Around a 10-minute walk from the course, 2-minute drive. Nice people and atmosphere.

Tem Avondo

Cafe right near the center of town. Right near Ferrador. Traditional café with a traditional Portuguese menu. Plate of the day changes most days, chicken, pork, beef and maybe some seafood. French fries and salad comes with most meals. There's indoor/outdoor (very sheltered) seating. Nice people and lots of locals in the front café.

Pizza Domingo

Sundays only, lunch and dinner! Located in Lameiros. Truly great pizza and other cuisine with amazing music and vibe. Find them on Facebook and Instagram.

SUPERMARKETS

Meo Super is the biggest and is open the latest, till 20:00 every day. There are a couple of other small markets near the center of town that close at 18:00. Vila Nova de Milfontes (20 minutes drive away from the course on the coast) has bigger markets and Odemira to the south (25-minute drive or more) has an Aldi and a Lidl outside of town.

FARMER'S / FISH MARKETS

Mercado Local de São Luís. Tuesday through Saturday: 8:00 to 12:30. Located inside the public market house which also includes Café de Fernanda, barbershop, etc. Across the street from the restaurant Ferrador.
