## **NBDG-X LAYOUT | HOLE-BY-HOLE DETAILS**

#### HOLE #1 | Par 3 | 83 m

Slightly downhill with some trees to avoid.

OB: National road on the left and eucalyptus forest behind

#### HOLE #2 | Par 3 | 95 m

Open shot, slightly downhill.

OB: Forest on the left side, marked with white stripes

#### HOLE #3 | Par 3 | 101 m

Along the road, between the mandatory and OB.

MANDATORY: Restricted area on right, must pass from left. If missed, proceed to drop zone with one penalty.

OB: On left, marked with white stripes

#### HOLE #4 | Par 4 | 165 m

FA2/FA3/MJ18/FJ18: Play from short tee

Two landing zones in 55-75m for the first shot, then a quite deep valley with pine trees and the basket on a steep hill.

OB: On the left, marked with white stripes

#### HOLE #5 | Par 3 | 46 m

Open shot to extreme uphill.

#### HOLE #6 | Par 4 | 47 m

Technical u-turn hole with two mandatories. *Additional details added later.* 

#### HOLE #7 | Par 3 | 77 m

Island hole, open shot to slight downhill.

ISLAND GREEN: Everything around the island is OB. If your tee shot ends in OB, proceed to drop zone with one penalty. Regular OB rules on following throws, including all throws inside the island.

FA2/FA3/MJ18/FJ18: Play from short tee

#### HOLE #8 | Par 3 | 88 m

Quite open shot around 10m downhill, basket surrounded by pine trees. OB: On the left, marked with white sticks.



## **NBDG-X LAYOUT | HOLE-BY-HOLE DETAILS**

#### HOLE #9 | Par 3 | 77 m

Open shot on a hillside.

OB: On the right, marked with white sticks.

#### HOLE #10 | Par 3 | 83 m

Blind 5-6m downhill shot with mandatory and fairway becoming narrower and narrower because of OB.

OB: Around the fairway, marked with white sticks.

MANDATORY: Restricted area on right, must pass from left. If missed, proceed to drop zone with one penalty.

#### HOLE #11 | Par 3 | 71 m

Downhill shot through a triple mandatory.

TRIPLE MANDATORY: Restricted area outside the gate, must pass through the gate. If missed, continue to drop zone with one penalty.

#### HOLE #12 | Par 3 | 50 m (estimated)

Extreme downhill shot.

OB: Eucalyptus forest behind the basket, marked with white stripes.

#### HOLE #13 | Par 4 | 124 m

Uphill shot through a creek.

CASUAL RELIEF: Areas marked with blue sticks.

#### HOLE #14 | Par 3 | 91 m

Uphill tunnel shot.

#### HOLE #15 | Par 3 | 87 m

Slight uphill shot.

#### HOLE #16 | Par 3 | 92 m

Uphill shot.

OB: Crossing path in front of the basket. Also on both sides, marked with white sticks and stripes.



## **COMPETITION INFO**

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Saturday-Sunday, December 13-14, 2025
- Three competition rounds
- PDGA C-tier, no membership requirements
- PDGA Rules and PDGA Competition Manual in use

### IF YOU HAVE RULE ISSUES

- Check the caddie book and course map for hole rules
- Check PDGA rules
- Play with two different ways. TD will make the ruling after your round is finished

### **PLAY-OFF**

 In case of tied first place, sudden death is played on holes 1-2-5, until there is a winner.

#### **SCORING**

- Official scoring platform is <u>PDGA Digital</u>
   <u>Scorecard</u>. Paper scorecards available at Tournament office if needed
- Tournament access code will shared at Tournament office and in Player meeting
- Each player in the playing group must keep scores for all players in the group
- Each player is responsible for their own scores in their own scorecard

#### **CHECK - VERIFY - VISIT**

 After the round players must CHECK the scores are correct and matches with other players' scores. If everything is correct, VERIFY the scores. VISIT tournament office as a group

#### **NBDG DOUBLES**

- Friday, Dec 12
- Casual doubles event
- Open for everyone
- Divisions: Advanced, Recreational, Beginner
- One competition round (White layout)
- Best shot
- Make your own team or get a random partner onsite
- Casual event, but basic PDGA rules are valid
- Registration fee 10 € / team
  - $\rightarrow$  Cash or PayPal payment onsite

No registration page, walk-in registration onsite

- $\rightarrow$  Come to the course, register to event staff
- ightarrow Groups can begin the round between 11:00 and 15:00 when two teams are ready to start



## **MINI GAMES**

We always want to offer more than just the main competition. We think that all of you should have a chance to win something, even if your competition wouldn't go as planned. In this event we have following mini games scheduled during the the main event, NBDG-X Alentejo Open:

### CLOSEST TO PIN (CTP)

- Whoever gets the tee shot closest to the basket pole on designated hole, wins the prize
- One CTP game per main event round, total of three games
- CTP holes announced onsite
