The Glades Disc Golf Course (1249 Bumble Bee Rd, Accident, MD 21520) is located in the Deep Creek Lions Club Park and in the beautiful Deep Creek Lake area. The disc golf course is an eighteen-hole tract that is a mix of open and wooded areas. It has one set of tee pads and one basket location.

Please thank the Lions Club (Chris, Scottie McK, and their team for keeping the park and course in beautiful condition all year round. Let's help keep it that way on the event day by picking up trash we see on the course. There will be trash cans at various locations. No alcohol or drug use(smoking, vaping, or any other method) is allowed during a PDGA-sanctioned event (see PDGA section 3.03 C player misconduct).

Tournament Central will be located at the shelter beside the dog park, near the tee for hole 1. Bathrooms are available near the tournament central.

Please remember to stay hydrated throughout the day and protect yourself from the sun. Tournament Central will have water, bug spray, hand sanitizer, and sunscreen for those who need them. A first aid kit will also be available at tournament central. Water will also be available near hole 9.

Presentation of awards will take place at tournament central following round 2 and any playoffs

### Scoring:

We will use pdga.com/score for official scoring; the access code is "glades". We will also have paper cards available. It is required that all players keep score during the round, and it is recommended that 1 be a paper card for backup. Please have the PDGA app loaded, and each player should log in before arriving at the course, as the signal is sometimes spotty at best.

### Spectators:

Spectators are welcome. We ask that spectators remain a safe distance away from all tee pads, fairways, greens, and players. Please remain quiet during actual play so as not disturb any player on the course (be aware that players will be on the entire course and not just near the hole that you are spectating).

All players under 13 must have a parent or guardian (13 or older) caddy with them during the entire tournament. Caddies may be switched between rounds, if necessary. Player caddies must abide by all PDGA rules during the tournament. Players are responsible for the actions of their caddies during the tournament.

#### Weather:

The tournament will be held rain or shine. We will monitor the weather during the tournament, and in the event of lightning, play will be suspended until the lightning has cleared. The signal to suspend play due to lightning will be three short horn blasts followed by another three short horn blasts 1 minute later. Players should immediately stop playing, mark their lie, and go to the nearest shelter. For information on suspended play, please refer to section 1.07 of the PDGA rulebook.

### Playoffs:

Playoffs will be played for first-place ties in all divisions. All playoffs will be played on a loop of holes 1, 2, and 3. It will be a sudden life playoff. The first player to win a hole wins the playoff. All playoffs must be initiated by a tournament director and be observed by a designee of the tournament director.

### Ace prize:

All competitors are entered into the Ace Pool at no additional charge. Rocky Gap State Park donated a prize for the Ace Contest. If more than one ace is thrown during the two rounds, the prizes will be discs donated by Mile Lane Disc Golf.

#### CTPS:

We will have multiple CTP (Closest to the Pin) contests. At each hole where a CTP is, a flag will be on the tee pad, and a baggie containing a note card and a pencil will be attached. The first time a player in that hole's CTP division throws, the player nearest the pin should mark their spot and place their name on the note card. As subsequent cards are thrown, tee shots that are closer (for the correct divisions) should mark their shot with the flag and place the new player's name on the card. All CTPs will be for the first round, EXCEPT an all-division, all-rounds CTP on hole 1 to win a prize pack (Disc and mini) donated by the Maryland Points Tour. Other CTP prizes are discs donated by Mile Lane Disc Golf.
