GENERAL RULES & NOTES

- 2-METER RULE: The 2-meter rule is not in effect.
- COURSE MARKINGS: Areas of the course will be marked in colored paint as follows: OB lines will be marked in WHITE paint; HAZARD lines will be YELLOW; MANDATORY LINES and DROP ZONES will be marked in ORANGE; Defined CASUAL areas will be marked in RED; RELIEF AREAS will be marked in PINK; Areas designated to be of SAFETY concern will be marked in BRIGHT BLUE.
- OUT OF BOUNDS: OB areas (including water) are primarily defined by a white painted line or white fabric strap/rope.
 Where present, white OB stakes may be used as a visual aid. As is standard, the line itself is considered OB. (806.02)
- CASUAL WATER: Players may obtain relief from unmarked casual areas of standing water per PDGA Rule 806.03.
- AD WALLS: Ad walls that are parallel to an OB line DO NOT serve as the OB line. The OB line will be defined by a painted line or rope running in front of and parallel to the walls. The minimum distance between the walls and OB line is 1 meter.
- RELIEF FROM OBSTACLES: Players may obtain relief backward on the line of play, without penalty, from temporarily placed advertising assets, permanent sign posts, fairway markers, gopher holes, golf course utility boxes (green plastic

- fixtures), per PDGA Rule 803.02 (A). As the rule states, "unless greater relief is announced by the Director" instead of only taking the closest lie that provides relief, the Tournament Director has granted up to 1 m relief from the aforementioned assets/obstacles.
- CASUAL AREAS: Any appropriate areas, such as wet areas, or areas that could be potentially unstable or unsafe to establish a stance, etc., will be marked in RED and played as CASUAL AREAS. If an area is marked at the beginning of a round it will remain marked for the entire round. Per PDGA Rule 806.03, "(A.) A casual area is an area designated by the director which allows for optional relocation without penalty. A player may choose to take relief if their lie is in that area. (B.) By default, any body of water that is in-bounds and has not been explicitly declared by the Director to be in play is a casual area."
- CASUAL OBSTACLES: Per rule 803.01 (B) (1),
 "A casual obstacle is ... any item as
 designated by the Director," spectator
 stakes and ropes that are in-bounds
 have been designated as casual
 obstacles, and may be moved and
 replaced.
- RELIEF AREAS: Any appropriate areas, such as active wildlife dens, insect nests, unsafe areas, etc., will be marked in PINK and played as RELIEF AREAS. These areas may be added or removed during the event based on the discretion of the

Tournament Director. If an area is marked at the beginning of a round it will remain marked for the entire round. Per PDGA Rule 806.04, "...A relief area is played as an out-of-bounds area with the exception that no penalty throw is assessed to a player whose disc comes to rest in a relief area."

 PLAYER GUESTS: Players are responsible for friends or family who are spectators and who attempt to join the playing group in violation of CM 4.03.G. Players will receive courtesy violation penalties under 812.C if this occurs.

HOLE 1

OB: Practice range left; Highway right and beyond.

OB: Discs coming to rest right and long of the marked line.

HOLE 4 PECA APPROVED GOOD

OB: Property line on the right as marked, creek/rock area short of the green as marked, and outside of island green.

DROP ZONE: For any throw from the fairway coming to rest OB, mark the spot where it was last in-bounds. Only if that spot is on the ISLAND GREEN, proceed to DZ +1 penalty throw. Standard rules apply on all other throws.

OB: Discs coming to rest right of the marked line.

OB: Discs coming to rest right of the marked line.

HOLE 7

OB: Discs coming to rest right and long of the marked line.

HOLE 9

OB: Discs coming to rest left and long of the marked line.

HOLE 12

OB: Discs coming to rest right of the marked line.

HOLE 16

OB: Discs coming to rest right and long of the marked line (shared with hole 17).

HOLE 17

OB: Discs coming to rest outside of the marked safe area.

HOLE 18

OB: Discs coming to rest left and/or long of the first marked area; Discs coming to rest outside of the two marked islands.

NOTE: Standard OB rules apply on the entire hole.
