OB Notes:

1. ELECTRIC FENCE on the right hand side. If your disc goes past this, please do not try to retrieve your disc. We have marked a red flag line as the OB line just to keep off the electric fence. All players may take 2 meters of relief off this fence whether OB or within close proximity.
2. Creek right (and over) is OB. Red flag line long/left (and over) is OB. If you are OB, play from last point in bounds with 1 penalty stroke.
3. Creek long (and over) is OB. Red flag line right (and over) is OB.
4. Creek plays as a "river" for OB. You can layup short, or choose to throw over, but if you land in the water, you are OB, and play from last point in bounds.
5. White stakes right and over are OB. White flag line left and over is HAZARD. Flag line peels off left, the shorter off the tee you throw. White flag line left and over is OB.
6. White stakes right (and beyond) are OB. White flag line left/long (and beyond) is HAZARD. If you are in the hazard area, you play from your lie, with 1 penalty stroke.
7. In the creek plays OB. If you go far enough right, there is a stake line. Over that line is also OB.
8. No OB.
9. Red flag line left (and beyond) is OB.
10. No OB.
11. Once you get beyond the first wall of trees, there is a flag line that travels on both the left and right (and long). If you land over the line, you are OB.
12. No OB.

15. Red flag line right (and beyond) is OB.
16. Red flag line left (and beyond) is OB. Red flag line right (and beyond) is OB.
17. No OB.
18. White stakes right (and over) are OB. There is a small bubble in the middle in which the stakes create a small in bounds peninsula.
