Scoring

Scoring will be done through digital score cards on the PDGA website pdga.com/score or through the PDGA app. The code is **MWC25**.

Catering

Bring your own food and snacks for the day. The golf club will be selling hot sausage, onions in bread for \$2.50 each so bring cash for food and drinks purchase. Please do not BYO alcohol to this event.

Practice

Unfortunately, we are unable to offer any time for practice rounds before the event as we have only hired the golf course on Saturday. **No disc golf players allowed on the course on Friday**. Practice will be allowed before the 8am players meeting and during the lunch break up until two minutes before round two starts.

If you are unable to attend/play the Mid Winter Classic please use Disc Golf Scene to inform the organisers as soon as possible as we have players on the waiting list.

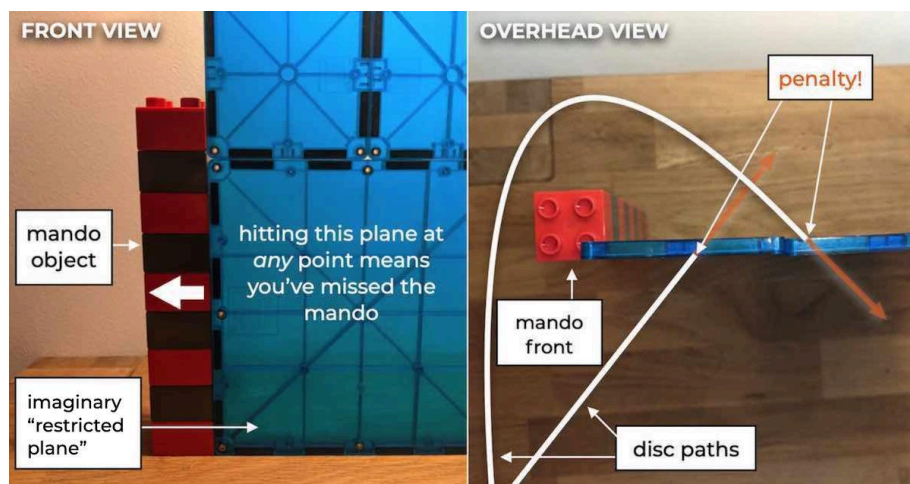
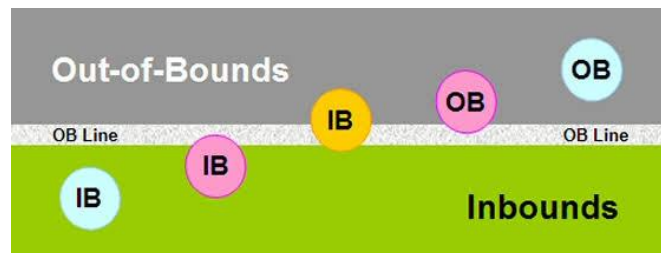
Ace Kitty

Rules

This is a PGDA sanctioned C-Tier event, so please ensure that you are familiar with the rules and regulations relating to tournament play. [Official PDGA Rules](#)

- All water except casual water on the playing surface is OB. The disc is OB when entirely surrounded by water.
- 1-metre relief is available from all OB with no penalty stroke
- Teeing off - A player may not have any supporting point outside of the tee area at the moment the disc is released. Before or after the release is OK.
- No alcohol is to be consumed during any round or play off.
- The Black Ice Duel are non-smoking events. There is no smoking or vaping on the grounds and buildings of the course. The only exception will be in the car park. Please be considerate of other people who may be in the car park. Any smoking/vaping outside this area will be treated in a similar vein to breaches of the PDGA Alcohol rules.
- Hazard rule - player receives one penalty stroke and the lie is not relocated.
- Lost disc drop zone - If a drop zone has been designated for lost discs on the hole, the player may throw from the drop zone instead of from the previous lie with a one stroke penalty.
