Rules and Scoring

As a PDGA Sanctioned Event, all rules and scoring shall follow PDGA guidelines. All players* are required to keep score. Scoring within the PDGA app is preferred, however, paper scorecards will be available for those who prefer this method.

All members of each card are required to report to the scoring table following their round to verify their scores. Failure to do so will result in a two-stroke penalty.

*A designated caddie may also keep score for a player during their round.

TD Specific Rules Addendums or Clarifications

(805.02) Two-Meter Rule

The Two-Meter Rule (805.02) will NOT be in effect at this event!

(802.04) Teeing Off

Due to overseeding of the golf course, most of our tee pads are situated on the "rough" areas of the course, and will be on grass or even dirt (with a few tees on cart paths).

While we have to use these natural areas, we have done our best to create tee placements that are level and provide good footing. Each tee pad will be marked with two flags at the front and two flags at the back to indicate the boundaries of a 4'x10' teeing area. All PDGA rules apply otherwise.

(4.04) Dress Code

This event will adhere to the dress code standards as put forth in section (4.04) of the PDGA Competition Manual for Disc Golf Events. Be mindful that a "collared" shirt does not necessarily mean a fold over type collar like a polo shirt. Hemmed collars on a crew neck or v-neck jersey of high quality are allowed. No T-shirts, cutoffs, etc. Also, no offensive, profane, political, or obscene slogans or logos are allowed.

(806.) Regulated Areas

As this event takes place on a large and active ball golf property, there are limits as to how we may mark or designate regulated areas. As such, there will be no paint lines, and almost no string lines to define these areas. In most cases, these areas are fairly well defined, as the ViewPoint groundskeeping crew has been working to re-seed and manicure the course for their fall and winter seasons. However, there are likely to be some lies which are questionable, and will require a card to collectively make a call. *It is your responsibility as a player to call a violation when one has clearly occurred.*

Regulated Areas - Continued

The "line" of a regulated area is defined by the intended path of said line, whether it is the edge of a cart path, a golf green, fairway, or bunker. For instance, a cart path may have some overgrown areas along its edge where grass is growing onto the cart path. However, the "line" of the cart path should be obvious by looking along the edge of its length to determine its intended path, and thus, the boundry to consider when determining a lie.

The example here shows a cart path with overgrown turf along its edge. The natural boundry is deliniated by the most prominent grass edge as indicated by the white line. In this case, there is actually a cut line made by groundkeepers to show the true edge of the cart path (yellow line). However, as that extra grass between the white and yellow lines has not yet been cleared, the white line should still serve as the boundry - or OB line. Now for the ridiculous thing to point out; the patch of growth into the joint of the cart path is absolutely OB! I know that it might seem silly to point this out, but I have actually witnessed players trying to argue that *"because their disc is touching grass, it must be in bounds."* NO! NO it isn't! Seriously, folks...



Make the call. Accept the call. It's not personal; it's the rules. That is the spirit of the game of disc golf.










Gunnite creek bed and beyond is OB.

Pathing after Hole 16 (to 17) - The long walk!

After completing Hole 16, you will have a long walk to reach the tee of 17. The area in red represents Hole 3's fairway area and the golf green/fairway, so pathing through it is prohibited. Crossing the creek bed can be rather dangerous in some places, so cross it at your own risk. The safest path is to follow the creek bed south to its end and then proceed to 17's tee.






Hole 18
